And, lastly, never stop promoting. Even once classes have begun, continue to have flyers about clogging and your groups to encourage a level of interest so that your next classes will be just as successful as the ones you are working so hard at right now!






Tony taught at the first CLOG Convention in Mobile and was a great friend of Tandy Barrett and many other national clogging leaders.





## Secrets of a Portable Dance Floor

by Ken Seng, The Sugar Creek Cloggers.

Hi there Cloggers. How many of you have dreamed of having an option to not dance on sticky blacktop pavements or concrete that tears up your shoes from being so rough, or have you thought our sounds would sound soooo much cooler if we had a wood floor with a little air underneath it to enhance the sound when we dance. Of course the most adventurous of you probably priced a commercially made portable dance floor (OUCH!!! Never want to do that again!)

Well I'm here to chase off those ranks of snake oil salesmen and tell you that with a little bit of time in the wood shop you can turn out for your team a good functional portable wooden dance floor at a reasonable cost. Our dance floor is 12' x 20' and nicely accommodates 2 rows of dancers 5 across. With a couple of dancers help I can have the dance floor ready to dance on in less than a half hour of setup time.






Another advantage to using the design I am revealing to you now is that some day we may find a place to have a workshop or some other event if we only had a floor. Several clubs could bring their floors to the event to make one Superfloor. Cool, EH?

So how do you go about building this percussive dancers mobile dream?

You start by getting sheets of ¾" plywood, cut each sheet in half so that they are 4' by 4'. To make a 12' x 20' dance floor you will need 15 4' x 4' pieces. (Use plywood as you will probably not find OSB near as durable and make sure one side which will face up has a nice smooth finish.)

Now I said we are going to put some air under that floor so we get a little more sound out of the floor than if it was laying flat on the ground. To do this we will need 2x2's 8' long. You will need 2 ½ for each section of floor or 38 2x2's 8' for a 12' x 20' dance floor. Cut 2 pieces exactly 4' long and 3 pieces 45" long (3 inches shorter than 4'). Use C clamps to hold the boards in place and then fasten them to each section in the pattern shown in figure 1. My first few panels I put together using 1 5/8" Drywall screws (9) evenly spaced on each 2x2 (It's also a good idea to predrill the screw holes because 2x2's are known to want to split). but then I did some fast talking with my wife and I got a brad nailer and boy did that speed up the process, of course we can't take those pieces



of stage through the carry on luggage in an airport because they'll drive the metal detectors crazy because I put so many more brads in a side than screws.



Now to hold the panels together you'll need some more 3/4" plywood. Where you have 4 pieces come together you'll need to cut a piece 18" long and 10" wide. For our 12 by 20 dance floor you'll need 8 of these, then where you only have two pieces join together in along the front or the back cut a piece 18" long and 5" wide (8 of these) and where the panels join on the sides make them 10" by 9" (4 of these) Also cut up a bunch of 2"x4"s 7 7/16" long you'll need 56 of these pieces. Attach the 2"X4" as shown in the diagram.

Now after cutting up all these little pieces of plywood you will have some left over scraps. Let's cut them a little more so that they are 1 ½" wide and make them at least 6" long. Attach them so that they are on the middle of each of the 2"x2"s. As shown by the solid arrows in the illustration. Also on four of the panels put a 6 inch strip on each side of 1 of the corners. (Very important!! Just one corner!!) Use screws on the corner, just in case we need to make a super floor with several teams floors.

OK now use ¼ round router bit and round of the plywood edges on the top of each plywood panel and the inside edges of all the 2x4 on the joint pieces. (This is so you don't catch your shoes on


the edges and it is a little easier fitting the pieces together.)

Now are you ready to put it all together and try it out? You betcha!! Start with a corner panel, lay it down, put a 4 corner joint piece kiddy cor-

ner from the corner. One of the Long joint pieces along the back corner that doesn't have plywood strips on the corner and one of the stubby pieces on the side. I work the back row to the front row. So continue along the back laying the panels into the connector and adding the next connector. I recommend a stomp double or two to encourage the panels to drop in when they get stubborn.

Once you have checked

everything out and have made sure it fits together right, I recommend a coat of stain to seal the floor from the elements. This floor has worked for us fairly well on reasonably level surfaces. If your wood working skills are not that of an apprentice to a master craftsman you may want to work with the screws to put the pieces together since it is easier to undo and adjust. Have fun and enjoy dancing on it!

This year, the workshop added a new feature with Friday afternoon workshops. This gave (Continued on page 14)




He wants to use his talent to

More and more cloggers are planning their vacations around clogging workshops and competition. You need to take special care when planning a vacation that includes a lot of dancing. Here are some suggestions that might help to make you dance vacations exciting and enjoyable.

## **Before the Trip**Pack Light, Pack Smart

Special items like clogging jazz shoes for exhibitions and competing, dance sneakers for workshops, Camcorders for recording lessons, casual clothes for workshops and costumes for exhibitions or competition all add up to more weight and more bulk in your suitcase. Figure out what is the

bare minimum you need and then only pack half of that. If you are going to a major city, you can always buy or borrow things when you get there. You never know how much stuff you will have to lug around yourself. Of course if you are traveling somewhere with someone to carry your suitcases, then pack everything including the kitchen sink. I use my own dancer's travel checklist to help organize my packing routine.

### Shoes, Shoes, Shoes

Women and their shoes. Most guys have no idea what women; particularly dancers go through to be sure that we have the right shoe for the outfit or the occasion. But I am a big believer in comfort before style. You may think that you need to bring walking shoes, clogging shoes, dance sneakers for workshops,

sandals for the pools, and heels for going out on the town. If I carried all those shoes on a trip, I would need to take a suitcase devoted solely (no pun intended) to my shoes. But I have managed to reduce

my shoe needs down to just clogging shoes, walking shoes and heels for social dancing and nightlife. If all else fails, hit the mall

and pick up a new pair of shoes.

