# Angels Among Us...



hen I was western-style square dancing as a kid back in the early 1970's with my family, there were people at the classes that always seemed to know what to do. Whenever you needed help they were always there to extend a hand, or gently turn or point you in the right direction. The caller referred to them as "angels", and to a self-conscious young man who didn't want to be embarrassed by breaking down the square, they certainly earned their wings.

Angels didn't try to talk over the caller, but they smiled alot and always made you feel at ease. When the beginner class was over and the intermediate class began, the angels stayed and joined in the fun just like everyone else. The wings folded back into their gingham and you couldn't tell them from anyone else. As I learned more about western-style square dancing, I found that the angels are a very special group that is hand-picked by the caller to help with the beginners. In exchange, some callers would offer them intermediate classes for free. Some were angels just for the satisfaction of being able to help new dancers.

Cloggers could use more angels. Having someone beside you that is stepping along to the rhythm in time can help an unsure dancer learn the downbeat. Since clogging is such a visual and also percussive dance form, having someone with taps on that makes a clean sound can really help someone to follow along. The good thing about true angels is they aren't interested in glory for themselves. They aren't showy and always follow the lead of the teacher. Clogging is so expressive that sometimes we want to be performers all the time. Offer your services to your teacher, share this article, or ask your students to be true angels and you may be rewarded with a heavenly beginners class experience.



# Skirting The Issue

Reprint from USDA News Research and text by Cathy Burdick and Becky Osgood Clogging research by Allison Townsend

How did we get where we are today?

Old time square dance and clogging dresses of today can trace their history back to the elegant ballrooms of France and the grand manors of England. In those countries, the minuet, polka, waltz and quadrille were danced. As people emigrated to America they brought their customs, dress and dances with them. Gowns were made from damask, taffeta, silk or fine muslin. The fullness in the skirt was obtained by wearing a hoop skirt underneath. Coiffures were often high and possible powdered. It was an era of stately music, stately dances and stately dress.

We move forward a hundred years and hope to open the West in on. Days are long and hard with both men and women settling the land, working in the fields, and tending the livestock. Women grow their own flax to make linen, use wool from their sheep to spin yarn, weave their own material and dye it with dyes made from roots and berries. There is not much time for gaiety so every occasion is used for socializing. Barn-raisings, weddings and holidays were prime examples when gatherings were held. Often people came from miles around to see their neighbours, catch up on the news and dance the night away. These dances were held in kitchens, barns, out-of-doors, even in the saloons. Women's dresses were long, starched petticoats and floor length pantaloons were worn underneath. The costuming allowed free and exuberant movements in the square, circles and couple dances.

We move forward to the 20th century, the 1920's in particular and we find Henry Ford endorsing and sponsoring early American Dancing in Lovett Hall, in Detroit, Michigan. Lovett Hall was



complete with teakwood floor, crystal chandeliers and formal straight chairs on either side of the ballroom. A live orchestra and a dancing master were on hand to teach and prompt the evening's dances, which consisted of waltzes, two-steps, early squares and contras. In the beginning formal attire was mandatory with the ladies in long gowns and white gloves.

Following World War II, there was a resurgence nationally in especially square dancing. In the Appalachians, the work of bascom Lamar Lunford and others were also giving precision clogging a great deal of exposure and attention. In choosing their costumes, ladies remembered the long dresses of the early years. At first, these dresses were straight and worn without a petticoat. It wasn't long before the length came up to just above the ankles and starched petticoats and pantalettes were added. Cotton was the fabric used which meant hours of ironing, not only for the dress but the petticoat as well.

By the early 1950's, squaw dresses were "discovered". Some of the newer cottons could be washed, crushed together while wet, and pulled through something tubular, like a stocking, or tied at intervals. When dry, a three or four tiered skirt would present a pleated look, much like the skirt worn by Indian women. Miles and miles of ric-rac were used as trim, which made these dresses weight eight or nine pounds. Imagine dancing all night in a dress weighing eight or nine pounds. Talk about your aerobic exercise! Many a lady remembers repleating one of these skirts, either by hand or with clothespins, or even with a contraption where the material was woven in and out of metal ribs. Hemlines had gone up to ankle or calf length, and pantalettes to below-the-knee bloomers. By the late 1950's some of the embossed cottons could be washed carefully and be presentable without ironing.

In the 1960's came the nylon, nylon net, dracon, polyester and novelty blends that did not have to be ironed. The "drip-dry" era was in full swing. So were the petticoats. Layers of nylon net were used for the petticoats which held the dresses out beautifully. The

hemlines were rising and now we had fancipants with row after row of lace trickling down the leg. How far the fancipants extended up the thigh was a personal choice.

Along with the 1970's came the border prints. These prints can be used not only with the print providing the decoration around the bottom of the skirt, but working the design into the bodice and sleeves. Skirt length got shorter and it became a matter of personal choice as to the length. Petticoats also got fuller and with the hemline creeping up the thigh, the look began to be more like that of a tu-tu skirted ballerina. Many young girls and exhibition groups have kept the tu-tu look. Cloggers during this period often chose to have their skirts and petticoats even shorter than square dancers to accentuate the length of the legs and show off the footwork even more.


