TO THE READERS

Food for Thought

I think one of the biggest factors in the decline of a society is the loss of the dinner table. Now, isn't that a weighty and profound way to start a clogging editorial?

I remember growing up in a fairly large family that one of the rules of the house was that you had to be home for supper. I remember hearing my mother velling from the front porch as we played street ball or spot-light to get home right now for supper! As we grew older and the parents grew softer (as they usually do with younger siblings in large families) the dinner table began to nearly always have some of our neighborhood friends pulled up for a share in this week's spaghetti, beans and corn bread, salmon cakes or baked beans and homemade mac and cheese.

The reason I remember those meals is not only for the food but for the memories that were made there, the relationships that were cemented, and the sense of family that was shared.

As a young clogger, I would go to team practice or class a couple of nights a week for a couple of hours each time. Every weekend, we would go to a dance hall with live music and freestyle and square dance for hours. For the life of me, I can't really tell you much of anything about those times other than we clogged a

What I do remember is that after each of these clogging times, the group of us would go to the local Shoney's Big Boy or Pizza Hut and sit till they ran us out. At our local Pizza Hut, we cloggers even rolled the salad bar against the wall and played clogging songs on the jukebox and danced right in the middle of the small restaurant. The store even began to order songs for the jukebox just for us!


Through the years I have danced with thousands of cloggers throughout the world, but I will always have a special place in my heart for that little group of dancers who closed down the joint after every clogging event.

Sometimes we focus so much on the work of clogging that we forget that a lot of the great bonds of friendship with cloggers comes from the time spent OFF the dance floor.



After Sterling Silver finished its 90 second routine, they were in for more suspense as the group waited for the judges to make a decision. Luckily, they were given the okay to pass through to the Las Vegas round. Those feelings at that moment were hard to describe. In the words of Jacey Sisneros, "It felt surreal."

The weeks leading up to the Las Vegas competition were intense. Not only were the practices difficult, but routines needed to be cut down to 90 seconds and changed to fit the criteria of the "America's Got Talent" producers. It was stressful when the music wasn't passed through until the final week before the Las Vegas round. The Members of Sterling Silver remember practicing at 5:00 A.M. (before school) and at other times ending at midnight – it was crazy!

When the Las Vegas week finally came, Sterling Silver was in for an intense week; it was extremely emotional! They had to make it through two more "cuts" and then perform in front of the judges again.

> When Sterling Silver performed their second routine, they were extremely nervous. They ran out on the stage, and gave it everything they had. Despite the fact that they received rave reviews from David Hasselhoff, and smiles from Piers Morgan and Sharon Osbourne, they were not passed through on the final day! They were later called to be an "alternate" for the show.

The whole experience was

difficult and emotional! Some of the parents of the group have said that their children are still not the same since this experience. Looking back Sterling Silver feels it was a great learning experience. They were able to associate with some great talent and some "interesting" talent. They also felt they left in good company; there were many talented acts that did not pass on! It was an experience that cannot be equaled. All members agree they learned a lot.


Next year's competition will be held on June, 2009 and promises to be another great festival, teams mark your calendar.


