



Clogging on the Grand Ole Opry

Director Bubba Richardson Talks with the Double Toe Times about the Opry Square Dancers, the Opry Show and its Stars and Clogging

I sat down with Bubba Richardson on a cool, rainy Nashville Day in November at the Big River Grill, just down the street from the historic Ryman Auditorium to talk about clogging and its place on the Opry. I have known Bubba for many years - way back to his early days with the Tennessee Flatfooters when his rubber legs would amaze everyone who saw him. Bubba is truly one of the most sincerely nice people you will ever meet in clogging. He is laid-back and soft-spoken, with none of the ego one might expect from someone who has been handed the responsibility of providing the face of clogging for the world-famous Grand Ole Opry. After our interview, we headed to the Ryman to get ready for the evening's performance. Bubba has asked me to join the group as a fill in dancer for the evening, and I was guite honored to do so. I had danced on the Opry stage with Ben Smathers several times back in the 1980's and also with Melvin Sloan, but this was a real treat to clog on the historic Ryman auditorium stage with the Opry Square Dancers.

The Ryman was the home of the Opry until the mid 1970's when Gaylord's Opryland was built. This "Mother Church" of country music was hosting the Opry once again during the Winter months in a special engagement. Space is at a premium at the Ryman. There is very little dressing space and even less to relax or socialize. The Square Dancers shared the restrooms with band members as a dressing area, until Bubba rounded up the troops and we headed to the 4th floor lounge to get a little more room and a place to run through the routines before the show. From this room high atop the building, you could peek through a trap door at the catwalks overlooking the stage and see and hear the action below. Some of the dancers I had known before and some I had seen from years of being an Opry fan. I have to thank my partner Marcia Campbell and the group for the patience they showed in teaching me the routines. haven't danced on a team in many years, but it was just like old times when the hoedown music started. Bubba has done an amazing job of

awe of the stage presence that these performers master. The audience is seated just inches from the stage and they lit up when the dancers came out. You could honestly feel the energy in the house. That's what makes the experience of the Ryman so special.

As we sat together in the waiting area between shows it was great to see how this family of dancers interacted. I was so awed by the energy and personality of Gary Giles and Codye Sanker and the others. What a delight to hear stories from Eddie Oliver, who has danced on the Grand Ole Opry for nearly 37 years! Eddie's father started dancing in 1952 with Ralph Sloan and the Tennessee Travelers. Eddie's uncle, two aunts and their neighbor rounded out the group. Eddie told how — when the group first started dancing on the Opry - there was a long board on wheels with chairs attached to it on stage at the Ryman and all of the dancers sat on those chairs. When it was time to dance, they just rolled the row back and went to town! Eddie remembered his first payment as an Opry performer, a \$5.32 check with the WSM logo on it. He couldn't have been prouder. "It was a good show back then," Eddie said, "Marty Robbins, Lester and Earl (Flatt and Scruggs), Faron (Young) and Ernest Tubb. Faron was such a cut-up. He used to go back and stick things in the curtain ropes so the backdrops wouldn't work. It was always something backstage."

And so went my evening with Bubba and the Opry Square Dancers. Eight Dancers. Four shows. Four flights of stairs down and four flights back up again between each one. And an evening I will never forget.



DTT: Tell us how you got started in clogging.

Bubba Richardson: I actually started playing the mandolin when I was ten years old. I didn't like to practice. It hurt my fingers. I still got to travel around the country because my sister played the fiddle and we went to bluegrass competition after bluegrass competition and I would have to sit there while she played. I saw this guy dancing – buck dancing actually. That's what they called it. His name was Danny Bell. I thought, "I can try that." After that, I started watching the dancers and learning. After a while I joined the Tennessee Flatfooters and I got into the clogging part. We traveled all over, to Maggie Valley, North Carolina and Fontana Village.

DTT: Did you take lessons in Tennessee after seeing the buck dancing?

Bubba: No. I never took lessons from anybody. When I was ten or eleven I used to look like I was having a seizure when I was dancing. I look at old videos and think "Who's that? That's not me! Oh, yes it is." So I worked on gluing my hands to my sides and actually looking like I was clogging.