The 1980's gave us a return to a fancier dress for square dancers. Most of the patterns feature rows of ruffles, lace and ribbons with very full skirts and petticoats. The colours are bright and eye catching. Border prints are still going strong. Many women now wear colour coordinated dresses, petticoats and pettipants. The length of the dress and the pettipant is left to your good taste. They can range from knee-length to the "sissy britches" style. Thanks to continuing modern technology in materials, most are still permanent press or "drip dry", and require little, if any touch-up with the iron. In clogging, the rise of competition gave way to flashier outfits with sequins and a jazzier look. In many outfits, petticoats were done away with altogether.

Modern dance clothes are no longer "Authentic Covered Wagon" type. Men wear well-fitting shirts, western pants, slacks or jeans, and comfortable shoes for exhibition. Both men and women cloggers now wear jazz oxfords, and the shoes we know as "scoops" —with the small strap across the top of the foot — are seldom scene. Women may be as individual as they like in their dress, letting their imagination run free. Sleeves, necklines, skirts, trims, colours, combinations, there was no limit! Some of the choices that we have today include denim western dresses, prairie skirts, belts, accessories to change and mix and match outfits. Dance shoes are available in many styles, heel heights and colours. The choice is yours. Good taste in underpinnings, in skirt lengths and necklines should always be considered. What looks well on the wearer and to the beholder is the criteria.

We have a wonderful heritage to look back on in fashion, who can tell what the future will bring.







# **Earning Your Wings**

Reprinted from the September 1993 Times Squared

Is your halo on straight? (You should excuse the expression.) It is important that as many of our club members as possible come to the Beginner class as "angels". What are angels? They are the wonderful people who volunteer their time to ensure that a class has the best possible learning experience.

Angels provide the new class

members with their first real look at the club (since class members don't generally see the instructor as a club member until after graduation). How angels behave and treat the new dancers, other angels, and visitors will affect class members' decisions whether or not to join our club. Angels are also role models. No matter what the instructor and club try to communicate to the students concerning etiquette, attitudes, or styling, class members inevitably take their cues from what they see the angels doing. So it is important that angles be extra careful to provide good role models. Smile, be enthusiastic, and enjoy the dancing. Be friendly, courteous, and gentle. This is sometimes easier to say than to do, especially if it has been a long day. And, let's be honest, some of us have personal agendas, perhaps disagreements with club policies or less-than-cordial relations with specific

put aside. Although most of us do the right things instinctively, at least most of the time, it can't hurt to reiterate certain points. The following advice for angels has been extracted from several sources, including articles in dance magazines and hand-outs prepared for other clubs. Thanks go to Betsy Gotta and Nick Martellacci for providing some of these articles.

club members, that are out

Angels are not teachers. This is perhaps the most common misconception that causes problems. Angels' primary teaching function is to teach by example — to be in the right place at the right time. For cloggers, that means slowly dancing the steps in the proper way as the teacher is demonstrating to give dancers more opportunities to see that steps up close. Always have your ready foot lifted slightly at the heel to help dancers see where to start.

Another difficult point is just how much "help" you should give in getting dancers into the right place. Dancers, after all, must learn to do the moves on their own. To gently guide someone through a maneuver if they have a momentary lapse of memory might be okay, and sometimes one can help by indicating nonverbally where a person should go, but we accomplish little by pushing or pulling a dancer through an action when he or she doesn't know what was supposed to have been done. In line dancing, that can be accomplished by simply moving

> letting the learners follow. Sometimes you can point the way. Be sure to make your steps precise and clear. Dancers standing still are an indication to the instructor that the dancers are having problems. Do be sure the teacher is aware of problems: raise your hand if necessary and ask the teacher to explain something if dancers around you are having trouble. Be careful, however, not to embarrass any dancer by the way you

ask for help. For example, say "We're not getting this or that" not "He (or she) is having trouble." Do encourage students; let them know that all beginners make mistakes and that things get better with practice. Also, angels do sometimes make mistakes,

too, and it is good to admit to them cheerfully; it makes the students less tense about their own mistakes. Club styling is always a third major source of contention. It is important that beginners learn the steps with the standardized names for your area and that no flairing on the steps be done. The teacher will introduce our club styling at appropriate times after the calls are mastered. Angels must use only the styling which has been taught to the class. This is not always easy. You may really enjoy adding that buck flair to your basics, but it is really important to remember that adding more than is being taught will only confude the dancers. Students are going to want you to teach them "how that's done" before they have mastered the steps, but you should resist the temptation. (In fact, it helps the angels to be reminded how the steps are really supposed to be done; some of our styling causes havoc when a teacher says, for example, 2 basics and you dance 2 buck or yourself in the right direction and boogie basics.)

And some random additional advice:

- Line up with everyone, not just a few friends. Seek out the weaker students and invite them to come dance by you. Make sure that students are not sitting out in a group dance or mixer because angels are dancing.
- End conversations promptly when the teacher begins a session. If you are not dancing, keep your conversations far away from the dance area.
- ♦ Lend a hand cheerfully if you are asked to help set up or take down sound equipment, to help with refreshments, or to take attendance. Keep an eye out for security problems, accidents, and dangerous situations like spills or debris on the floor.
- ♦ Let the instructor know if there are problems with the sound.
- Don't complain about the hall, the floor, the teacher. Don't criticize students or other angels.
- Remember your name badge.