Traveling is often physically demanding and stressful. Your whole body is really put to the test of if you take a day of workshops and then fun dance and exhibition for 3 hours or so each evening. How do you keep up your energy and

endurance? WATER-WATER-WATER is an important factor. Since airplane travel and dancing are both very dehydrating, I have a 1.5 liter of water with me at all times. (Budget tip—buy your first bottle of water at a grocery store and the rest of the time fill it up from water fountains in the venue)

For that mid afternoon energy slump—energy bars. I have sampled tons of tasteless, rock hard high protein, low carbohydrate

energy bars and my current favorite is the Myoplex Low Carb Energy Bar distributed by GNCE. A little pricey at \$2.79 per bar but it actually tastes pretty good. You can also get other high proteinlow carb bars at most grocery stores.

Remember to bring all your usual vitamins, dietary supplements, teas, potions, beauty aids, sun-screen and medications and maybe other some staples like Advil, bandages and safety pins. It is really inconvenient to buy toiletries and

over the counter medications in the hotel gift shop or at the airport where the mark-up on these items can be 40-150% or more. Besides, who wants to go looking for an all night drugstore in a strange city at 2:00 in the morning?

## At your Dance Destination

**Break Time** 

Even if there are a million great teachers and promising dance classes, be sure that you take out a little time to relax. Sit by the hotel pool, put you body in the hot tub, and get a manicure or mas-

sage. A pedicure is an incredible treat for your tired feet and legs. When you check in, get a room with a tub. Fill it with warm-hot water,

climb in and stretch your legs and feet before and after your workshops. If you follow this routine after a night of strenuous dancing, you can avoid cramps and aches in your legs and feet the next day.

### **Dance With Strangers**

Talk and dance with someone who you don't know. The whole purpose of travel is to explore new places and new people. There is nothing as exciting and gratifying as finding someone who enjoys clogging as much as you do. Most of what we learn at workshops are line dances where everyone faces the same direction. Make it a point to turn to those around you and say "Hi" or make someone feel a part of your group.

### Water, Water, Water

You need to stay very well hydrated during dance classes and fun dancing. If it has been a really hot, steamy evening, I will drink water with electrolyte supplements (you find this at GNC or other health food stores) before I go to bed so that I will feel refreshed the next morning. If you decide to have adult beverages following an event, be sure you drink at least twice as much water to combat fatigue, dehydration and hangovers.

## After the Trip Departure

I know it is hard to go back to the real world after a clogging weekend. Who really wants to face work, school, spouses, kids and all the other responsibilities you juggle in your normal life? The party does have to come to end, though. Some people plan their trip to leave an extra day AFTER the event ends. You are already sleep deprived from several days and nights of non-stop dancing. Why make things worse by standing in long checkout lines at the hotel, rushing off to the airport and dealing with traveling with your still-

wired team or club members?

Allot plenty of time for packing all of your dance gear and other necessities. Allow tons of time for getting to the airport and check-in procedures. Sometimes I spend twice as much time getting to the gate as I spend flying to my destination. But that's life in the fast lane.

### **Treats**

Since you will probably spend at least an hour roaming around the airport waiting for your plane, why not find special treats. I love to roam around bookstores, make-up counters and bath and body shops. My newest delight is the Brookstone stores, the retail chain that sells all kinds of goodies for pampering yourself. If look closely, you will find an electronic food massage pad that vibrates, warms your feet and gives a shiatsu massage for your tired toes. What is

better than a free foot massage after you have been dancing for 3-4 days? Pure heaven.

### Water, Water, Water

Same rules apply about having plenty of water with you to combat jet lag and travel aches. Besides when you get home from a convention or competition, you'll want to be fresh to show up at class to tell all you friends about your adventures.

### Chill out



form of exercise for continue good health.



### **Utah Teen to Clog Her Way Through Europe**

Heather Bolton started dancing as many young girls do, taking ballet lessons in early childhood. She left ballet after a few years, but at the age of 8, stumbled upon a different type of dance shoe: the clog. That led to an 8-year love affair with clogging that is now taking the Grantsville teen to Europe to perform.

Bolton, 16, auditioned for an open spot on the national dance team known as Clog America last September. She received an e-mail a few weeks later informing her that she had earned a spot not only on the basic team, but on the traveling team as well.

"I was so excited," she said. "I kept screaming as I told my friends over the phone that I had made it. It was awesome."

Clog America, which is based in Draper, Utah, is a folk-dance troupe made up of members from all across the western United States ranging in ages from early teens to mid 40s. Bolton is the second-youngest member of the troupe.

This July, Clog America embarked on its 31st International Festival tour to Rome, Sardinia, Poland and Italy carrying a message of peace, friendship and hope to people in other lands through music, dance and humanitarian projects. In addition to musical instruments, costumes, and dance shoes, Bolton will also be taking blankets, hygiene kits, clothing and school supplies for disadvantaged children in Sardinia and Poland.

The group is called Clog America because the majority of the numbers are clogging routines, but the troupe does perform the Charleston, country swing, and an original a cappella number with their clogging shoes.

"I just like to be on stage performing, and it's been fun to do the different dancing," Bolton said "I've never been so fond of speaking in front of people, but dancing in front of people is entirely different. I really get into it and let my personality show."

Parents Greg and Annette Bolton are very proud of their daughter's accomplishments.

Bolton explained that her passion for clogging is one that will last a lifetime. She plans to teach her children and even her husband how to clog one day.

"I'll die an old woman, with my double tap shoes on my feet," Bolton said.
