Home Again!



This issue of the Double Toe Times features a story about the return of clogging to Fontana Village. I am so proud that I was able to be a part of the weekend and, to me, it really was like going home again. With the smell of a Fontana breakfast cooking on the stove still fresh in my mind, let me share with you my Fontana story.

The Smokey Mountain Jamboree at Fontana Village in the mountains of Western North Carolina was the site of my first clogging workshop experience over 20 years ago. I still remember the awe of seeing buck dancing there for the first time, and along with the rest of the traditional clogging workshop world, seeing Canadian step dancing for the first time when Tandy Barrett invited Judy Weymouth and her dancers down from Ontario. I remember the first time I heard Bill Nichols call a nine-pin square dance at Fontana. That still remains my favorite old-time dance to this very day.

I had never taught a clogging class in my life when Jamie Bullins from Garner, North Carolina, befriended me at the week-long Jamboree at Fontana and we traded steps and styling. Later in the week, during an open mic session, we took to the stage to share some of the steps we had made up. I had no idea that my nervous antics would catch the eye of the organizers and they would offer me opportunities that opened many doors for me in clogging.

Thanks Bobbie and Dewey Paul for taking a chance on a very green instructor who was better at cutting up than clogging. Those antics have kept me busy for over 20 years now! I'm no better a clogger than I was back then, but I have gained a family of friends and a treasure-trove of memories. I am proud that Bobbie and Dewey were there this past month to be a part of the Fontana homecoming. It was an honor to join Bill Nichols onstage and call a nine-pin square dance with the man who first amazed me with his calling style and his unique mountain patter.

Not many of us get a chance to orchestrate a family reunion like this one. In talking to my co-coordinator Naomi Pyle following the event, I found that it was a realization of many dreams for her as well. I guess you really can go home again!



Thanks for sharing this routine. There are many cloggers and clogging groups that use their talents to testify their faith and I admire that.

Growing up in West Virginia, the places I clogged at frowned upon dancing to gospel music -- even the up-tempo bluegrass style of gospel. If someone got up and started clogging -- not knowing the song had a gospel theme -- one of the old-timers would politely go up and tell them it was a church tune.

The psalm says "Praise his name in the dance," and a new generation of people are discovering that they can share their faith in a subtle way through their clogging. Some still may not agree, and I have seen instances when a show routine was a little over the top, but I think it is a good thing to let your feet express the joy that is in your heart... to whatever kind of beat you hear!



Cloggers Return to Fontana Village, NC for first annual Fontana Clogging Jamboree

Hundreds of cloggers made the winding journey through the North Carolina Smokey Mountains for the first annual Fontana Clogging Jamboree held on September 19 and 20, 2003. For those who remember the clogging events of Fontana past — from the clogging classes of Bill Nichols, Boo Ruch and others who lived and taught there, to the Smokey Mountain Jamboree led by Bobbie and Dewey Paul, the N.C.H.C. meetings, and Easter's Possum Holler — there is always a favorite Fontana memory.

The event was the realization of a dream several years in the making. When Naomi Fleetwood-Pyle came to friend and fellow-instructor Jeff Driggs with the idea of bringing back a workshop at Fontana, she found that he had been planning and hoping for the same thing. 

Bill Nichols: The "Grandfather of clogging and a pioneer of dance education.



During the lunch break, dancers headed out to the spacious front porch for a session with our special guests as they shared their stories and memories of Fontana and its place in

clogging history. Bill, Tandy, Bobbie and Dewey, Boo, Scotty, Chip, Jeff and Naomi all shared Fontana memories and answered questions from the crowd about clogging history. The forum ended with a special musical number from Bill Nichols and Anna Wells on the dulcimer, as Anna's husband Ray kept time with a limberjack clogging doll.

Saturday night's program began with a concert by musical guests, the Grass Stains of West Virginia and Andrew Williams of Utah. The mini-concert from 7:00 to 7:30 pm played to a full house and the cheering group of cloggers brought the band back for an encore as free-stylers took to the floor to clog along to the live music. The musicians also played throughout the evening for square dancing. Bill Nichols led the crowd in a fun "sit down" square dance and later shared the mic with Jeff Driggs for a rousing Nine Pin Square dance, where ladies vie to swing a limited number of partners in the hopes of avoiding getting left out and heading to the center of the circle.

Chip Summey's adult dancers presented a funny skit that poked good-natured fun at their instructor, and exhibitions highlighted teams from Australia, New Jersey, Georgia, Louisiana and New Mexico. Gary Larsen, of Utah, is traveling the Appalachian region working on his doctorate and interviewed many of the staff for his work. He gave an amazing dance demonstration that garnered a standing ovation.

The evening ended with a jam session that included the bluegrass band and members of the audience who had their own instruments. Tandy Barrett even brought her own bucket bass! The evening's theme was a Pajama Party and dancers were decked out in flannel, pj's and slippers.

There's just something about Fontana and its rich history that suits cloggers, who have been dancing there since the turn of the century. Fontana Village rebuilt itself many times over the years, as copper miners and their families lived and worked during the 1930's and 1940's.


The creation of the Tennessee Valley Authority by Franklin Roosevelt brought a new group of families to Fontana when the building of the Fontana Dam began in 1942 and continued with the building of power generators into the late 1950's.

Now, a new generation of cloggers are discovering Fontana, and plans are to keep the floor alive with tapping feet for many more years.



Kentucky State Clogging Championships

The 18th Kentucky State Clogging Championships were held on Saturday August 30, 2003 at Georgetown University in Georgetown, Kentucky. The auditorium was filled with over 700 cloggers and spectators who were there for a great day of clogging.

The Kentucky State Clogging Championships were a C.C.A. (Clogging Champions of America) qualifying event, so both amateur and challenge levels were offered in a variety of team events, duos and duets and solos. In addition, the event offered an a capella team event, show duets, short duets and traditional solos. Teams were given a large plaque with all of their age division winnings and the 13 event grand champions took home the coveted Kentucky Horse Statues. In addition the grand champions won 6 and 7 foot trophies — the largest offered in clogging competition — and the grand champion teams won \$1,000 and \$500 respectively. Each year, the organizers also honor an area clogger for their contributions to clogging. This year, they honored Kentucky cloggers Doug and Pat Stephens with the Norvia Burns Award for Clogging Excellence.

Another young lady, who when brought to center stage, was so overcome with emotion cried so much she could barely talk. It took Gregory a few minutes to get her to even say a few words. It was the patience Gregory had for each dancer as he brought them out on stage that I noticed. He loved to tap dance as much as anyone in that auditorium that night. You could tell that Gregory also enjoyed seeing others who had that same love and passion for the dance. For the dancers who were able to get on stage and dance one-on-one with Gregory Hines, it will be a memory they will treasure for the rest of their lives.






