We Get Letters...



We get letters. We get emails. We get lots and lots of phone calls. Most ask for information about clogging or classes or workshops in their area. Some think the magazine is a message service or detective to track down national instructors who won't return calls. More than anything else, though, we get messages from people who just want some assurance that what they are doing out there in the day to day clogging world is valid.

This Summer I have gotten several emails and notes from teachers who have had teams split or who are trying to make a go of clogging on their own after having left an unfulfilling dance environment. Some are seeking advice, others seek allies. Some just want to vent. The common thread among all of the stories is the sense that an activity that is supposed to be fun is causing them so much stress.

I, too, was involved in a team that split. When I first started clogging nearly 25 years ago, I was a member of a clogging exhibition team. The team was not a competitive one and we mostly did regional events. As my passion for clogging grew and I attended workshops and competitions — like most of you — the bug bite me and I was consumed by my desire to pursue clogging. The team I was a member of was some ways from my home. My parents offered their backyard garage as a studio and I began to teach some private lessons and then went on the public classes and eventually workshops. I developed friendships with members of a competition group and would socialize with them at our area clogging dances, which were held at live bluegrass establishments every weekend. Without going into my own venting, let's just say I was released to become a free agent. I was told I would be nothing without the team and I would be done in clogging. A lot of crazy things happened after that to test my resolve and my commitment to clogging.

The easy thing to do is retaliate. It's human nature to stand up for yourself and often we defend ourselves by throwing words back on our accusers. I chose at that time to ignore the words and phone calls and the visits to my classes and let the clogging speak for itself. Others urged me to strike back, but I knew that it would just make things worse. I have given the same advice to several dear friends in clogging who branched out on their own. "Don't ever let it be said that you were the bad guy. Just work hard to build your program the best you can and the bad words and feelings will have nowhere to go. The best quiet revenge is success." Eleanor Roosevelt said "Do what you feel in your heart to be right. You'll be criticized anyway." She was right.

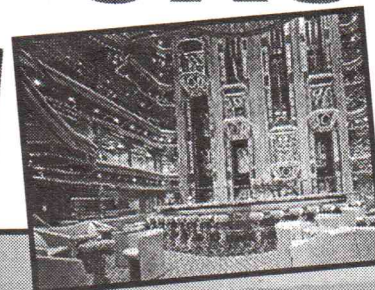
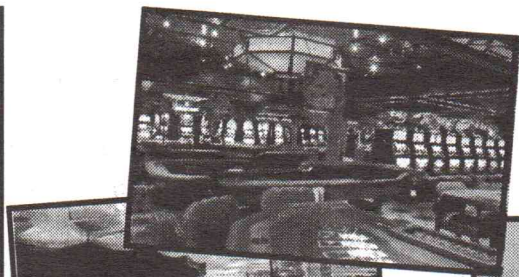
Nobody said it was all going to be fun. With success comes obstacles, and some of those may even come from within. As your aspirations come to fruition, you will experience a range of emotions. Success isn't always defined in terms of money or recognition. Some of my proudest moments in clogging have been in seeing the efforts of others who I had the privilege of working with. And even when you find yourself comfortable in your own "success", you may not find everyone in support. "Success will win you false friends and true enemies - succeed anyway." Mother Teresa said. Moms were right, listen to the Nuns.

Know this... you are not alone. Your letters echo the fears and growing pains of everyone who has been a part of a creative process. As hard as it is, ignore the negatives and focus your energies on bringing the magic spark to your students that you remember from your own clogging experience.

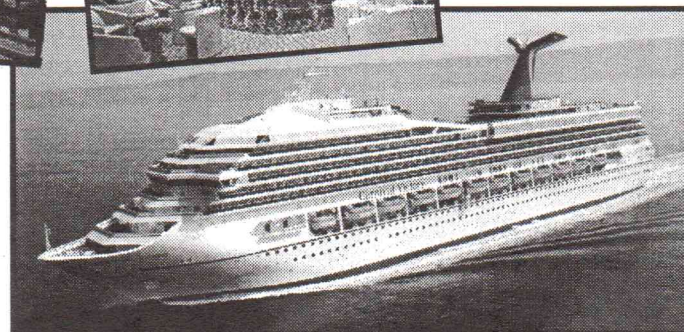
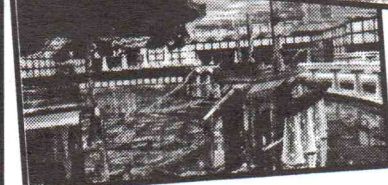

Walt & Marti Stevens

Cloggers Mourn the Loss of Clogging Innovators

Walter T. Stevens, Jr., was known as Walt to most of his friends. He was the founder of the Burlington County 4-H Cloggers and inventor of the Stevens Stomper tap. An engineer, clogger and square dancer, Walt was the first to introduce and help spread clogging throughout New Jersey.

