ho hasn't gotten stuck in a rut, even doing the thing you love? After over twenty years of teaching clogging almost every weekend, I can't help but find myself sometimes dreading the long drives or afternoons spent in

airports, backaches from hotel beds, and the endless parade of school gyms, hotel ballrooms and recreation centers.

I've talked to directors who found themselves feeling overwhelmed and unappreciated. It's easy to get exhausted trying to haul equipment, keep up with a dozen dancers, music and all of the tiny details that come with what we do.

I recently had to travel cross-country for a weekend workshop. A hectic day at work made it a mad dash to the airport, and I finally settled onto the plane and laid my head against the window, asking myself why I do this to myself every weekend.

A weather front had caused travel delays and the plane rattled through the clouds as we climbed above the storms. A crying baby just added to the feeling of isolation. As the sun began to set, the steward dimmed the lights. No one turned on their reading lights. I guess I wasn't the only weary traveler. When you have had a hard day, its funny how your body won't give in to the rest it needs. I sat wide-eyed and numb, trying to recharge for a weekend of clogging. When you stand in front of folks to teach, they deserve for you strive to be at your best.

The turbulence had not stopped, so I raised my window shade to see if we were actually climbing or if Murphy was serving me a dose of predictable gloom to add to my exhaustion. The gray fog of the storm made it impossible to see, but occasional flashes of light let you know the storm was still all around us. Just as I reached to lower the shade, we broke through the clouds. The setting sun had cast a palette of reds, oranges and purples on the clouds. As we continued to climb, a cloud would block the view again for a moment, and then the sky would open up again to display a huge canyon of colors. The tall billows looked like towers in a mystical world. I looked back through the plane. Most had bowed heads or were tilted against the window in sleep. Even the baby had been rocked to sleep. This show was just for me.

We followed the sunset as we traveled west, and as we climbed higher the tableau changed to a sea of cotton candy foam. Lightning strikes in the distance looked like some cosmic dance floor. It's so hard to describe how just seeing clouds can be emotional and I feel trite looking for adjectives. I just felt tremendously lucky to see something so amazing and beautiful.

I wouldn't have these opportunities without clogging... so many amazing people, places and memories. It's easy to get caught up in the hard stuff and miss the good stuff. Sometimes you have to look beyond the ordinary to see the extraordinary. Sometimes it's right there. All you have to do is look for it.

Overcoming Tragedy to Share the Love of Clogging

Dear Double Toe Times:

Every person has their own story to tell, but every clogger has an adventure. I share my story with everyone who wants to hear it. Having a lifethreatening accident and overcoming that to become a grand champion clogger is quite the accomplishment. Here is my story to share with your readers. Thank you for your time.

This is my Story

At the ripe old age of 8, I was in a tragic tractor accident. Doctor's told my parents that I would not survive and if I did, I would be a vegetable, unable to walk, talk, or even perform simple tasks. I proved them wrong after three days of care in the Pediatric Intensive Care Unit (PICU), 12 days of hospital stay with no surgeries, and six weeks in a wheel chair. I was up and walking on my own two feet. I believe that things happen for a reason, and without this accident would I have ever been introduced to or become so passionate about clogging?

I was introduced to clogging at a county fair in my hometown in North Carolina a few months after my accident. I just stood there and watched the cloggers as they danced, all in sync with one another and in rhythm with the music. I was so amazed and taken back at this incredible form of dance. Clogging was a common thing in North Carolina, seeing as that is where it originated. I went home from the fair with dancing not only in my feet but it was in my heart.

My mother signed me up for lessons at the local dance studio in our hometown. I had to audition to even get into this studio. I had never had lessons in dance before so I entered the audition scared and nervous. After performing my routine that my mother and I had choreographed, the instructor asked me how long had I been dancing. I responded to her that I had never had lessons and that performance was the first time I had clogged. Looking at me with shock and surprise she told me that I was more advanced than some of the girls that had been there for a year. After hearing that, it confirmed the feeling in my heart that I was born to be a clogger.

Clogging has given me so many things throughout the 14 years I have been doing it. I have obtained leadership skills, lifelong friends, trophies, great exercise, confidence, and most importantly the drive to overcome any obstacle in my life. Clogging is something that I can share with everyone I see, whether they like it or not. Having the opportunity to continue to learn new things about something I am so passionate about is the greatest accomplishment and gift. Clogging is something that I have and that I will always have to show that I overcome tragedy and turned it into triumph. Clogging is a way that I can express my self and say, "I did this".

I have won several talent competitions, pageants, and even clogging scholarships. I don't only have the self-satisfaction but I also can take home visual memories, such as trophies and plaques to display my love and appreciation for clogging. Clogging is a part of my past, my present, and my future. I take it with me everywhere, and -yes -- I even clog in the aisle at Wal-Mart!


Memorial Day Clogging Spectacular Workshop & Midwest Clogging Championships Columbus, Ohio Event Marks 14th Year


