

Clogging FEVER!

High Energy Groups Propel Modern Clogging into the National Spotlight in Syndicated Dance Series

The past couple of years have seen a tremendous amount of media exposure for clogging. From dancers taking to the stage on Wayne Brady and Star Search, to over a thousand dancers taking to the streets in the Washington, D.C. Expo, clogging is certainly gaining name recognition and respect among the dance community and the public.

This Summer, the return of a popular show from the disco era offered clogging one of its most high profile opportunities in many years.

Dance Fever returned -- without the disco balls and flared pants -- to offer a showcase for a wide variety of dance styles. The ABC Family Channel used hip emcee Eric Nies (from the MTV series the Real World) and offered a panel of judges that included MC Hammer, choreographer Jamie King and celebrity Carmen Electra. Two clogging groups made it onto the show, winning their shows and their semifinals, to provide a final show that became a rallying cry for cloggers everywhere and a good-natured battle of the sexes for clogging message boards.

Members of the The Southern Belles and All That took time to answer some questions about the show and their clogging careers for the Double Toe Times.

DTT: At what age did you begin clogging?

Blake Bartlett of The Southern Belles: I have been clogging for 22 years. I started when I was 5 years old.

Mike Curtis of ALL THAT: Started clogging at age 14. Jodi Lewis of The Southern Belles: I think i was about 9 years old.

DTT: Give a brief history of your clogging experience (teams you have been on, teaching and directing experience, honors, etc.)

Mike: I Have danced with Ultimate Dance Force, Leather n Lace, and currently Power n Precision. I have been teaching at national workshops and have taught in places such as BYU, Maine, Daytona and several other exotic cities! Ha ha! I have danced in Japan, Canada, 22 different states and performed in the centennial Olympic games in Atlanta. I have won around 30 male grand championships along with 50 or so duo duet grand championships.

Blake: I began competition clogging when I was about 8 under the direction of Shannon Kerpics (then Shannon Lowrey) on the Dixie Land Dolls. I competed with that team until I was 15 or 16. After that I began competing with Clogging Express out of Valdosta, GA under the

direction of Tootie Coker.

I started the Southern Belles when I was 12 with my sister, Heather Kohberger. We began teaching some kids from our church in our basement. From there everything expanded and we eventually opened a studio of our own. I now compete with the team that I direct. They have become very successful in competition; winning the title of "Clogging Champions of America" in 2002 and "Team of the Year" in 2002 & 2003. We have also accomplished many championships with the National Clogging & Hoedown Championships organization.

I have accomplished 2 outstanding goals in clogging. One, winning the overall female championship in 2000, and two, taking my team to the top in 2002. My team, as well as me individually, strive to impress an audience every time we hit the floor. Yes, like everyone, we want to win, but it's even better when we can be impressive and be complemented on our performance by friends as well as complete strangers.

Jodi: I first made fun of clogging when my sister starting doing it. I was too cool trying to be the ballerina, but I soon got jealous or something like that and wanted to learn. So at first, I learned all the basics from Shannon Kerpics' friend, Ginger Petty.

Only a couple of months later I was sent over to Shannon and began competing on her Dixieland dolls elementary team almost immediately. I was about 14 when 8 of us from the Dixieland dolls started our own team called southern magic. That didn't last long, only about a year to a year and a half... but we were all really cute:)

When I was 16 I got a call from Scotty Bilz who was trying to form a new competition team and my sister and I started dancing with him on Clog N' FX. We had lots of fun with Connie and Scotty, but I decided to take a break for a couple of years while I was in college. Of course, then I missed it too much. My sister had stated dancing with Blake on the southern belles and I hated just being a spectator. So at 21 I joined the belles. I haven't directed or taught really throughout my experience. Most of the time choreography on all the teams has been a huge group effort - if that counts? Fortunately each team I've been on has been successful in competition and I was lucky enough to have been taught from the beginning from one of the best, Shannon, so I never had too difficult of a time adjusting or learning new things. For that I'm very grateful.

