Get a "Real" Job...



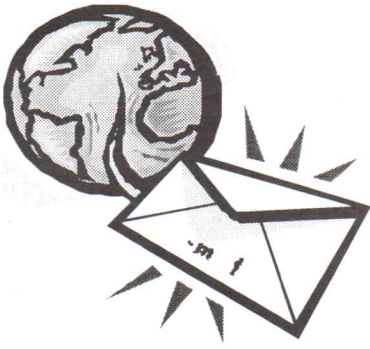
Okay teachers, let's be honest. How often have you been asked if clogging is what you do for a living or if you have a "real" job?

I remember when I first got the teaching bug. I had just returned from a workshop where I had been making up steps with a friend and we had gathered the courage to try to teach at the open mic hour. I came home with a desire to try classes. My parents offered their garage and I saved money to tile the floor, buy a secondhand air-conditioner and a record player from a school surplus store. I started a record collection that was becoming a major drain on my college pocket, but I wanted to follow this dream. The first classes were small, but I decided to branch out and try teaching at a local recreation building. An hour class was \$3.00 and a one-on-one private lesson was \$10.00 an hour. Some weeks I had as many as 10 private lessons a week in the evenings and classes nearly every night. The income was not great, and what profit I made was spent going to every workshop I could get to. As I began to teach regionally and nationally and do workshops, my classes at home grew as well. I remember one class at the Fox Hunters Club with over 100 students. At \$3.00 a student, I was finally paying the rent, but still I was putting my profits back into the hobby. I remember how proud I was of my first Hilton sound system and how much I babied it. I was putting over 100,000 miles a year on used cars to get to workshops. Some of my peers and I took the risk of starting some workshops of our own. Some over the years have become successful events that draw hundreds of people and have become profitable for us as partners. Others have lost thousands of dollars. Those are the risks you take in building a career. My investment in this publication has yet to profit me personally, but I am proud that it continues to grow and that it has provided an income for my mother who does the bookkeeping and data management. With persistence and hard work, it too may become another successful venture. It really pulled the rug out from under me when at my first major clogging event that was successful and well attended, a clogger who I had admired for many years came up to me and said "Boy, you have really sold out for the dollar. You should give your old friends a discount for this event." This person drives an SUV that cost more than the house I live in. Just like the parents at classes who complained that \$3.00 was too much for a class, I never found the right way to address the issue that what we offer as clogging teachers is a tremendous service and well worth the price.

I have many friends in the clogging world with similar ambitions and who have made tremendous investments in their hobby as a career. Some of the lucky ones have opened studios that have become very profitable. It is not -- however -- without a great deal of effort, and years of driving broken down mini-vans that are free buses for dancers to events and performances. They have wondered if their next set of classes will cover the rent on the hall or the mortgage on the studio they've built. Just like any business that is successful, they must raise their head high and not apologize for that success when it comes. Their hard work and persistence has paid off and they should enjoy the fruits of their labors and continue to offer quality instructor and recreation. Maybe that financial success will allow them to make up for the time they have lost with their friends and families while following that dream.

I no longer allow defeatists to make me feel guilty when I invest my own resources, time and talents to an event that becomes successful. Anyone knows that a person who puts on classes or events is hoping for success. If you offer value and people support you, you will be a success. Provide proper thanks and support to those who help you in your efforts. A friend in the dance industry offered a great answer for when someone tells you "it must be nice to make all this money clogging." Tell them "The classes are very successful this year and it allows me to offer more quality to the students. How are you doing financially?"

Making it Official

I have some very exciting news. I am not sure how much you know about the area where I live. (Salem SC) - Oconee County. My county is the home of Oconee State Park. Oconee State Park has a very long

history of clogging events, starting back long ago with Bill Nichols and Simone. Our county is also home to Lib Mills and Carl's Clogging Supply.

I starting clogging 32 years ago and have always danced every where I possibly had a chance- square dances, family reunions, on the streets in Cherokee where live music was played, I even recall people stopping my Mom in town and saying "Ain't that your little girl that clogs all the time" that would be my cue to start my show. I really did not have a chance - My Daddy has a bluegrass band, Saturday night dances and festivals was our life.

Around the age of seven I met a man named Bill Nichols. He and I were instant buddies. We always met up at the dances and would see who could step the highest!! My fondest memory was sitting on his knee at Fontana in 1978 when I won the world championship in my age division!! (I still have the picture of that)

As all kids do, I to strayed away from clogging to pursue the dreams of my youth. My oldest daughter brought me back to where I belong. While working night shifts at an area hospital, my Mom and Dad (still faithful to the Saturday night traditions) took Kelley with them. Not long after her 2nd birthday she began to look like someone I knew. Dancing everywhere she had a chance - even in town. My heart stings pulled me right back, where now, I know I was meant to be.

Three years ago I starting teaching Kelley and four of her friends in my basement. Now in 2004 I have a studio and an enrollment of 106 cloggers. (I teach ONLY traditional) My original basement team just finished 2nd in the peewee traditional line division at Maggie Valley, we went to Las Vegas in November, and on to the Junior Olympics this August.

