I don't remember the source, but I've heard it said that once something is considered a tradition, it is dead. Some would suggest that we have talked our traditional dance to death.

I remember as a school kid in West Virginia learning to square dance in gym class. We squared up in the Winter months when it was too cold to go outside and the Health teacher presented the class with such stoney indifference that the only reason to get excited was if you got to hold hands with a pretty girl. Having grown up square dancing (but certainly not telling my friends or buddies I played ball with) I knew that it was much more than our gym class exercise, but I was too shy then to let the joy I knew in my heart for dance shine out for anyone to see and judge. What fun we missed because we chose to groan and shuffle our feet.

Thomas Carlyle said, "What an enormous magnifier is tradition! How a thing grows in the human memory and in the human imagination, when love, worship, and all that lies in the human heart, is there to encourage it."

Think of the traditions that you hold dear. So many are done because we know that our belief and love in them will endear them to our families. The traditions bind us to our loved ones before us.

Maybe the parts of the clog dance that we love will grow within the imagination of our youth if we apply the power of our hearts and energies to them with the same zeal that we defend our family traditions.







Fond of Fontana


Noted Clogger Pam Collins looks back over 40 years of Fontana memories

I thoroughly enjoyed the return of clogging workshops to Fontana Village in North Carolina. It was more than a festival... It was a family reunion. I am planning to be back next year with my Palmetto State Cloggers. I've already given them the date and told them not to make other plans at that time! The experience brought me back to my own early days in clogging and the experience of Fontana

It was great to see Bill Nichols and my parents talk about old times. You see, we first came to Fontana in 1964 and Bill was the photographer for Fontana. My folks and I had just moved from Alabama to South Carolina where my father worked with Electrolux. (At 83 years young he is still with the company.) As an employee sales promotion, you could win this trip to a place in the mountains called Fontana. I was EXTREMELY shy when dad won the first trip in 1964.

The square dance at the Recreation Hall was held the first Monday of our trip. There I sat, a thirteen year old SHY girl, with my parents and brother, Danny. My mother insisted my brother and I participate in the square dance! A sister DOES NOT want to participate with her brother in a square dance. I remember that I did... to please my mom. I had never seen square dancing, nor ever heard 'bluegrass' music. I was raised on classical music growing up in New Orleans









'Tex' Brownlee was the caller. He and his wife came to Fontana every summer from their home in Florida.

After several square dances, there was announcement from 'Tex' to clear the floor. "We have a group of young folks who are going to do some clogging for you. Let's give them a warm welcome, the Fontana Village Cloggers."

It was LOVE at first sight for me. The penny loafers, bell bottom pants -- they looked "normal" to this thirteen year old — and they sounded like nothing I had ever heard before. The tune played by the "Fontana Ramblers" was the greatest tune I'd ever heard. It beat the 'overtures' I'd grown up with.

I'd find out later it was a tune with the same state name I just moved from, "Alabama Jubilee." The song is still my favorite! Well, by the next year I had gathered up some courage from somewhere to ask one of the 'stars' (as this is what those cloggers were to me in my eyes) how to do what they were doing. The previous year I had picked up on a 'double-toe step'. There WERE NO names back then, you just did it.

I continued going to Fontana and spending my summers there. My dad kept winning trips to Fontana. I did not realize until many years later that my dad had not always won all the weeks that we stayed, and had worked extra hours just to make sure I got to go, because it was the first time my folks saw some-thing I really loved. I will always be forever grateful to them for this! Throughout the 60's I clogged with the Fontana Village Cloggers and on into the 70's. I met a girl from Florida whose father was an artist, Peggy Nichols. We got in the Recreation Hall during the day and invented steps... the Samantha, Sam, Follow-up, Real McCoy and many more. We taught free workshops during the day of the Big Mountain Square Dance that would later occur that evening. They were always held on Monday, Wednesday, and Saturdays.

Peggy Nichols was my inspiration. She took time with me, and introduced me to choreography. At the time I never knew what a life long impact that would make on me. Peggy had a friend I met back in the late 60's named Boo Ruch. During the breaks in the square dances, they would perform a duet. I was mesmerized by their timing and choreography, but at that time I did not know what I was seeing what would later be something of great significance. Boo would become an innovator for 'show' choreography. Peggy is now an artist herself.

