

Jumping For Joy

After learning clogging at age 65, Howard Hummer of California wins National honor at 82

Howard Hummer grins as he talks about hearing himself described by a young boy as "a neat old guy ... just kicking up his heels."

Hummer said the boy, about 10 years old, had been watching him rehearse prior to a dance competition at the Orange County Fair a year ago. Hummer recalled hearing the boy tell people in an other dance group about Hummer's fast-stepping dancing called clogging.

"I got a kick out of that," Hummer said.

Though his house and garage are stacked with trophies, Hummer recently received a special honor from Showstopper, a national group that sponsors the American Dance Championship competitions. During the association's 25th annual finals in July at the Disneyland Hotel, Hummer won the overall national champion title for those over 70. He also got 'what he describes as "the biggest dang trophy I've ever seen."

Also, Hummer received a special recognition, the Showstopper's National Talent Competition American Dance Achievement Award, for his contribution to dance. "It's quite an honor," Hummer said, holding the plaque in his hands.


Hummer has danced at the Hollywood Palladium and Hollywood Bowl and at Disneyland in addition to many competitions. Also, he has been on CNN and ABC news clips. He has served as president of the Southern California Clogging Association.

Hummer discovered clog dancing at 65 when he visited the Los Angeles County Fair. The demonstration mesmerized him.

Now 82, and in spite of the silver hair and being a member of the senior set, he's still stomping away in competitions and shows around the county. He performs and competes as an individual and with his dance troupe, The Hemet Social Security Stompers.

"I guess I have kind of a missionary zeal about clogging, but I like to make people happy," he said. "I talk with my feet."

Some of the talking his feet do includes dance steps such as "rubber legs," "ankle breakers" and "the drag." His



signature move is leaping quickly from a flat-footed position, bringing both feet up behind him and slapping his ankles.

As a young man, Hummer was interested in show business. Instead, he attended the University of Arizona as a political science major, sharing classrooms with former Sen. Bob Dole and Secretary of the Interior Stuart Udall: Rather than enter politics, he became a contract pricer in the aerospace industry, but says he never lost his interest in show business.



CCA Showdown 2004 Countdown To Showdown!

The day started with a lot of promise – nice, sunny day... save for the cold wind. The people of Chattanooga were nervous – with a temperature of 50 degrees, and the threat of snow looming, it was going to be a rough day. For those from the north, including the teams in town from Minnesota, Michigan and Ohio, it was like a heat wave!

Fridays competition included the Amateur and Challenge Solos, as well as all Duos and Duets. The plan was to narrow the competition down to the final competitors with the final competition taking place the next evening, on the main stage.

We danced solos well into the afternoon, but the suspense was going to have to kill us. The Division Winners were crowned, and the solo competition was put on hold.

Then quickly followed the duos, as well as the duets. It was certainly an impressive thing – knowing that the very best of the very best were currently taking the stage. After much dancing, the champions were crowned. Jamie Conyers and Megan Stull were named Overall Duo, and Mike Curtis and Kelly Goodpaster took Overall Duet. But who would be the national champion? Only time would tell...

The next morning, the competition had moved to a new stage. With television monitors set up by the stage, the CCA took care to make sure that no matter where you were in the auditorium, you'd have a clear shot of the action that day! And, they used the screens for a very neat display before the event began — they advertised every qualifying event, and showed pictures of the Overall Amateur and Challenge teams, prompting many rounds of "Hey, we're on the screen!" from the groups in the audience.

All categories of competition were danced before awards were given – Amateur was danced, then Challenge. Teams came from all over the country – Minnesota, Michigan, Ohio, Indiana, Nebraska, North Carolina, South Carolina, and Kentucky. And, they came with their game faces on, for sure!

What makes this competition different, for those that have never attended, is the way that the dance order is determined. At most competitions, the categories are danced in the order that the teams entered the event – the first group to enter that category is the last group to dance in that same category.

At competitions during the year, the teams that place overall win "Star Points". These points are then used to determine the order that the teams dance at the Showdown – the team with the most points is the last team to dance.

Now, it'd all come down to this...with everyone on the edges of their seats with anticipation, it'd come time to crown the National Champion teams for the year.



Instructor Profiles

Tony Burgess, Charleston, WV

Tony Burgess began dancing in 1979. He received his first diploma for beginner clogging at a class at the YWCA. A year or two later people asked him to teach. He has probably taught over 4,000 people to clog since then.

His first classes were held in Frame, West Virginia with 65 students attending. He has since taught at Glenwood Elementary in Charleston, West Virginia and a little place in Nitro, West Virginia called Cin-San Auditorium (named after the owners daughters, Cindy and Sandy).

Tony began a group called the Mountain State Stompers in the early 1980's, which performed for benefits and fund-raisers, fairs and competitions around the state of West Virginia. Tony always liked clogging because it is fun, he gets to meet people and stayed physically fit. In addition to teaching clogging and running a team, Tony was also a mountain square dance caller. This is the old-style big set, a big circle or mountain square dance. Tony always tried to preserve the old time clogging while mixing it with the new clogging. The weekend clogging sessions at Cin-San created a natural gathering point for cloggers. On any given Friday or Saturday night, hundreds of cloggers and bluegrass music enthusiasts would gather at Cin-San for freestyle clogging and Appalachian style square dancing. Cin-San is also where Garland Steele would call from time to time, and Jeff Driggs cut his teeth on old-time calling at that same microphone.

