Grace in Your Heels



Dance has been an important means of expression since the beginning of time. In many ways, dance marks the time. From cave paintings depicting the hunt as spirited dance to the Sonnets to Footloose, our feet have always been keeping time with the times.

Shakespeare wrote about dance... a lot. In Henry V on the eve on Agincourt, Shakespeare wrote that they say "our grace is only in our heels." He was describing the plight of some of the royals who - even though they have been sent to the finest schools and taught the highest arts -- they still cannot rise above their own absent moral character.

I think back to some of the finest dancers I have met during my years of clogging. Some of the most amazing dancers to hit the floor seemed to not have much to offer off the planks. I remember a particular dancer who I admired so much when I first began clogging. They had a legion of young people who traveled far and wide to learn from them and so many took to idolizing the dance style that soon we were looking to the same person for direction in what clothes to wear and what shoes and taps to have and even how to behave. The dancer revelled in having a throng of followers. Many found, however, that the approval and acceptance they so desperately wanted were regarded as nothing more than a bother to someone who felt they had risen to a level that was unattainable to their own students. Nothing kills a young person's soul more than to have their idols fall.

Of course, dance isn't the only activity in which this cycle occurs. Walk down the hallway of any high school and look at the clothes the guys are wearing. I would venture to say half or more are wearing some kind of sports jersey. We just can't help it. We look up to our siblings and parents growing up, and as our minds are shaped and our individual interests develop we seek out heroes within that world.

Most of you who read the Double Toe Times do so because you have a deep love for clogging. Some are instructors, some dancers, some competitors and some just flat out love clogging and can't read or learn enough about it. When you are involved in an activity to this degree -- trust me -- someone is looking to you as a role model. It may be as a dancer, it may be someone who aspires to teach classes like you do someday, or it might just be someone who thinks you can do amazing things with your feet.

Don't let your grace be "only in your heels." It's hard for some people to learn to accept compliments and even harder to learn when to recognize unspoken compliments. Even when you least expect it, as a clogging leader, eyes are on you. It's a tough thing to shoulder sometimes and we are all only human, but someone, somewhere, is watching you for guidance, leadership or just plain acceptance. Just remember that and you won't find that graceful foot ending up in your mouth!

Clogging Madness

Danville, California

On March 6, 2004, the Diablo Mountain Cloggers hosted their 17 annual clogging workshop, now known as March Madness. This workshop is different from others in that it is geared toward newer dancers and only older, classic clogging dances are taught. This gives the newer dancers a chance to “catch up” and learn some of the great clogging dances that experienced cloggers know but they might not otherwise get a chance to learn. It has always been successful and is attended by newer and experienced dancers as well as many teachers.

We tried a new location this year, due to construction being done at our old haunt. The workshop was held at the Grange Hall in Danville, California. It turned out to be a wonderful place and the dancers loved it – probably mostly because of the wooden floor. It isn’t often these days that we get to dance on a wooden floor – oh the wonderful sounds cloggers can make on wood!! Although it would have been nice to have just a bit more room and more modern restrooms, nobody complained about those. There was a separate kitchen so people could sit and relax, eat a sandwich or two and catch up with clogging friends.

There were nine instructors who taught a variety of dances, mostly easy-intermediate and intermediate, with one intermediate-plus dance. The teachers were Lois Elling, Jennifer Elling, Starla Wright, Richard Willyard, Michele Hill, Matt Ellinger, Carol Smith, Susi Thomas, and Althea Mason with Deann Norris adding to the cueing program at the evening dance. The dances that were taught were from California and back east, from 7 years old to 16 years old, and danced to traditional, country, and pop music. It was a true variety. We had many comments on the great selection of dances.

The day started off with Althea teaching Scotty Bilz’ “Hambone” which got everyone’s enthusiasm up with all that stomping, knee slapping and clapping. With over 100 dancers on the floor, there was quite a lot of noise. The workshops, with easy to intermediate-plus level dances, continued straight through the rest of the day until the dinner break.

After dinner, most of the dancers returned for an evening of cued dancing including the new dances that had been taught that day.

One of our trademarks for our annual dance is the lovely cross-stitched badges that Deann Norris makes for all the teachers and volunteers. Each person gets one with the current year’s design and their own name done in cross-stitch. This year’s design was created by another one of our talented members, Willah Haberman. The bright green tee shirts were a nice showcase for the country-themed apples and checks.

Josh gave us all a wonderful workout. His routines met every need the

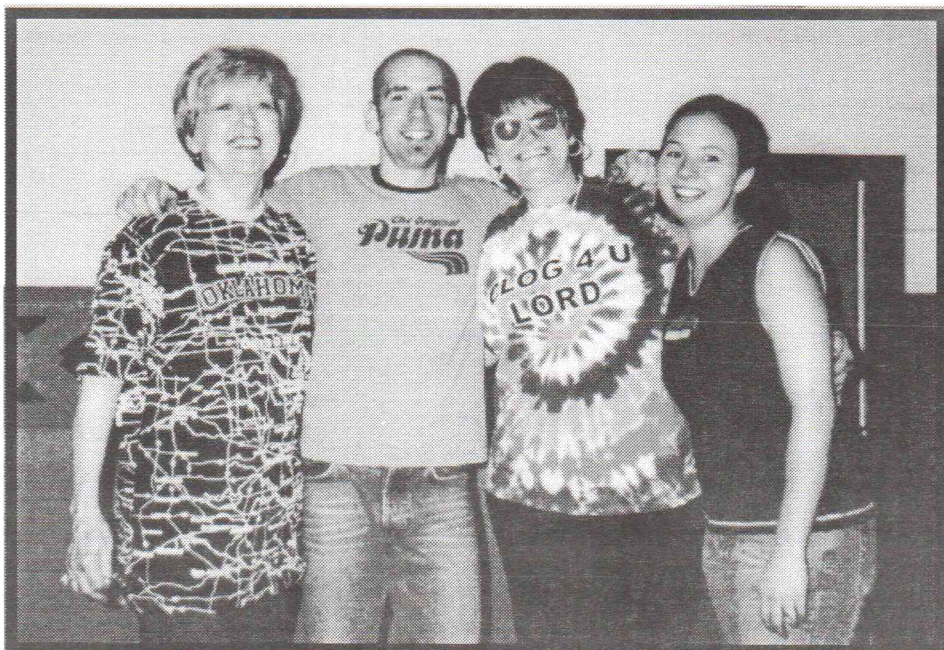