My years at Fontana would see the first World Clog Dance Championships. I would win my first clogging World title there. I would get married, and take my husband there. We took our children there. They grew up clogging there.

I met a very young Burton Edwards there with the 'Magnum Cloggers'. That is where I first saw Jon Hasler with the Pride & Joy Cloggers of Indiana. Our would cross again later, as Jon and I both won over-all Grand Champion Male & Female at the 1st Annual Hee Haw International Clogging Championships held in Nashville, Tennessee. Burton would win overall male at the same competition years later, as would other visitors to Fontana, -Keith Brady and Jay Ledford, among more. Does Fontana hold something 'magical' for cloggers? Do you remember the Grandfather Mountain Cloggers? Kentucky Hoedowners? I honestly feel that we had all been at Fontana in the 'good ole days' and somehow were blessed by the experience.

I fondly remember teaching at the Possum Hollers, and I remember Jeff Driggs as an inspirational instructor through the years. When my family visited Fontana and attended the Fontana Jamboree last September, it was the first time my parents and I had both been back at the same time since the 70's. It was indeed emotional. Because of Fontana, Peggy, and Boo, and all the cloggers to come throughout all those years, I teach clogging and have now for 38 years.

Bill Nichols, Marie and a two year old Simone put on a clogging demonstration one of those summer evenings many years ago. We all met Bill, and have always admired him.

I have photo albums full of photos of best friends on vacation with me in Fontana playing putt-putt, playing guitars in the Talent Night, and probably the largest collection of photographs of the Dam at every angle covering 39 years! (ha ha)

Well, I appreciate you allowing me my little sentimental journey of the Fontana years. I go way-y-y back, long before workshops were organized.

I am so glad to see a Clogging Jamboree at Fontana once more. I hope it will bring that joy to cloggers who never had that opportunity to grow up in Fontana.

Georgia Clogging Teacher Trades Lives with Ski Instructor in Reality TV Show

Clogging Instructor Heather Kohberger of Georgia got the unique opportunity to trade places with someone as part of the ABC Family reality series "Switched UP!"

Heather traded lives with Kemp, a ski instructor and supervisor at Northstar Ski Resort at Truckee, CA (Lake Tahoe) for four days. As Heather spent her time in Kemp's life, Kemp learned what it was like to take care of Heather's son Zachary and teach her clogging teams. His time included a trip to the Blueridge All Star Clogging Competition in Clemson, SC.

Heather Kohberger teaches with her sister, Blake Bartlett, at their dance studio, Clogging Connection, just outside of Atlanta, GA. They have been teaching together for more than 15 years. Heather and Blake are the directors of competition and exhibition Clogging Teams, including the National

Champion Southern Belles. Heather and her husband Phil were blessed their first child, Zachary Philip, on December 29, 2002. Heather is a nationally Certified Clogging Instructor, a member of the National Clogging Leaders Organization, the Georgia Clogging Leaders Association, and the Clogging Champions of America.

Heather has had the privilege of performing and instructing at various worldwide venues. In July of 1991 she traveled with Clogging Express of Valdosta, GA to perform for 10 days at Switzerland's 700th Birthday Celebration. In November of 1998 She and her sister Blake were selected to attend Austria's International Folklore Festival as instructors. In June of 2002 the Southern Belles were invited to represent the USA at CIOFF's Asia Oceania Folklore Festival in Seoul, Korea.

The Double Toe Times caught up with Heather at the Spring Fling Workshop in Gatlinburg, Tennessee. DTT: Congratulations on your recent experience with "Switched Up." Tell us about how this fun opportunity came about.

Heather: The "Switched Up" opportunity came about when one of my adult students appeared on the show

"Extreme Makeover" and the film company that produced her segment also does "Switched Up." They came to the studio to film her and fell in love with clogging and in talking to us loved the story of how we started the studio and what we do and they said I would make a great story for "Switched Up." After that everything kind of fell into place and they called and offered me the opportunity and I said "Of course!"

DTT: Tell us a little more about the concept of the show. Heather: The premise is that two people simulataneously trade lives for a period of three or four days and you pretty much dive into the other person's world head on.

You try to take on as many aspects of the other person's life as you can at one time.

DTT: Did you know ahead of time what you would be switched up to do, or was it a surprise?

