



"America's Got Talent," NBC's hit summer series from "American Idol" producers FremantleMedia North America and Simon Cowell's SYCO Television, returns this summer with the hottest performers from across the country ready to compete in the blockbuster reality show's third season.

TO THE READERS

Saving Face

The last two years have been incredibly trying ones for magazines in general and especially for the Double Toe Times. We have had delivery delays and publishing delays and have been working hard to get back on track and get the clogging news and events to people as quickly as possible. I have to say that I am truly blessed with wonderful clogging friends who have stepped in to help with printing and fulfillment and work to get us moving in the right direction.

The first weekend of April of this year, I woke up one morning (after a weekend of splitting headaches) to realize half of my face wasn't working. The shampoo going right into my eye in the morning shower was my first indication that something wasn't quite right. Moments after showing up at work, my coworkers sent me to the hospital, where tests confirmed that it was Bell's Palsy, a compression of the #7 facial nerve. I recognized it myself by the end of the first day. My father had this same ailment in his 30's and I heard my grandfather also suffered from bouts of it. It's not a debilitating disorder, but face can't move and your eye cannot blink and has to be taped shut to sleep, your taste buds on that side don't work and part of your hearing mechanisms are disabled so sounds in the ear are sharp and "tinny."

After 25 years of teaching workshops almost every weekend, I have begun to slow down quite a bit and my first string of free weekends really were a blessing when it happened. The workshops I have done in California, New York, Ohio and elsewhere have been good experiences and people have been so understanding and supportive while I teach with one hand holding my cheek so I can say words that begin with B. P or F.

I've never felt that I was much to look at, but losing all expression in half of your face is very humbling. Abe Lincoln said "If people say I am two-faced, why am I wearing this one!?" I concur.





Giving Thanks

Hi there. I really would just like to show my appreciation for clogging. I have just recently started clogging again. I havent danced since I was 18 years old. I am now 32. I was a clogger from the age of 6 until I graduated high school and moved out on my own. I missed it dearly and always wanted to get back into what I loved for so many years. I just never had the means to do so.

I was a great clogger before I quit. 12 years of pure dedication pouring my heart and soul into it. I competed, I did shows, I taught, most of all I loved what I did. My heart was really torn when I had to quit and move on with my life. Being forced onto the workforce and having to make ends meet.



Picture this. A Kung Fu clogging battle breaks out in the Chinese restaurant where touring stringband Uncle Earl has decided to stop for dinner. 





eastern North Carolina for a surprise attack on a newly formed alliance of dancers operating under the name of The Wasted Fats.

When The Braised Meats captain (Heidi Kulas) brags on her team's "quadruple double doubles" (a rarely attempted advanced clogging maneuver), Wasted Fats captain Maureen Berry conures the special costume transformation that signifies her team is ready for battle.

The Uncle Earl g'Earls leap for their instruments and rip into a Georgia fiddle tune. Coincidentally, the g'Earls' friend and producer of their last album John Paul Jones (of Led Zeppelin) happens to be

at the piano "noodling" on chopsticks. He joins the rhythm section and banjoist Abigail Washburn sings in Chinese about food, drink and of course, about dancing.

The feet are flying fast until one of The Fats (Jason Nious) land a ferocious flip, and the Meats are all out of fancy steps. Infuriated, the Meats' captain throws out the rule book and uses her special danceo-kinetic superpowers to levitate the innocent skaterwaiter onto a table. He struggles to maintain balance, simultaneously scaring and impressing the crowd with his roller-clog technique.

Uncle Earl must acts to defend the innocent civilian. Guitarist Kristin Andreassen, who is herself a veteran of a Kung Fu clogging gang by the name of Footworks Percussive Dance Ensemble, takes the floor to counsel Meats and Fats team leaders. They find a dance step in common.

And suddenly, Kristin is joined by Rayna, KC & Abigail; all of Uncle Earl takes the floor in matching magic silver tap shoes, revealing their clogging moves which they have been practicing in a secret cave somewhere in the vicinity of Waterloo, Tennessee! The g'Earls wow both teams with their triple-axlewagonwheel technique and successfully unite Meats, Fats and even the restaurant chef in a dance of joy and mutual appreciation.





performing a couples routine entitled "Istanbul" (Constantinople), very colorful and well done.


- The "Tucson Mountain Cloggers" from Arizona performed "Banjo Boy" with several different formations, great job girls!
