TO THE READERS When in Rome...

The History of New Year's Resolutions

According to the researchers, the tradition of the New Year's Resolutions goes all the way back to 153 B.C. Janus, a mythical king of early Rome was placed at the head of the calendar.

With two faces, Janus could look back on past events and forward to the future. Janus became the ancient symbol for resolutions and many Romans looked for forgiveness from their enemies and also exchanged gifts before the beginning of each year.

The New Year has not always begun on January 1, and it doesn't begin on that date everywhere today. It begins on that date only for cultures that use a 365-day solar calendar. January 1 became the beginning of the New Year in 46 B.C., when Julius Caesar developed a calendar that would more accurately reflect the seasons than previous calendars had.

In the Middle Ages, Christians changed New Year's Day to December 25, the birth of Jesus. Then they changed it to March 25, a holiday called the Annunciation. In the sixteenth century, Pope Gregory XIII revised the Julian calendar, and the celebration of the New Year was returned to January 1.

Although the date for New Year's Day is not the same in every culture, it is always a time for celebration and for customs to ensure good luck in the coming year.

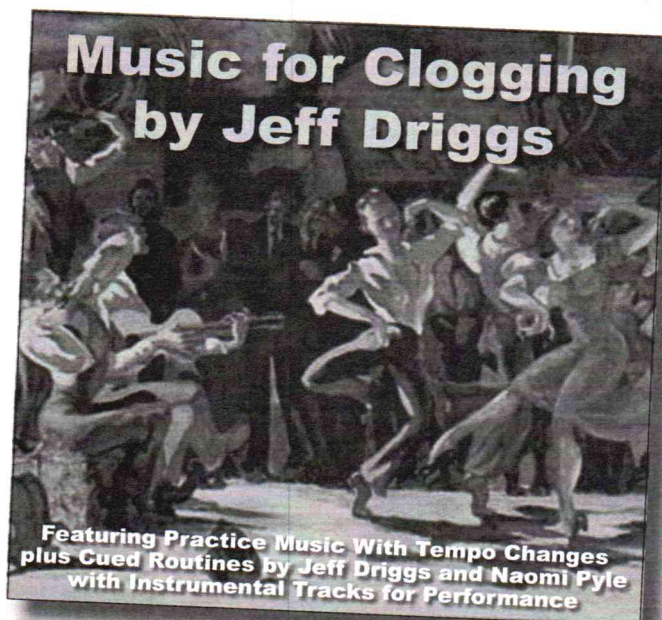
The celebration of the New Year is the oldest of all holidays. It was first observed in ancient Babylon about 4000 years ago. In the years around 2000 BC, Babylonians celebrated the beginning of a new year on what is now March 23, although they themselves had no written calendar.

The Romans continued to observe the New Year on March 25, but their calendar was continually tampered with by various emperors so that the calendar soon became out of synchronization with the sun. In order to set the calendar right, the Roman senate, in 153 BC, declared January 1 to be the beginning of the New Year. But tampering continued until Julius Caesar, in 46 BC, established what has come to be known as the Julian Calendar. It again established January 1 as the New Year. But in order to synchronize the calendar with the sun, Caesar had to let the previous year drag on for 445 days.

So just in case you were concerned about not having gotten off to a good start on those resolutions to get all of your music files cleaned up or the studio cleaned or classes promoted, don't worry... we're just following history! Just don't let your ideas wait 445 days to put into action! Make this the year you take action on following your clogging dreams!