Heather: I did not know ahead of time. You find out


about 20 minutes before you leave where you are going so that you know what type of climate to pack for. They tell you the person's first name and the town they live in and you don't find until you meet the people in their life what they do for a living or for recreation.

DTT: The big question: What were you switched up to do?

Heather: I was switched up to be a ski instructor at NorthStar Ski Resort in Truckee, California which is Lake Tahoe. Kemp—the guy that I switched up with—is not only a ski instructor, but he is the ski school Supervi

sor, so he had a lot of responsibility and a lot to keep up with. DTT: Had you skied before?

Heather: When I was about 13 or 14 I skied in Gatlinburg, Tennessee and then again in Boone, North Carolina while I was in high school, but I was not very good and I remember it being a very negative experience. It really was learning from scratch. The fact that I water ski and dance and have good balance was a big help and I felt like I learned pretty well. I had four coaches around at all times, so that's the way to learn! His roommates were all ski instructors and they all took the day off work to coach me every step of the way. They spent the day teaching me how to ski and then that afternoon I had to teach a class myself. It really wasn't that bad because I simply had to spit back out all of this great advice that I had been given all day. Being a clogging instructor, it was applying instruction techniques to a different art form. The people that Kemp surrounds himself with are amazing. Two of his roommates are Australian, one is French and one is Slovakian. What surprised me is that the skiers have an amazing sense of family. We are used to that in clogging, but it was a pleasant surprise to feel that same feeling among that group as well. DTT: What was it like being a beginner skier and trying to teach others?

Heather: I am sure it will end up in the show that I kept telling the students that I was going to teach them how to fall down. Luckily, I really didn't fall down as much as I thought I would. I was surprised. I found out later that a lot of the times that I fell was because of the guys tripping me up. (laughs) They wanted to get some footage of me falling so the guys would step on the back of my skis to get me to fall down.

DTT: You said being a clogging teacher was helpful to you in teaching skiing. What skills did you find most helpful? Heather: The biggest quality was balance and weight distribution. In clogging, we change weight on our feet so quickly and that skill was really helpful in teaching skiing. Tom, the instructor who worked with me, was blown away that he didn't have to interject once. He said I taught a more thorough lesson than most of his first year apprentice instructors.

DTT: While you were teaching skiing, I take it a ski instructor was teaching your clogging classes and teams... Did you know how it was going as the days went on or did you find out at the end of the experience what had happened?

Heather: I found out little bits. I tried not to. When I called home, it was mostly to check on my baby and check on the girls in competition and see how they were doing. It my first time away from Zachary and that was hard. It was tough having the kids somewhere without you and wondering how

they did. I hear he was a great sport and had a great attitude. He went in there and gave it 110 percent.

DTT: I understand Kemp joined the kids and danced onstage with them at a competition. How did that go?

Heather: Great. It was at the Blue Ridge Allstar Clogging Classic in Clemson, South Carolina. Kemp joined the Southern Belles onstage. He had learned to clog the day before and learned a routine, got a costume and shoes and in less than 24 hours from the time he had learned to clog was onstage at a competition. He gave it a great effort. He pretty much looked lost the whole time but he was having a great time and that's what counts.

DTT: Under his directorship, how did the teams do? Heather: The team did really well. They placed in every category and won a couple of grand champions. One of our amateur teams won overall amateur team of the day and it was the first time that group had won it. On top of that, add the "Switched Up" experience and the kids were just thrilled. Even weeks after it is all they talk about.

DTT: What was his reaction to switching up to clogging and motherhood?

Heather: I think he was more than shocked be find himself suddenly being a dance instructor and mom. When he found out his switch and that my name was Heather, he said he was expecting a parallel trading of places with a single young woman with a sorority house life or something more closely to his own life. When he pulled into my neighborhood and realized he was going to someone who lived a suburban lifestyle he was a little shocked. He and Zachary bonded right away. They went right to the dance studio and got started. He was really impressed with clogging and made the comment that more people really need to see this style of dance and it needs to get out there more. He really respects the dance form and said it was a lot of fun. I think he thought his challenge was simply to learn to clog. When they told him he had to get onstage and compete it caught him by surprise. DTT: When can we expect to see your "Switched

Up" experience to air? Heather: The show will air on ABC Family and is scheduled for late May.

DTT: Thanks so much for taking the time to talk to us, and congratulations on a great experience and thanks for all you do for clogging.

Heather: Thank you! It was a pleasure.


