

It's Your Time



ast month, I had the pleasure of returning to Mars Hill College in Western North Carolina to see the annual Spring Concert put on by the Bailey Mountain Cloggers. Last year when I saw this performance, I was so taken by the ability of cloggers from so many different backgrounds and styles to be able to come together to make a team with so much energy and excitement.

This year's concert was the most daring and most stylized I have seen. Mixing traditional clogging with Fosse-esque choreo, wildy percussive dueling-duos, and lyrical grace, the show told the story of a girl trying to make it in show business and finding the road a rocky one. Having seen this group perform throughout the years and seeing many of last season's dancers and how far they have come in their professional growth was amazing.

The performance I saw was the final matinee of a run that included several near sold-out shows. After the curtain fell for the last time and the dancers came out into the audience to greet their friends, families and guest, the sense of finality struck many of them and emotions ran high. Some were graduating seniors who must now reluctantly move on from this experience. I am sure they will always relish the time they had as a part of such an ensemble, and, likely, will look back later longing for the "good old days" at Mars Hill College and the Bailey Mountain Cloggers. These young people gave themselves to a project knowing that it would signal an end for the group as they know it. They gave their all to leave a mark and give a show that would be their legacy to their time.

I recall my similar thoughts the last time I came to see the Mars Hill concert. When you know how long you have to be a part of something, you sense the importance of making your mark. You learn how to be a team player, or be left out, and you learn to the relish every moment you have, knowing that one day will be your last curtain call.

Think of your dance program as a limited engagement. This is YOUR time. Make your mark.



This year we were very fortunate to have a guest to star in the Spring Fling's "Moulin







Donner Center is in the middle of a large park so many also enjoyed nature during the breaks. Some of those not into nature went shopping at a nearby mall on the breaks.







Competition Corner # 104

by J.L.Harkness

The competition season is a time to absorb all your critiques and perfect your routine. Janet Smith, a judge for Starpower, says, "Go even bigger with your routine and incorporate more difficulty where needed to increase your technique score." You should decide exactly where your arms, hands and head are throughout the routine, according to Patrice Barakat, a judge for Showbiz. Through it all, review your scoresheet and critique tapes as often as possible. "There may be something we write that may [suddenly] 'click' and you say to yourself, 'Now I get it,' "Smith adds.

BREAKIN' IT DOWN

There are certain specifics that judges look for in each category of dance. When it comes to Artistic Expression, Show or Novelty categories, storytelling is at the top of the list. "If it's a show number, tell me the story with your face and movements as if I can't hear the music," says Smith. With jazzy moves, Smith says, "Attack it in the very beginning-make me not take my eyes off of you." Nicole Snelson, a judge for Star Systems, says, "I look for solid technique. I want to see that ample time has been spent at technique when you are out there doing your dance."

COMPETITION TIPS

Becoming a fine-tuned act can lead to a successful competition. Here's a few do's and don'ts:

"Don't put in a technique that is still being worked on or the latest tricky step 'cause everybody is doing it."-Patrice Barakat

"Don't wear too much glitter or bright makeup. It's not necessary. Look into theater makeup and have a makeover day." -Sonya Tayeh, Hall Of Fame Dance Challenge judge

"What makes a solid, strong routine is originality, creative costuming, precise execution of technique and dancers who are well-rehearsed and confident in their choreography." -Densil Adams, Dance Olympus judge

"Stage presence is a must! If a dancer has all this wonderful technique and shows no expression through their number, it becomes boring." - Janet Smith

The #1 Pet Peeve

Overwhelmingly, judges say their number one pet peeve is age inappropriate costuming and choreography. "There is nothing worse than a routine being inappropriate. Dance is an art and should be treated as such," Janet Smith explains. Densil Adams agrees: "As teachers, I feel that it is solely our responsibility to present children as children, and selection of music and costume is an important factor."

Here's a guide to figuring out specifically what judges' comments mean. The comments in aqua were taken from a sample lyrical scoresheet, but most of the phrases could be seen in any category. The quotes in black are from competition judges, credited in parenthesis.

Stage Presence

"Don't put in a

technique that is

"Emote with more range" means that you should "tell me the story with your face as if I can't hear the music" (Janet Smith).

"Stay mentally connected and allow the music to move you" means, "Learn how to really listen to the words of the music to allow them to move you throughout the dance" (Sonya Tayeh).

Technical Execution

"Continue to strengthen basic skills." Go through your whole routine step by step and be sure you perfect these basics (J.L.H.).

> "Elongate and lift" means that "you have energy in your feet and your upper body is asleep. Concentrate on connecting both of them. Give your whole body the same energy" (Janet Smith.).

"Energy should be coming out every limb of your body" (Patrice Barakat).

Timing & Rhythm

"Don't rush" means that you should be sure to dance in sync with the tempo of your music (J.L.H.).

"Breathe life into the music" is often given to a dancer who is just doing the steps and not feeling the music. Give an emotional life to your dance by making sure you are dancing to a song you truly love, and then express the meaning of the song to the audience. "If you have amazing technique but just a pleasant smile, it's not going to do it for me" (Patrice Barakat).


Choreography/Routine

"Let us see your extension" is a challenge, by the judge to the dancer, to make the routine more technically demanding. Judges write comments like this if they feel the choreography is not showing the dancer's full capabilities (J.L.H.).

"Strengthen stamina" means you need to work on keeping your energy up from beginning to end. "You cannot start the number off with crazy hot energy, then die off halfway through" (Nicole Snelson).

"Consider a theme instead of randomness" is often given when the dancer is not connected to the song and is just doing moves on top of the music. The number one rule to remember in lyrical dances is to tell the story of the lyrics through dance (J.L.H.).


