





Two Cloggers Dance Their Way Onto Reality TV

ABINGDON, Va. – This summer, two Virginia cloggers appeared on reality TV shows.

Dance teacher Kim Fore and one of her students appeared on separate shows – Fore, of Glade Spring, on ABC's "Dance Machine," and 8-year-old Kayla Thomas, of Abingdon, on a show called, "The Next Child Superstar."

"I never dreamed that this would happen, but I just kind of went for it," Fore said of her competition, which began airing July 11. "It was a great experience for me, and I think it will show my students that there's opportunities out there for them as well."

Being from a small town, she said she hasn't had many of the opportunities available in larger cities, but opportunities are out there. She said she spends hours searching for them on the Internet.

Among the opportunities she has found were the audition for "The Next Child Superstar."

"This [performing on reality TV] kind of completed a lot of goals for me that I had, and now that I've gotten older, I have really focused on my career with my studio and finding opportunities for these other talented kids that are coming up," Fore said. "I want them to be able to make it somewhere big."

She said she started dancing at age 4 and started dance lessons in her home at age 13. She later expanded to a friend's basement and then to a studio on the town square in Glade Spring.

Now her dance studio, Xtreme Dance Company, has locations in Abingdon and Chilhowie, Virginia, and she is preparing to expand to a third location.

Kayla studies several styles of dance, but she clogged to the song "Black Betty" in the competition.

"I'm going to be clogging because it's probably the best dance I do," Kayla said, adding she enjoys dancing "because it's fun."

Kayla said she enjoyed performing on TV, and she wants to be a heart doctor or a veterinarian when she grows up, but she also wants to keep dancing.

In addition to the show taped on June 29, Kayla dances on a competition team and is traveling to New York in July to perform.

"I feel like it could be a good thing for her because

she loves to entertain and that's her opportunity to entertain everybody that watches it," her mother, Dawn Thomas, said of the program. "I think some reality shows aren't good, but I think this one is about the kids."

She said Kayla started dancing at age 3 and loved it from the start.

"I'm excited for her. ... I'm hoping that it will help her get other opportunities," Thomas said. "She has a lot of talent, and I feel like if we get on there and they videotape her ... they'll see what talent she does have."




THE "FREE SPIRIT"

Community Grieves Loss of 8 Year Old North Carolina Dancer

ASHEVILLE, North Carolina – Last year, 8-year-old Claire Atkins, of Spruce Pine, kicked up her heels on stage at the annual Mountain Dance and Folk Festival.

This year, this historic festival was dedicated to her memory.

The bright young dancer died July 18, 2008 after a fall from a tree. A member of the Cole Mountain Cloggers, she leaves behind a grieving family and saddened mountain music community.

Claire came from a dancing family. Her parents, Jeff and Angela Atkins, started and coach the Cole Mountain Cloggers. One of four daughters born to the couple, three sisters who also dance with Cole Mountain survive her: Abigail, 12; Caroline, 6; and Sarah, 3. Their uncle, Jay Atkins, coaches Woodfin Elementary's Elk Mountain Cloggers.

"In the community of the Shindig and Mountain Dance and Folk Festival, there are families who keep the traditions," said musician Laura Boosinger. "Jeff and Angela Atkins have such a family. Claire was a very petite, fine-boned child. It was fun to see her go out and elatedly perform a crowd-pleasing dance move.

"She was a lovely, loving child who always gave a hug to everyone she knew," Boosinger added.

"Claire was always the one who did a cartwheel in the 'rise and shine," said family friend Vickie Hensley-King. of Fairview, referring to a clogging move usually known as the "Kings Highway."

"She was so full of life and energy."

Jeff Atkins serves on Asheville's all-volunteer Folk Heritage Committee, producing the Mountain Dance and

Folk Festival and Shindig on the Green. He is director of the Shindig. The tragedy has united the mountain music community. Following his daughter's death, the Folk Heritage Committee announced that this year's 81st Mountain Dance and Folk Festival, held July 31-Aug. 3 at Diana Wortham Theatre in Pack Place, would be formally dedicated to the young performer's memory.

"We are people of faith, and we see God's hand in getting us to where he wanted us to be," said Jeff Atkins.