Born in Chase MD, Walt joined the Navy out of High School. He was awarded a fleet scholarship to Penn State where he studied Mathematics. He met and married Marti White, a fellow Mineral Industries student, while at Penn State.

Following discharge from the Navy after the war, he took a second degree in Electrical Engineering and worked until about 1970 as a defense engineer at various locations in the US and in Germany. Then he became an engineering consultant.

According to daughter Marti, both parents were dance enthusiasts. "Walt enjoyed dancing," Marti said, "With good rhythm and balance he could dance to most any music with flair. He enjoyed clogging the few times he saw it as a youth but never had a chance to take lessons until adulthood. Soon after learning some clogging steps, he became interested in choreography. He

enjoyed matching the steps to the nuances in the music. He taught his routines to the dancers of the Burlington County 4-H Cloggers. He was very patient with the dancers. You could see that he really loved working with the young people on music and dance. He had the gift of humor in virtually any situation, and this could be especially helpful in working with a couple of teams of cloggers!"

Marti White was active in 4-H while growing up in Mercer PA. Walt and Marti had 3 children: Carolyn, Walter Lee and Eric. Marti, a full-time Mom for 20 years, started sewing and cooking 4-H clubs. When her family was grown, she taught Junior High School Science for 20 years. Walter had 4-H clubs

focusing on woodworking and electronics.

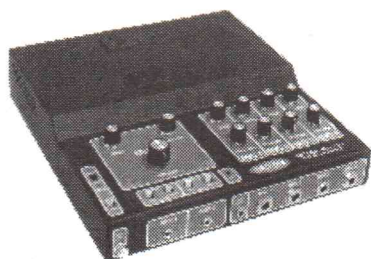
Walt experienced numerous frustrations with the cast aluminum taps his dancers and other cloggers were using at the time. At Marti's encouragement, he undertook to develop a superior tap. At the time, clogging taps were made from cast aluminum. This posed a problem for cloggers because they would frequently crack. Walt had the idea to make the taps from STEEL. This was a totally

revolutionary idea. The taps would be stronger and have a better sound. The strength of steel also allowed them to be thinner and have a better tap action. Marti did most of the testing of adhesives for the initial glue-on tap designs. Both Marti and Walt traveled to workshops and conventions, introducing and testing the new design.

The Stevens family moved back in 1989 to a family farm in Mercer PA. Meanwhile, the Burlington County 4-H Clogging club has continued to grow in New Jersey. Mrs. Stevens was pleased to hear from a former member that has married and had a child. She told Marti that she is anxious to start her own club.

Walt and Marti are survived by daughter, Carolyn, now runs the company producing Stevens Stompers. Walter Lee worked in the company until his death in March of 2002. Son, Eric, is an Architectural Engineer and lives with his wife and 3 daughters in Clarksville MD. Both of Walt's sisters have been cloggers: Sarah Paul and Carolyn Hall living in the Baltimore area. Carolyn extends her thanks, on behalf of the Stevens family, her thanks for the warm wishes and condolences expressed by fellow cloggers and friends. "Walt and Marti lived full lives," Carolyn said, "Their joy of music and dance, as well as family, working with young people, and faith in God gave them a richness of blessings that they shared with so many people."

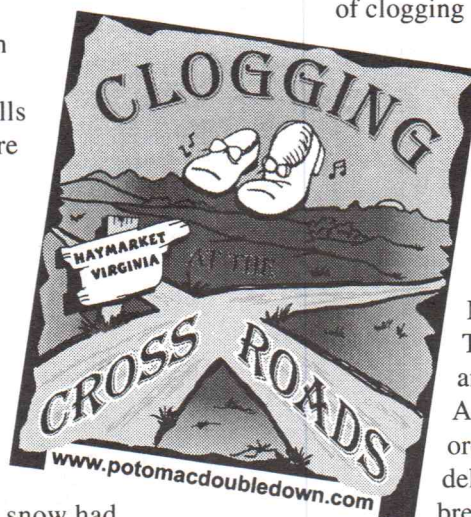
Attendees had the option of ordering lunch to be delivered during the noon break. Many took advantage