I went around the world to get to this. I love traditional clogging and will always remember those who helped me along the way. I have many events at Oconee State Park, and I always keep it traditional. I feel blessed to have so many dancers and I want to make a difference in our county.

One day I had an idea - What would be something I could do to put clogging in the spotlight it deserves? I called our county office and asked if we had an official county dance. The reply was "no". I asked to be put on the next agenda.

Lib Mills and I took our notes and hearts full of love for the dance and made our stand. As I sat waiting on my turn my thoughts ran over 30 years of dance in a matter of minutes. As I faced 10 members of county council in stiff business suits, the words came easy because it came from my heart.

"Congratulations ladies, you have an official county dance". Lib and I looked like two kids at Christmas. My first thought was Bill Nichols. I could not wait for him to hear the news. I breathed a long sigh of relief. Clogging will now be a part of our county forever. No matter what changes in the future, November 3, 2003, it was adopted into Oconee County history as "our" dance.

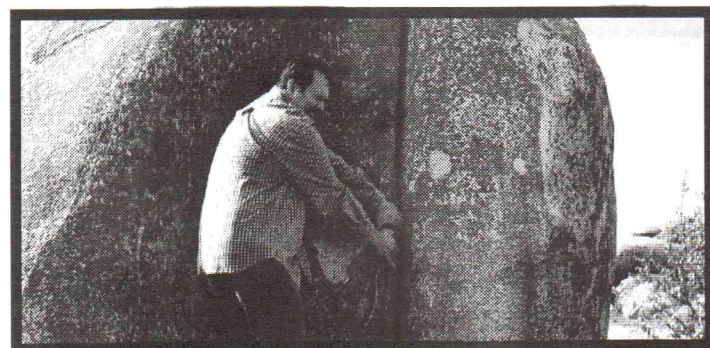
Reno Clogfest International

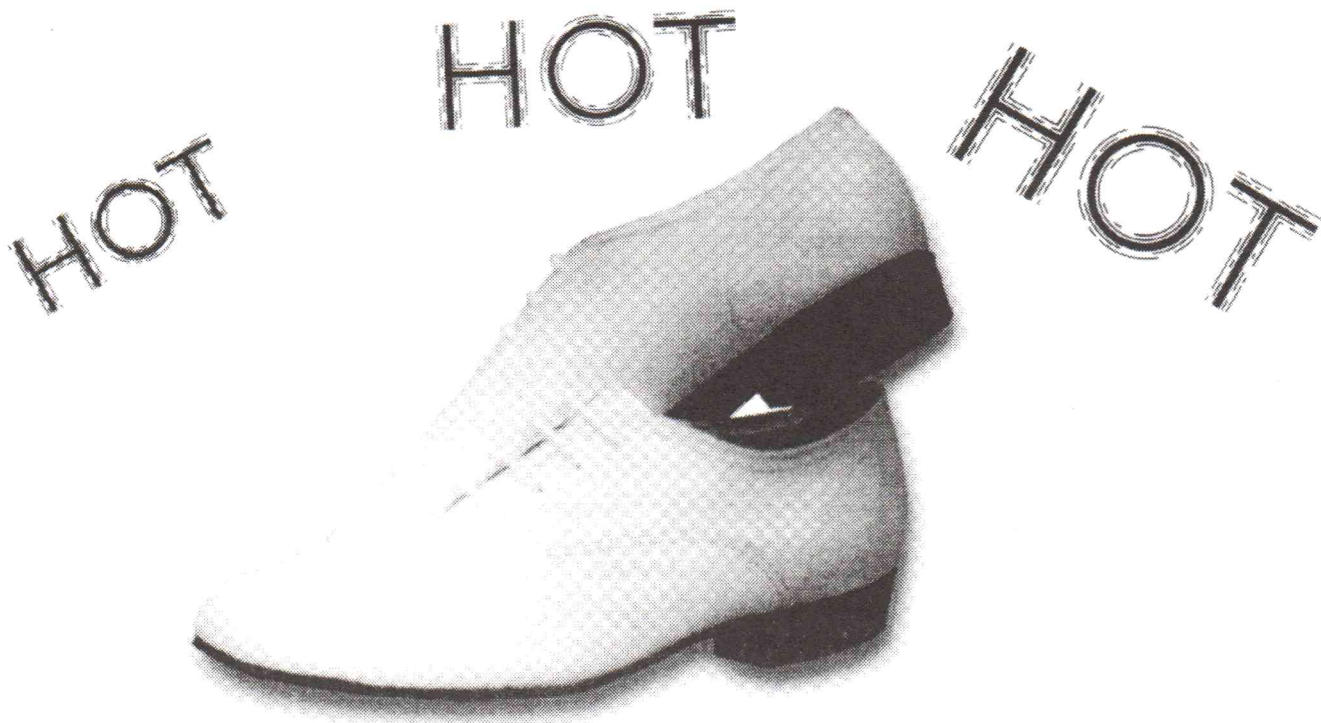