After his daughter fell from a tree

and suffered a severe injury to her arm, the Atkinses traveled to Brenner's Children Hospital in Winston-Salem for her to have surgery. A congenital vascular defect, unknown to them and unrelated to the fall, caused bleeding to the brain.

"It could have happened anytime, anywhere," said Jeff Atkins.

"When we found out that she couldn't be saved, we wanted to help other children. Five different children had surgery to receive organs from Claire."


Community remembers

Jeff Atkins described his daughter as a loving, energetic child who loved reading, school, the fiddle, her family, her church family at Central Baptist Church and clogging with the Cole Mountain Cloggers.

A hush fell over Martin Luther King Jr. Park on Saturday night as the usually joyous Shindig on the Green paused for a moment of silence. Boosinger took the stage and led friends, family and the audience in a special version of "Will the Circle Be Unbroken" in memory of 8-year-old Claire.

A celebration of Claire's life was held at the Greenlee Primary School auditorium in Spruce Pine. In honor of Claire, the family requests donations be made in her memory to Carolina Donor Services at 1551 Westbrook Plaza Drive, Suite 200, Winston-Salem, NC 27103.





Diamonds on the Soles of Her Shoes

Level: Beginner

Notes to the Dancers:

This is a story of a musical journey of sorts for me. It begins with a scene along the wharf in Miami where the air is filled with the strains of a live Steel Drum Band. And I am standing watching an old man dance in his own way to the music of the steel drums. His feet never left the pavement: his heels kept beat with the music of the steel drums. He didn't really move much, but he was enjoying the music and feeling it from his heels to his head. This dance begins and ends with that scene in mind and a step I have called the "Old Man's Heels".

The dance moves on to another scene. In November, 1986, Paul Simon appeared on Saturday Night Live with a South African group called Ladysmith Black Mambazo. Earlier in the year, they had collaborated on the album "Graceland". The performance that night in November on SNL was a song from the "Graceland" album; it was called "Diamonds on the Soles of Her Shoes." Having tuned in to SNL that night unaware of the scheduled performance to come, this was a great surprise and a performance whose imagery, lyrics, dance and music would stay with me thru the intervening years. I have often wanted to dance to "Diamonds..." since that time. Finally, with a little inspiration and a few ideas, the time has come.

I have tried to choreograph a dance that my favorite people... Beginning Cloggers... could enjoy even before you acquire the wealth of steps and skill that is sure to come. I included a step in this dance that I call the "Mambazo"... named after the group that performed with Paul Simon. The step was derived from watching replays (over and over again) of the SNL video of their performance in 1986. I only adapted it slightly for clogging. The point in the dance where we do the "Mambazo" is exactly the same point in the song where Ladysmith Black Mambazo did the same step. I use a lot of earthy steps in this dance - the "Mambazo", "Old Man's Heels", "Zulu Stamp", "Bazo Swing" and "Bongos" - as I tried to capture a clogging version of the African styling in various places of the dance. Another step I called "Algia Mae Touches" comes from a step that Algia Mae Hinton, an African-American from the Piedmont region of North Carolina, used in her tap and buck dancing. She is one of the Appalachian dancers featured in the DVD called "Talking Feet." She would do some intricate, yet understated, movement and then follow it with a portion of this step which is a very dainty touch of the toe on her unweighted foot before doing a brush and going on to something else... in this step she reminds me of someone who is being very careful to protect a valuable resource on the soles of her shoes... her dancing showed that she truly has diamonds on the soles of her shoes. I use her understated step juxtaposed against the subsequent ostentatious Strut Steps to accentuate the polarities of this dance: the New Yorker (by way of New Jersey) Paul Simon & Joseph Shabalala from Ladysmith, South Africa, the Pop lyrics and the traditional isicathamiva harmonies of the Zulu people, steps whose roots lie in the clogging tradition and steps whose roots lie in the Zulu dance tradition.

I am sure that Paul Simon did not have clogging or taps in mind when he constructed his song around the phrase "diamonds on the soles of her shoes". But those of us who clog know that our "diamonds" are truly on the soles of our shoes. Have a great time with your "diamonds" as you learn clogging.