DTT: How has clogging changed from the time you first became involved in the activity?

Blake: Clogging has taken us from the traditional roots of square dancing to the modem MTV video look. When I first began clogging, the style was very traditional and few, if any other dance forms were incorporated. When I danced on the Dixie Land Dolls, we began adding jazz into our line routines and also began using pop music. Now even more changes have been made. The emphasis has strayed from the amount "clogging" steps to the amount of "dance" steps a routine uses. The footwork is intricate and involves many types of dance which makes it more interesting and entertaining for everyone.

Jodi: When I first began dancing everything was more traditional, from footwork to music selection. Within the first couple of years of my dance experience, clogging changed with the introduction of buck dancing and Canadian step dancing. Traditional music was soon replaced by hip hop and more modern selections chosen for the routines. Costumes have also changed. Again, they have gone from being more traditional, where all the girls would wear skirts or dresses to now where everything is a little more unisex in general, or at least more modern all around.

Mike: Today, the steps are a lot more intricate. Lots of toe steps and most footwork is very complex and not easy to learn.

DTT: Tell about the Dance Fever experience (How did it come about, tell about the trip and the progression to the finals, your impression of Las Vegas and the show)... Mike: We heard about the auditions the day before. I called the guys and we got together for practice the night before. We made through the two round audition process and moved on to Vegas. The trip was incredible. We were treated like stars from the minute we got there. Where ever you went, people knew who we were. It was an awesome feeling. Once we won our semifinal round, all that stuff escalated. We were recognized almost everywhere we went. When we saw Hammer and Jamie King and people like that in different places, they spoke to us first and really made us feel welcomed in their group. The atmosphere of Vegas and the entire trip was an amazing experience that I will never be able to replace. Jodi: I was first approached by a friend of mine that works for a production company to go try out for dance fever. I disregarded it completely and dropped the subject thinking that it wouldn't be the type of show that would embrace clogging. Then, my boss came to me one day and asked me if I had heard of the show and about the auditions that were taking place in Atlanta, just down the street from my office. He actually used to work for the production company that produces the Miss America pageant, which is also the one that produced dance fever. He told me I should go and that his old friends had told him about the show and that they were really looking for more unusual or different styles of dance, and not just hip hop. So I called Candice and got her in on it with me and then we called Blake and Beth to see if they'd be interested in auditioning. We had two days to get a routine together for it. The audition was nerve racking but cool. We got a call back after only dancing about 1 minute of our routine and then came back the second day along with the 65 other call backs in Atlanta and auditioned again. We didn't get the confirmation call that we were truly going to Vegas until a week later. We had to have 3 routines at 1.5 minutes and 3 other 30 second versions of those routines prepared for the show as well as costumes to choose from. We flew out to Vegas the next week with out having any of them prepared. I was in Myrtle Beach with Stan at the beach jam and Blake and Beth were performing at Silver Dollar City in Branson so there was no way to practice all together beforehand. We had to put everything together once we got there. Our practice started late in the evening and luckily we've all danced together for so long that it really didn't take much time to get our stuff down. Blake had done our music on her laptop on the way....we put all of our heads together and worked as a really good team to get it done. Our first rehearsal was Thursday at 7:45 am, and we taped our episode on Friday. It was definitely the most surreal experience I've ever had. It was certainly no vacation, but I wouldn't change a thing. How many times do you get the chance to be judged by MC Hammer, Carmen Electra, and one of the most talented choreographers in the biz - Jamie King? For them to only compliment us on everything we did was amazing. My biggest fear was for them to find one annoying thing that we did and focus on it and somehow make fun of us. Clogging costumes aren't always accepted so easily by others and some of us have funny facial expressions:) but that didn't happen....we won our episode - another great moment. We then went on to prepare 2 more routines (or 4 including the 30 sec. ones) for the final show which was taped the following Tuesday. But there wasn't much time for independent rehearsals. They had us scheduled throughout the day in

interviews and watching the other show tapings, etc. It was rough. We ended up throwing out our 3rd routine. Stress and lack of sleep got the best of us and it showed in our final tech rehearsal. That was fine since our first 2 were really good. The last show taped and I honestly thought we would've placed higher than 5th, but I'm not complaining one bit. It was nice to be there with good friends -- all that -- and I'm glad that not just 1 but 2 groups of cloggers did such an amazing job on a national television show.

