



On Prancers When dancers' feet start to stutter, it must be clogging time

Like little girls who can't stop making noise with new shoes, the women walk, brush heel to toe and even do a few tap-dance steps.

The six, from age 50 to 82, love to hear their clogging taps slap the linoleum-covered concrete floor.

It's fun making noise. It's even more fun prancing.

Their shoes look like leather tennis shoes with one tap secured to the heel and one to the toe, then another riveted to those taps.

The two metal taps hit each other, then the floor.

The dancers' feet stutter. Feet go ttap, t-tap, t-tap.

Then stomp, slide.

Cindy Noe, a clinical research coordinator, is the leader of this enthusiastic twice-a-week class of experienced cloggers.

The class learns mostly line-dance steps. The step combinations often look like the steps in "Riverdance," another of several forms of the folk dance.

Noe fiddles with her headset, asking repeatedly whether they can hear her

in the high-ceiling room with acoustic issues. Her voice echoes and battles with the upbeat theme song from the TV series "Happy Days." Its fast tempo is perfect for clogging.

Noe, who's been dancing in the double-tap shoes for 21 years, gives the cues to the practicing dancers.

"Rocking chair."

"Fancy triple, do two."

"Charleston brush, two."

"Two basic."

"Clog over nine."

The women know what she's talking about, and they know how to do those steps.

Clog over nine is a sideways nine-step maneuver that looks like it would tangle up your feet.

The step is easy for the experienced dancers even though each clog over nine is really about 18 or 20 steps.

When Noe counted her steps with a pedometer, she

came up with 10,000 in an hour-and-a-half.

"It's a very good workout," she says.

"I didn't use to have a waistline and I do now," says Nell Yount, hugging her waist with her hands and twisting her body for effect.

Clogging can be strenuous, but it doesn't have to be. Noe is careful to adapt the steps that can be hard on the knees, so the stress that comes from hopping on concrete isn't as damaging.

Nancy Radley is careful to protect her body. She doesn't jump or raise her knees as high as Noe does.

After "Happy Days," Radley chats with Ruth Whitney about her performance.

"That's part of it, the socializing," Noe says. "As you can see, we have older people. I don't consider them old because they're staying active. They love this because of

the music and the social aspect."

Whitney, a clogger since 1981 and a dancer since childhood, loves to show off her talent. She does a quick tap step with a flourish at the end. A grin takes over her face.

The 82-year-old says, "I'll bet you didn't think old ladies danced like that, did you?"

And you wouldn't think clogging for an hour-and-a-half two evenings a week would be a commitment none of the ladies want to give up.

Noe's twice-a-week, intermediate class is one of several classes taught

in Albuquerque by various individuals within the small clogging community, she says. She hopes to start a class for beginners in January and wants to teach children and teens, too.

She adjusts her headset again, then takes control of the class. She's prepared a new combination of steps to the tune "Mr. Mom" by Lonestar.

"I took this and I said, 'What old steps can I mess them up with?' "Noe says.

She teaches something she calls the Black Mountain Step. The six cloggers practice it a half-dozen times.

"Perfect, perfect. That was it," Noe exclaims.

Then she adds a mountain goat step, a double break and some vines.

The six women focus on Noe's feet.

Their shoes make the same pattern as hers.

Their grins shine as big as hers.

Their taps sound like her taps.

For them, it isn't noise. It's the sound of fun.

Eady's program includes clogging, ventriloquism, and vocal performances. Songs included in her show are "Rockin'

Robin," "I've Been Everywhere," and "I Want to be a Cowboy's Sweetheart."

She has also demonstrated her talent for the audience of the Miss America Pageant in Atlantic City, N.J. "She was the first teen to perform of the stage at Miss America," Mac Sisson, state executive director of Miss Teen Arkansas-America said.

Eady's program was self developed. "I started it because there was a lot of violence out there, and I wanted to reach people of all ages," she said.

According to Sisson, Eady is booked every weekend from January through April and often makes appearances during the week for civic organizations and service clubs. She has entertained crowds in Tennessee, Texas, Oklahoma and New Jersey.

Participation is not lacking during Eady's performances. Students clapped and sang along while she clogged and entertained.

 \mathbf{P} - Patience has to be plentiful. We are dealing with human beings. Everyone you meet is bearing a burden and fighting a battle. Plan on your reward being the joy of giving or helping. Most important, stress the need for the person who has been helped to help someone else.

Suited to a T

What do Virginia Cloggers, an artistic error and Ireland have in common? Everything!

While drawing a Celtic knot one night, a Virginia clogger was distracted and made a mistake. In total disgust, she threw the ruined project on the floor. Thankfully it landed in just the right position for her mistake to become a blessing!

The Blue Ridge Thunder Cloggers (BRTC), from Loudoun County, Virginia, hope to travel to Ireland in August of 2005. Plans are being made for the group to interact with an Irish dance troupe and to perform at a festival. It is their desire to make friends in the Irish dance world – friends who might like to visit America the following year to dance with BRTC.