DTT: How did you go from the Tennessee Flatfooters to the Grand Ole Opry?

Bubba: I got to go a lot of places with the Tennessee Flatfooters. I learned everything I know about square dancing from Ted Heavner. He learned a lot from Bill Nichols and everybody else from the workshops that he went and did. Melvin Sloan used to see dancers when he went out to the square dances. He used to come to Lebanon, Tennessee where there was a square dance every Saturday night. Our group had practice on Sundays and on weekends when there wasn't a competition or workshop we would go down there. Melvin needed an alternate for the Sloan dancers. I was going to college at UT in Knoxville, and I was no longer on a team. Melvin called and asked if I would fill in for a fellow who was no longer dancing. I did that for about two or three months and then Melvin hurt his foot and I was there for good. So, I guess I got on the team accidentally (laughs).

DTT: How long have you been dancing with the Opry Square Dancers?

Bubba: Right at fourteen years.

DTT: When you started, did you ever imagine that one day you would be managing the team?

Bubba: I never did. When I started I was scared to death and I was eighteen years old. I had danced with a team for years and had traveled to South America and around the country and had danced for a lot of people, but the Opry stage is pretty intimidating. There is so much history there.

DTT: Can you tell us about the make-up of the group now and what changes you have seen in fourteen years?

Bubba: Wow. It's amazing the changes. When I started dancing, there was Melvin, a lady by the name of Tonya Spicer who was from down where all of the buck dancing

was. Everyone danced straight-legged. It was real buck dancing — throwing your leg behind you — real, hard-core buck dancing. And the footwork went right along with the square dancing. Sometimes I felt like I was standing still compared to some of the others, they would kick so high. When I started there were still three dancers that had been with Ralph Sloan still dancing. Ralph's partner, Tanna Mosely, became my partner. That was really cool.

After that, there were more and more changes among the team. Melvin tended to bring in younger dancers. I got to the point that I was the old man of the team. (laughs) Eddie is still here. He is the only one that is still on the group that was there when I started. Marcia Campbell – she was Taylor back then – has also been on the group for a long time.

There have been a lot of changes, but the group still does Appalachian style dancing on the Opry. We square dance and do figures, but we are trying to add some modern stuff in there as well. We've gone from white shoes and white slacks, red checkered shirts and scarves tied in a knot on the left side to black shoes and black slacks and plain or solid colored shirts with sequins and something to catch the light.

DTT: How much freedom do you have in making choices on what type of choreography and dance styles you present on the Opry?

Bubba: Total freedom. I can do what I want in that area. As long as we aren't throwing people over our head. (laughs) Actually, there is one move we do sometimes – a lift – where we flip the girls over in the air. The audience always lets out a big gasp of air, and I do too! It's tricky on that stage.

Pete Fisher, the manager of the Opry, told me "It's your team and you can do what you like to" which is great.

There are some things I would like to try with the group. We get together once a week, and that is to perform, so there is not really any rehearsal time. I am pretty much of a perfectionist. If it doesn't look right, I'm not going to put it on the stage.

DTT: I am sure the Opry has a pretty consistent fan base of country music lovers through the years. With the success of "O Brother, Where Art Thou?" and the resurgence of traditional music, have you seen any change in the reception of clogging to audiences?

Bubba: The audiences have always been pretty consistent with the clogging. Sometimes it can depend on the audience. If you go on right after Garth Brooks, the audience is still on such a high that you can barely hear the music for the cheering. If you follow an Opry regular singing "Danny Boy" or a sad song, sometimes it is polite applause, but as soon as those feet start moving the audience starts making some noise.


DTT: What kind of preparation does the group go through for a regular Opry performance?

Bubba: The show starts at 6:30 pm. Hopefully, everyone is there and dressed by 6:15 pm and standing at the side of the stage. When the curtain comes up, as it has been for years, the cloggers dance over on the left side of the stage.

We dance for about a minute and a half. We dance the same rotation of routines each week, so everyone knows their part and I just have to yell "Turn" and it all just happens. We hear the music winding up and do "shave and a haircut" and the rest of the Opry continues after that. We have basically two routines that we do in the shows right now. We have them practiced and can walk through them before we go on stage and, usually, they go off without a hitch. Luckily, we don't have to prepare a great deal. I try about once a month to get the group together to work on some new stuff. With dancers driving in from everywhere, it is nice to have the routines that we are all comfortable with.