Blake: I received an email about the audition weeks before hand, but had forgotten about it until Jodi called me up and said "hey, do you want to do this audition?" We immediately jumped at the opportunity. We had 2 auditions and then had to wait a week or 2 for them to call and let us know whether or not we were going to Vegas. We finally got the call and headed to Las Vegas soon after.

Once we got there, the 4 of us had a lot of work to do because we had seen each other since the last audition (close to 3 weeks). We had to put together 3 routines; one of which had to be ready by the next day. I pretty much had the music edited by time we got to Vegas, but we did have to make several changes along the way. We worked quickly and got everything under control.

DTT: How did the producers and dance professionals affiliated with the show react to clogging before you danced and after?

Mike: Before we danced, I don't think anyone knew what to think. Nobody had really seen clogging before. After we danced, they were amazed. What they saw impressed

them to the fullest and I don't think anyone expected to see what they got. The respect that we gained immediately was irreplaceable.

Blake: Throughout the competition, I never had winning the money on my mind. I was more interested in impressing the 3 judges and receiving positive feedback from them. The judges were not told what talent we would be performing before we actually started. All 4 of us thought that since they had already seen "ALL THAT" perform it might affect us winning our episode...we thought they may not want two "clogging" groups to win. The fact that our style is a little different and the fact we are girls helped us out, and showed a different side of clogging.

DTT: What has the reaction been to your performance?

Blake: When we did our performance it was unlike any other. We had an energetic crowd yelling for us, cameras following us around the stage and 3 celebrities watching our every move. It was incredible! After we performed, the judges seemed to be blown away with our abilities. It was an awesome feeling to know that MC Hammer & Jamie King, who critique other celebrities talents on a daily basis, are impressed with your talent.

Mike: The reaction has been crazy. I get recognized in the mall and different stores by people who didn't know who I was before the show. We were in a club on my birthday and a girl came up to myself, Brian and Delohn and told us how good we did on the show. It makes you feel awesome to know that we had such a good effect on people.

Jodi: I knew the producers had never seen clogging except for in the Miss America pageant. Everyone associated with the show loved it. Most wanted to learn the basics and were so complimentary to us. Almost every group of performers had wonderful attitudes and was very accepting of other dance styles.

DTT: Performing at this level has to be stressful. How did you hold up to the hectic rehearsal and taping schedules?

Blake: After winning our episode and as the finals grew closer, things got a little stressful. I think that all contestants involved felt the stress. Throughout the entire event, I never felt that we were in "competition" with other group except ourselves. It was more about get a "good review" rather than who is better than who. I think that had to do with the fact that everyone had such a unique talent.

It was tough on our emotions not making it further in the finals than we did. I didn't cry like many of the contestants, and I tried to keep my chin up..I tried to be supportive of ALL THAT since they were representing clogging in the finals. It was just honor to make it that far and I was glad we had the opportunity.

Jodi: We received only positive reactions. Everyone I know that has never seen clogging can't get enough. They think it's the coolest thing. It's pretty flattering.

DTT: Placing in this national forum is an amazing accomplishment. How do you feel the exposure will effect the perception of clogging?

Jodi: I think people will actually understand what clogging is now, instead of the huge misconception that has always existed in the past. We fight the stereotype on a regular basis....we don't wear crinoline skirts and wooden shoes and dance in barns. And rocky top isn't the only song for cloggers. I'm not sure that clogging will ever have the exposure that other forms of dance have but I think there's something more out there for clogging - definitely. Maybe some shows in more places than just Branson or even something similar to Riverdance.....who knows? Mike: I think it will help a great deal. Until now, clogging has struggled to get exposure. This was a big time show and I think a lot of folks saw it. I

don't think anyone could have seen the show and

still have that old time perception of clogging.