A project of this size requires lots of planning and lots of money. BRTC has been fundraising since June 2004. They decided that one way to earn some money for the trip would be to create T-shirts to sell. Providentially, the faulty Celtic knot became the design for the shirts. The "knot" had "mistakenly" taken on the form of a heart – and begged to bear the slogan: "Cloggers dance from the heart."

After selling enough baked goods and washing enough cars to earn the money for printing, BRTC placed an order for 100 shirts and took them to a small workshop as a test. Should I Practice At Home – And For How Long?

We've all been in class with *that* student. You know the one – the one that has to practically relearn the routine every week in class. The one that never quite knows what's going on. And, granted, we don't know what's going on with that student – they might have nine thousand things happen in their lives. They might have homework stacked from here until next Tuesday.

Or, they may just need to practice.

How many of us are practicing at home? How long are we doing it for? And, what is it worth to us?

One teacher, from Phoenix, Arizona goes as far as to "guarantee" improvement, in simply 30 minutes – "Cut out one t.v. show a night and devote it to dance...I guarantee improvement".

Is 30 minutes enough? When you compare 30 minutes to nothing, 30 certainly seems like plenty. For a competition group, that's enough time to devote 5 to 10 minutes to each routine that the group competes with – and most competition level routines are short enough now that you can do the routine twice in five minutes, and still have time to breathe!

How many instructors are practicing that often? I know that I myself often find myself feeling ill prepared for my classes, yet struggling for the time to be able to practice.

So, when do you practice? How do you practice?

One thing that is often taught is mental preparation. For cancer patients, "*picture yourself healthy. If you picture yourself healthy, you will be.*" Is urged. In Weight Watchers, it's "*picture yourself meeting your weight loss goals. Picture yourself in the smaller pants, or walking up the steps, or playing with your children.*"

I often approach my clogging practicing the same way – I live near a major metropolitan area, and as such, I often find myself stuck in traffic. So, I simply pop in a tape of the music that my group is learning, and dance the routine in my head. Believe me, I tried dancing it in the car...the man in traffic behind me was rather confused!

So, for the sake of safety, as well as the sake of making sure I'm prepared, and as enthusiastic as my group when they get to class, I find that I often take the approach of mental preparation. It might not be the 30 minutes a day that our friend from Phoenix has recommended, but in our increasingly busy lives, we have to take our practice time where we can get it!

The Walls Might Be Listening...

Have you ever heard the expression "The Walls Might Be Listening"? Have you ever heard that, and gone "What the heck does that mean?".

That's one of the first lessons that I learned from my mom about competition – don't say anything, because the walls might be listening. In different terms, don't say anything, because you never know who's listening to you!

We've all sat in the audience, and watched teams or solos, and gone "What the heck were they thinking wearing that/dancing to that/doing that?" And how many of us have proceeded to turn to someone on either side of us, and go "What are they thinking wearing that/dancing to that/doing that?"

Now, how horrible would you feel if the person you turned to happened to be that dancers mom? Or aunt? Or director?!

I had an experience with this once myself. Of course, I won't name the competition – it's been several years ago, anyway. I was watching a team that, to put it gracefully, was a little out of their league. (Like I said before, we've all seen them!) I turned to my mom, and said "Oh, my gosh, mom. I can't believe that this team decided to come to this competition!"

Now, was I out of line? Absolutely. Was it my place to judge why they were there, or how ready they were to be there? Absolutely not. Did I do it anyway? Of course. Did I learn a big time lesson from it? You better believe it.

I stand up to go get in line with my own group, and I see two girls from the same competition group, sitting two rows behind me. Now, I don't know if they heard me, but I was so embarrassed by that, that I just wanted to crawl into a hole for the rest of the competition!

I also have an internet friend that learned this same lesson, but learned in a way a little bit harder then I did.

She attended a school talent show, where, of course, there were dancers. Fancying herself a bit of a dancer, she observed the routines with interest. She went home that night, and (in her words) "critiqued" the talent show routines in her online journal.

Turns out, someone from the school saw it. Now, let's just say that they heard that one loud and clear!

Now, was she out of line? Of course. Was it her place to judge? No! Did she? Yep. Did she learn her lesson? I'm not so sure that she did. She thinks that she was in the right for her actions. After all, her journal, her business, right?

Wrong. Even when you put information out on the internet – or, in the computer age, *especially* when you put information out on the internet, it's available for everyone to read.

People can access the internet 24 hours a day, seven days a week, in countries we've never even heard of! This takes "the walls might be listening" to a whole new level!

Now, I'm certainly not suggesting that no one ever have any opinions, about anything, ever, but please be careful of who you tell, and who's around WHEN you tell your opinions. After all, thinking that someone's standing line isn't up to par is certainly no reason to be making enemies!