It has now been 20 years since I began clogging in Charleston, West Virginia. I never really wanted to take clogging lessons. I really didn't know what it was. My mom and some of my aunts talked me into going to an elementary school downtown and taking clogging lessons from Tony Burgess. I fell in love with clogging, and was dancing on a team within 4 months or so. I joined Tony's Mountain State Stompers team. He would give lessons 2 nights a week. A beginner class followed by an intermediate class. Every Saturday night he would be down at CinSan for the bluegrass dances. Tony would not only dance but he would call circle dances. When the bands would take a break he would turn his music on and everyone who knew the line dances that he of course had taught them would jump up and dance the whole break.

Once a month, the Mountain State Stompers clogging team would have a dance to raise money for the team. The team would always perform and do funny skits. At one of these dances is where we first did the line dance "Flashdance", choreographed by Tandy Barrett.

Now remember, this is West Virginia, where clogging is very traditional. We wore black leather mini skirts with torn sweatshirts, while the only 2 men brave enough to do this — Tony and Ryan — had on leather pants and torn shirt. The crowd loved it.

Tony was always ready to listen to ideas from the team and try whatever made the team better. Tony was a great friend with Tandy

Barrett of Georgia; this exposed us to a wonderful person and choreographer. The teams I direct now still dance "Tandy's Dandy" that she wrote for the Mountain State Stompers so many years ago. It stands the test of time.

Tony was also the one who introduced me to workshops on a regional and national level. He was a member of the teaching staff at the first C.L.O.G. convention in Mobile, Alabama.


Sadly, Tony has since been forced by a progressive illness to stop dancing. His wife Camille has been taking care of him. She has brought him to several dances at LKM (CinSan renamed) in the past months. I have to say he can still remember how to do a circle dance and dance Rocky Top. Tony has to stop and rest but the love of the dance is still with him. I want to thank Tony Burgess for giving me the opportunity to be involved in clogging all these years. I have met so many nice people and been to many wonderful places. In the Charleston area, when Tony stopped clogging a little part of clogging died. I try to bring the excitement and commitment to clogging as he did but I have a long way to go. Thanks, Tony, for everything!



Miss Clogging in the Carolinas

Everyone has his or her feelings about beauty pageants. For whatever reason, you have formed your opinions. The same is true about clogging. For me, these two are a large portion of my life, a part of my life that I really enjoy. And are hopefully combined into one event.

Almost every year since age 16 I have been a contestant in the Miss American Clogger Pageant and every pageant within a 50 to 75 mile radius of my house. Also, being with the same clogging team and instructor for 18 years tells you my feelings about clogging, competition and performing. It is not always possible to find a pageant with a talent segment or more specifically a clogging pageant. But last summer while doing a search on the Internet for clogging or beauty pageants, a web page for Miss Clogging in the Carolinas was listed. I read about Gary Kirkman's clogging pageant preliminary in Mt. Airy, North Carolina.

I had to find out more about the competition and the instructor. Gary is an instructor who lives in Winston-Salem, NC. After discussing qualifications, fees and host hotel, Gary explained that this was an area he wanted to explore. He has organized clogging workshops and competitions during the past few years and wanted to have a representative at the North Carolina clogging functions by way of Miss Clogging in the Carolinas. This would start by a competition held in Mt. Airy, NC after the Gary's Beating the Back 2 School Blues workshop held August 9, 2003. The preliminaries would narrow down the contestants to ten girls/ladies of all ages that would move on to the finals. This wasn't necessary; there were only nine entrants.

In the preliminaries each dancer would be judged on their performance in rise 'n shine and then a 3-5minute solo performance. 3 - 5 MINUTES!!! Mayberry RFD was getting brutal. After our performances we were given a packet that outlined the final competition, our music for our solos that could only be choreographed by each dancer, and an essay. This was a great experience, a learning experience, and one where I met a new group of cloggers. But this was just the preliminary; next it is on to the final competition.

Final competition was held in Julian NC at "The Barn Dance", an actual Grand Ole Opry type barn built inside a very large building in a rural area of Julian. The pageant was held after the Ho Ho Hoedown workshop December 13th. Seeing everyone again was fun and brought back the stress and nerves. The essays were turned in at the door where Gary's mother gave us our wristband and instructions. Time

was passing quickly and soon it was time to dress for the competition. This time the competitors were down to six. We were introduced to the workshop attendees who were very supportive but Gary was our biggest fan. He made us feel special. The star treatment! Gary's favorite question throughout the day was "Are you nervous?"

In the final leg of the competition the contestants would have a 3-minute routine to the same music - techno Rocky Top. Each contestant let out a groan when the first note was played for the speed check. None of us ever wanted to hear that song again! As each dancer's number was called all the girls cheered that contestant on, after all you knew your turn was coming. Before we knew it the talent portion was over and the judges were huddled for the final decision. Who is going to travel to all the workshops and represent clogging in the Carolinas? Who would have their fees paid to Miss American Clogger? Who would wear the beautiful crown?

It was taking forever and watching their faces for clues didn't give away anything. The three judges finally made their choices and left the paperwork in Gary's hands. We were called back up to the stage, each of us had our eyes on the crown and scepter.

Again Gary says "Are you nervous?" Then that nervous churning feeling in your stomach starts in anticipation of the results. And the judge's decision is: Shae Fuller-Jones, Ms. "Clogging in the Carolinas", Ashley Storey - 1st Runner-Up, Melissa Savage - 2nd Runner-Up.


