Quiet on the Home Front



logging teachers are very seldom JUST clogging teachers. Most have families, part or full time jobs, a church and school life, and -- in rare cases -- a "social" life out side of clogging. It is really hard to not get personally involved with your students. Remember how much it meant to you to have encouragement from your own instructor when you learned? Your students look up to you. My goodness, some treat us like family or royalty. If you get the opportunity to be a guest teacher at another class, you might just feel like you get celebrity treatment.

With that level of admiration, people may come to you with not only dance related issues, but personal problems as well. As flattering as it is to have that kind of relationship with your dancers, it is best to establish a boundary and a comfortable way to let people know "I won't discuss things like that." Even though you invited all of these students into your professional life, always remember that you have the right to a private life as well. Establish a phone number or email address just for your clogging and keep your home number your HOME number. Most of us grew our clogging classes from a small class or even a home studio, but even with a small club or team, you can find that you are "on call" nearly 24-7.

When you are in a social setting with your dancers, don't let them monopolize your private time with talk about clogging issues. help but have the subject come up -- it's what we do! Just let things flow and learn when it's time to change the subject or just ask to talk about something else. Make it your policy... clogging talk stays at clogging practice or at the studio. Most of all, never discuss students or dancer issues with others, especially when it involves someone's children. You can be a professional success and succeed personally too!







The Double Toe Times

A Funny Thing Happened on the Way to the Forum...

Excerpts from your Posts in the Double Toe Times Forum show a wide range of opinions on the direction of clogging, its roots and how we define it as a dance form as it continues to grow and change

FORUM TOPIC

The dance known as clogging has developed from the predominantly Appalachian style drag-slide style, the heel-toe buck style and the flatfoot style, to a modern percussive dance including influences from tap, french-canadian step dance, Irish dance and more.

What are your thoughts about the changes to clogging and how do we define the dance and keep it growing while still preserving and maintaining its roots and many styles?

I believe Clay (PalmettoCity) and Rachel (DESRJRgurl) are on tack. Clay seems to believe that there is too much "non-clogging" going on today. Rachel suggests that including "some" jazz or other steps can make it more fun. Believe it or not. I do agree that "some" is okay - provided we recognize that we are adding some "jazz" or "Irish" or "Canadian" and that we not fool ourselves into believing we are doing "American Clogging". Jeff Driggs wrote an excellent routine a few years ago to Cry of the Celts. The routine contained a lot of clogging and "some" Irish. When we perform it, we mention that we will be "adding" some Irish Dancing steps. But there are "more" clogging steps in it than "Irish" steps. We also perform a routine to "Lord of the Dance" (Riverdance) which consists entirely of routine clogging steps (Joeys, Fancy Doubles, Doubleups, Basics, Drag slides, Rocking Chairs etc..). This latter routine is always a favorite of the audience.

As to how judges judge... Rachel is right when it comes to judges for shows like Star Search. However, when it comes to clogging judges at clogging competitions (like Silver Dollar City at Branson, Missouri), I still believe they should have guidelines for scoring. Doing "clogging" should score bonus points OR doing "non-clogging" should lose points. Judges already have other guidelines so why not add one more. I have personally seen teams win at

Branson, Missouri after performing a routine complete with "human pyramids", "partner drag throughs" and various other strange gymnastics. Does it make a good show routine? Certainly. But it is supposed to be a "clogging" competition. Perhaps if judges rewarded the more traditional clogging moves, teams would be less inclined to move to the other direction. Trevor DeWitt I'm sitting here before class thinking about all of the conversations I've had with people on this subject.

I know I am about to type a phrase that my result in a lot of vocal opinions.

Opinions are a good thing, it gets us thinking. It has been proposed by some that we promote modern competitive clogging with the term "power tap." My understanding of this idea is to promote clogging while acknowledging all of the modern influences on the dance. Calling clogging "power tap" is supposed to draw more people interested in clogging.

When I tell people about modern clogging I acknowledge two different levels of clogging. There is recreational clogging that goes on at workshops and in most clogging groups. Then there is the highly competitive side to clogging. In some, not all, competitive clogging the difficulty level of the steps and the sounds and complexity of the steps is pushed to the edge.

I think the question that was asked then is how do we define clogging and keep it growing? I read that in order for things to grow they need to change and develop. As humans, we grow and change as we grow. We are still the same person even though our outside appearance has changed a bit. In my opinion clogging is a relaxed, fun, friendly dance form. It is a dance that is tolerant of other dance forms and embraces those differences. When you go to a clogging competition there is a distinct sound of clogging that is very different from any other dance form. Even with the modern influences of tap, french-canadian step dance, irish and others, cloggers have embraced those differences and spiced up clogging with them.