DTT: Tonight's performance is at the Ryman Auditorium. How is that different from performing on the regular Grand Ole Opry Stage?

Bubba: There is no room to do anything over here. (laughs) We do run-throughs in the side-street and dress in the rest-rooms. Everyone is cramped here but once you get on that stage it is the same feeling, just not as much elbow room! At the Opry House, sometimes we will have a big enough dressing room that we can actually run through dances in it.

DTT: Do you have a most embarrassing moment in fourteen years on the Opry?

Bubba: Myself? Oh, I've fallen about three times real good. I try to make it look like I meant to do that! I guess falling down is my biggest fear. If the floor is real slick I used to get in trouble because I would really hold back. I don't like falling down!

DTT: Are there any of the Opry performers that are really supportive of the cloggers or like to try a step or two themselves?

Bubba: They are all really supportive. Whenever Vince Gill is hosting a segment we usually get him out there to dance with us. Brad Paisley is a big supporter of us. He loves the dancers. So many of the regulars are great supporters, Porter Waggoner and others. Daryl Worley (Country music artist who recorded "Have you Forgotten")

can really cut a rug. He is a big tall fellow, but he can get a little flat-foot shuffle step going on. Buck White will run out there every once in a while and do a step. He can dance. Rebecca Lynn Howard is actually a clogger. She clogged in Kentucky and has her own shoes and everything. I dragged Patty Loveless out with us one night. Whoever is on that side of the stage might one night get a surprise! Of course, the crowd always loves it when one of them dances a little bit.

DTT: In addition to the Opry stars performing with you, you have had the honor of performing musically with some of them. What are some of the projects you have lent your dancing to as percussion or your voice to?

Bubba: The first thing I did was for Dolly Parton. Her record producer called and Dolly had decided to do her first bluegrass album and she wanted some tap sounds for a song she was

recording called "Marry Me." It was a great, laid back bluegrass song and Marcia and I went into the studio and they had a board with mics on it and we did a little flat-footing.

From that, Ricky Skaggs liked it, and we danced 900 mph (laughs) on his song "Shady Grove. It was probably the hardest work I had ever done. There were three of us on the same board. It was a little, bitty board. We had Stevens Stomper taps on and they have the two plates and when we stopped dancing there was that little extra "click" and he didn't want that, so we had to dance it over and over to get the right sound. It was a lot of work but it was fun. I enjoyed it a lot.

DTT: What do you see in the future for the Opry Square dancers?

Bubba: I just hope we keep going strong like we are. We had new costumes and a new look and some modern footwork. The Opry is on CMT now and attracting new and younger audiences and we just hope that we can inspire people to maybe try clogging or give them an appreciation of it. We don't dance the style of a lot of competition teams. Some of us have competed and do precision clogging, but the high energy freestyle really works for the Opry.

DTT: As GAC (Great American Country Channel) picks up the Opry broadcast, do you expect more opportunities for the clogging to be televised?

Bubba: I not a really pushy person as far as promoting the group. The connection with the audience is great, and if it gets on television that is even better, but only a portion of the show is televised so we give it all for the people in the seats every night.

DTT: I am really honored to get to dance with you tonight and I am looking forward to it. Thanks for talking to the Double Toe Times.

Bubba: Thanks, Jeff. We are looking forward to you dancing with us!



The Opry/Ryman Story The "Mother Church" of Country Music is Steeped in History

It is an entity unto itself. A phenomenon that has lasted through generations. And one that continues today. With 75 years under its belt, the Grand Ole Opry, the world's longest-running live radio program, shows no signs of slowing. Millions of Americans have been entertained through its live radio and television programs with the best country music has to offer.