DTT: What happens for you and the members of your group now?

Mike: We wait. We have had several inquiries about our dancing along with offers to come to Vegas and dance. However nothing has seemed right yet.

But, we talk to MC Hammer a lot now. He is our Manager. Hopefully he will come up with some nice little offers for us before too long.

Jodi: I haven't danced since the show except for a performance for my work. I am already missing it. My sister recently quit for good because of other responsibilities such as work. I've always danced with her on every team I've been on. I've had a wonderful friendship with Stan Webb over the past year and I frequently visit Missouri. So it's only natural that now I want to dance with him and his team and I think that's the best thing for me right now. I'm not ready to quit since I know I've still got a few more years in me. It's really hard to give up a hobby that's been a huge part of your life for over 15 years!

Final thoughts:

Blake: Thanks so much to everyone involved in this opportunity. The producers of the show were absolutely great to us. They constantly told you what great talent you had and made the effort to get to know you a bit. We got to hang out with them outside of the taping and got to hear their thoughts on the show. It's nice to hear when some of the producers and camera crew tells you they thought you should have won. I am always touched by hearing things like that.

It was tough leaving Vegas and I didn't want it to be over. The trip was tiring and stressful, yet exciting and very memorable. I enjoyed the atmosphere of it and the stardom most. I know we made an impact on the dance world and that's what we set out to do. We have received several opportunities to perform since being on Dance Fever. I only hope that even bigger things come from this and benefit not just us, but everyone involved in clogging.

Mike: The main thing is this. A lot of people are upset that we didn't win and, of course, we are disappointed. But we had an amazing time in Vegas and I think we gave clogging some well deserved exposure. The people we got to meet and hang out with was enough to make us feel like we won a much greater prize. We just want to say thank you from the bottom of our hearts for all of the support that cloggers have given to us. In my mind, having impressed you is more important to me than anything those judges could have said to us anyway. So once again, THANK YOU!



Appalachian Flatfooting Stays Alive at Virginia Contest

GALAX, Va. — Kenny Monahan hadn't been on this side of the yellow tent before. This was the working side of the Old Fiddler's Convention, the side where farmers and schoolteachers transformed themselves into stars, whispering their songs one last time before taking the stage.

Monahan, 36, had come for Saturday's dance competition. So did 150 others. "Turn it on," Monahan said with a grin. "Let's turn it on."

Galax's convention, which boasts one of the oldest and biggest celebrations of old time and bluegrass music in the country, draws thousands of amateur dancers and musicians each year.

Short and thick in the legs, Monahan is built more like a high school linebacker than a dancer. But like anyone who is good, he's able to cheat gravity a little. His feet skip and slide across the floor as if moving on ice.

What he's doing is called "flat foot," a style that's best defined by what it doesn't do than what it does. The arms don't swing and the hands don't clap. The legs and knees don't buck in the air as in Irish clogging.

Flat foot is about control. The feet tickle the floor like fingers on a piano. Everything above the waist should be as still as possible.

Like much of Appalachian culture, flat foot dancing draws from Scots-Irish styles brought here centuries ago when immigrants came to the mountains.

Over the years, it has become American, influenced by traditional black dancing and a mishmash of steps that

developed in the last 100 years, said Roddy Moore, director of the Blue Ridge Institute, a cultural center at Ferrum College.

People who can still do it learned their steps on their own, shuffling their feet on kitchen floors with their parents and finding their rhythm at the weekend square dances held in small towns throughout the highlands. Purists worry that the flat-foot style is fading away as youngsters continue their fascination with the stomps and kicks and choreographed steps of clog dancing, most recently inspired by Irishman Michael Flatley and his "Riverdance."

The Galax convention, which the local Moose Lodge has organized for 68 years as its main fund-raiser, makes a point of holding a competition for flat-foot dancing only, though it's hard to tell whether anyone competing really knows what that means.

Monahan doesn't know exactly what kind of style he dances: "It's like electricity shoots up through me — my feet just move."