A dance form that stays the same without any influence or change will not

last long. I am just guessing here, but if you asked "traditional irish dancers" if what they do most of the time is the stuff in "Riverdance" or "Lord of the Dance" they would probably tell you no. Those shows pushed what was Irish step dancing to a new level. We accept "Riverdance" as Irish step dancing. So how do we preserve clogging? In my opinion it is important to learn the traditional along with the modern. A person must learn the foundation so they can master the new. You don't become a great clogger overnight. It takes practice and dedication and learning from the past. It is my opinion that you can tell the difference between someone who has worked to be a competitive cloquer with all of the new steps and has never learned the techniques of traditional clogging and someone with a back-

ground in recreational clogging.
This is just some thoughts I had. These thoughts are my opinions only and are not right or wrong...they are just opinions. I look forward to reading your opinions as well.

Jeff Driggs What an amazingly diverse set of opinions. Even among our peers, we have so many varied ideas of what clogging is and what defines it. I think alot of people would agree that the basis for what most now consider "clogging" are the definitions, terminology and notations defined by Sheila Popwell in the late 1970's and further expanded by Kevin Sellew's "Clogmunication" in the mid 1980's. These are the definitions that are featured from the www.doubletoe.com site (available on the clogdancing.com

homepage). What I think continues to be debated is how much additional dance and percussive influence can be absorbed to a dance that grew into the style defined in the late 70's and 80's, and continues to grow. Should we call the dance from those definitions "clogging" and give a new name to the dance with it's canadian, irish and tap influences?

I'm With the Band!

Texas Clogging Team Gives Pointers on Performing to Live Music

The Fire on the Mountain Cloggers have performed to a number of bands including The Tennessee Valley Authority (bluegrass), The Ledbetters (bluegrass), The Country Gazette (bluegrass), the Bavarian Village Band (German) and even the San Antonio Symphony. Try dancing your clogging routine on stage at a theater where the musicians have lethal weapons in their hands (we had to be quick to dodge the bows of the cello players). What a kick!

The band we have had the longest relationship with is the Tennessee Valley Authority. TVA has won numerous contests including first place in the national band contest sponsored by Kentucky Fried Chicken held each year in Louisville, Kentucky. We met them in April of 1981 at Night in Old San Antonio. Neither group performs there anymore, but a lasting friendship and

respect developed from that first encounter.

The first time we tried doing one of our routines live we did it just as a joke ... mainly to see if it could really be done. It was so much fun that we would look forward to times when the band and the dancers would be scheduled for the same event. I would check with Hank Harrison, the leader of TVA, to see if they would like to play a tune or two for us, and they would always oblige. I think they get as much fun out of watching our antics but the banjo player usually watches, of trying to keep up with them as we do.

We recently held a concert called the Fire on the Mountain Follies which featured the bluegrass picking of TVA and our clogging team. We billed it as "The 'Battle of Feet Against Frets' where the musicians left no string unbroken and the cloggers left no tap unhinged." The crowd LOVED it.

It's a bit tricky to perform live, so during our long-standing relationship we've developed a set of signals we give the musicians. I've listed a few examples of what works for us:

- One thumb up means LOUDER.
- Whirling the index finger clockwise in the air means FASTER.
- Holding the index finger and the thumb about two inches apart means WE ARE ALMOST AT THE END OF THE ROUTINE.
- A quick slash back and forth across the throat with the index finger means END HERE (or within the next few beats).

We give our signals to the leader, too, so he can see the communication. Since some of our routines are either longer or shorter than the normal way that the band is used to playing the song, we have to alert them to the approaching end.

Also, it is very difficult to know when to start a routine. We discuss the introduction to each routine (number of beats) as well as the speed of the music ahead of time with the band. The guitar player will say, "How many taters (beats) do you




want? Another musician will quip, "Do you want that Fast or Half-Fast?" Rusty (my better half) usually responds, "Burn it."

We try to get the band to play the same tunes we normally use in our regular performances, but they don't always know the tune. Some songs can be interchangeable because they have 32 beat sections; however, some of our music contains extra beats. We do a routine to a tune called "Shuckin' the Corn" which has 24 beats in each section. It's not wise to use different music for this because the step changes and figures would be out of sync with the music. Therefore, we just don't do this particular routine if the band doesn't know it. Fortunately for us, TVA can play just about any song.

Here are some special hints we've learned about dancing to live music:



- Respect the band. We try not to stomp around in our taps if the band is playing and we aren't performing. (This also applies to anytime we are waiting to perform and someone else is on stage.)
- Give the band a playlist. We talk it over ahead of time and work out what tunes we want to do. I type or write out a list of songs we want the band to play in the exact order we'd like.
- Don't hog the spotlight. We don't freestyle to other music that the band might be playing (without us).
- No smart remarks. Although it is tempting to good-naturedly harass the band, it is not wise to do this prior to going on stage with them. TVA has been known to leave out a few essential beats in a tune or speed up and then slow down depending upon what they feel like doing to us.

Cloggers from throughout Australia come to learn and event goers get a chance to learn clogging from scratch!