The Opry was born on the fifth floor of the National Life & Accident Insurance Company building. The date was November 28, 1925 and legend has it that the featured performer for that show was Uncle Jimmy Thompson, an 80-year-old fiddler who had the reputation of knowing a thousand fiddle rounds. George D. Hay, one of America's pioneer radio showmen, was the announcer. He proclaimed himself "The Solemn Old Judge" and launched the WSM Barn Dance. Three years later, he gave it the new name the one that would stick - the "Grand Ole Opry." The show became very popular and soon even the studio couldn't accommodate the hordes of fans flocking to see the show performed live each weekend. The Opry was moved into a succession of three venues, each larger than the next. The numbers continued to average 3,000 or more and a move to the Ryman Auditorium in 1943 was a welcomed necessity. The Ryman, built in 1892, had perfect acoustics and would become the Opry's most famous home.


The Ryman's story is a compelling one, indeed. Built in 1892 as the Union Gospel Tabernacle, the Ryman was so named in 1904 upon the benefactor, Captain Thomas Ryman. Even before its Opry days, the tabernacle hosted some of the most renowned names in entertainment - Bob Hope, Katherine Hepburn and Mary Pickford, among them - as well as religious revivals. But it was its 31 year tenure as the home of the Grand Ole Opry (1943-1974) that would endear the Ryman to millions as the "Mother Church of Country Music."

Today, more than 25 years after the Opry moved from the Ryman to the Grand Ole Opry House, both the world's longest-running live radio show and its most famous former home are alive with activity.

Through the years, some of country music's most beloved artists have entertained as Opry cast members. With members including new stars, superstars and legends, the Opry is poised to take country music into the new millennium.

Annually, hundreds of thousands of Opry fans have traveled over oceans and from all 50 states to Nashville to see the weekend performances in person. Likewise, those same persons continue to drop by the Ryman Auditorium for a self-guided tour of the facility or to catch one of the many concerts or productions that now call the Ryman home.

Remembering Barbara Kohler

Clogging Loses one of its Classiest & Most Giving Personalities

Barbara Eriksson Sauls Kohler, 230 Turkey Creek Drive, Leicester, North Carolina, passed away September 18, 2003 after a long struggle with pancreatic cancer. She was born in Miami, Florida, graduated from Miami Edison High School and was a member of the Majorette Squad. She attended the University of Miami as a Drama/Dance major, performing at the Ring Theater, University of Miami, TV shows and was a Cheerleader. She and partner/husband Jack Sauls toured the US, Canada and South America as a dance team for MCA under the professional names Jan and Jack Archer. They owned and operated Jack Sauls Dance Studio in Hollywood, Florida. Both were involved in competition archery and both were Champions. After his death, Barbara began competing in Clogging Competitions and was National and World (age division) Champion for two years. Barbara formed local competition teams of children and adults called The Gold Coast Cloggers. They performed and competed throughout the South winning many titles. In 1985, Barbara opened and operated the Gold Coast Clogging Studio in Davie, Florida. Gold Coast Adults won the first Florida Championship.

Barbara married Hollywood Police Officer, Robert Kohler in 1969. In the '70's, she conceived and choreographed a musical review called "The Sunny Side of the Beat" for the Department as a public relations tool showing the daily rigors of Police Officers. The cast was made up of men and women and their mates. The proceeds were given to the YMCA in Hollywood, Florida.

Barbara and Robert moved to Asheville, North Carolina in 1989 after he retired from the Department. They owned and operated a restaurant named Stanley's' Bar-B-Q and Bluegrass which was known world wide and had a large following in Europe, the Far East and Mid Eastern countries. Shows were performed nightly with a live radio show on the weekend. She organized childrens Traditional clogging teams in the area as well. ("Appalachian Valley Cloggers", Burnsville, North Carolina., "Fancy Feet" in Fairview, North Carolina and the "Elk Mountain Cloggers" in Woodfin, North Carolina) She and Robert took the Fancy Feet to Austria in 2000 to perform at the Austrian Alps Festival. She also worked as an advisor with the Bailey Mountain Cloggers of Mars Hill College, North Carolina, and in 1997 they traveled to Europe with that group. In 1997, Barbara and three partners wrote and produced a stage show and video called "Mountain Legacy." Conceived and financed by World Champion dancer, Burton Edwards, it honored the traditions of mountain dance and song through the ages. The huge cast of dancers came from all over the United States. The video was sold world-wide.

Barbara is survived by her beloved husband of 34 years, Robert, and her treasured companion kitties, Tasha and Midnight.