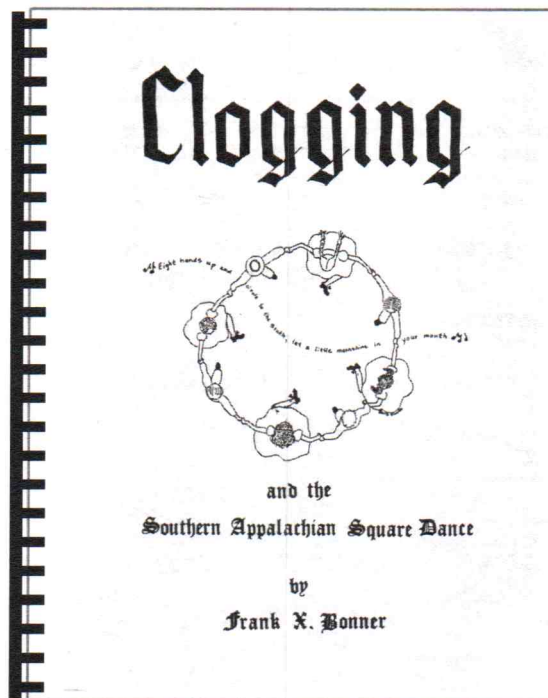

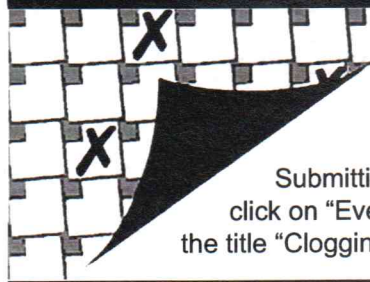

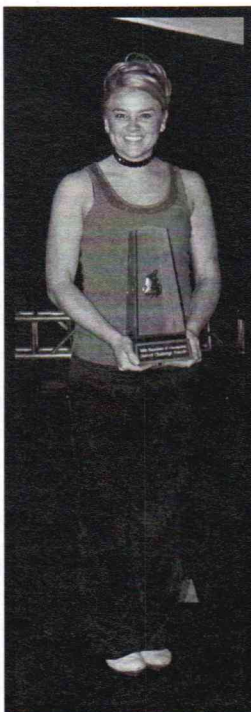
It takes so many volunteers to make an event happen of such magnitude and we want to thank again and again the people who made all it a success.

America's Clogging Hall of Fame Inductees

At the America's Clogging Hall of Fame World Championships, held October 24,25,26, 2008 at the Stompin' Ground in Maggie Valley, NC, three people were inducted into America's Clogging Hall of Fame. Inductees are chosen from nominations made to the ACHF organization. Inductees must have been clogging for at least 25 years and have been a positive influence in the preservation of the dance. This year's inductees were Mercy Martinez from High Point, NC, Donna Riley from Suffolk and Eddie Caruthers from Chesapeake, VA.

Mercy Martinez, High Point, North Carolina

Mercy Martinez started her clogging career in 1981 in Lake Mary, Florida. She originally went to clogging class as a spectator while her daughters took the class. Soon she found herself picking up the steps by watching and then helping her young daughters learn the "doubletoe". It was then that she figured she was "hooked". She has danced with numerous teams in Florida, including Dixieland Cloggers, Sunshine Cloggers and Rainbow Express.

By the time she moved from Florida her entire family -- including her three children and husband -- were clogging. After moving to North Carolina in 1984, she and her family began competing with the Hickory Flat Hoedowners, directed by Elliot Skeen and her own personal group the Pride of Carolina Cloggers. Since then, the Pride of Carolina has danced all over the

U.S. and won several thousand awards. This inductee has been a certified instructor and judge for the past 21 years, teaching everywhere from Florida to Colorado to preserve the heritage of clogging. In 1986 she was selected for the All American Team. She also formed several performance clogging groups, including Town & Country Cloggers, Heart of Dixie and Kernersville County Cloggers. Beside teaching in elementary schools and TOPPS conventions, she has performed in places like Walt Disney World and Opryland. The Pride of Carolina has had three different families with three generations clogging on the team, including her own children and grandchildren. She values the friendships she has made through the workshops and judging circuit and watching the little ones she's taught and judged grow into talented, prosperous adults.

Martinez works 40 hours a week and then teaches clogging for hours during what little free time she has left at night and also makes all the team costumes. The Pride of Carolina is her second home; the cloggers are her second family and clogging her pride and joy. Now teaching in her newly-built studio in High Point she hopes to continue clogging and educating her community about this wondrous dance form for years to come. She has always been supported by her husband, Frank, her daughters, Vanessa & Christine and son, Frankie.

Donna Riley has dedicated over 25 years of her life to preserving the traditional form of clogging. Her clogging group continues to carry out the traditional forms of clogging more so than the precision. She once stated "We still hold fast and true to traditional". In 1983 she was one of the founding members of the Peanut City Cloggers. The team was formed as a non-profit organization to allow families to participate regardless of their income. Through her hard work and dedication to the team, she has spent hundreds of countless hours at the sewing machine making sure costumes were made, repaired, or altered so that the team looked their best. She has been elected by the team for over 17 years to be their volunteer managing director and even when none of her children were dancing on the team she continued to support and volunteer for the team. She has taught beginner clogging lessons for over 20 years. When the team first started she allowed them to dance in her garage, then they moved to a deserted school building and have found their home for over 20 years at the local Ruitan Club in Suffolk, VA.

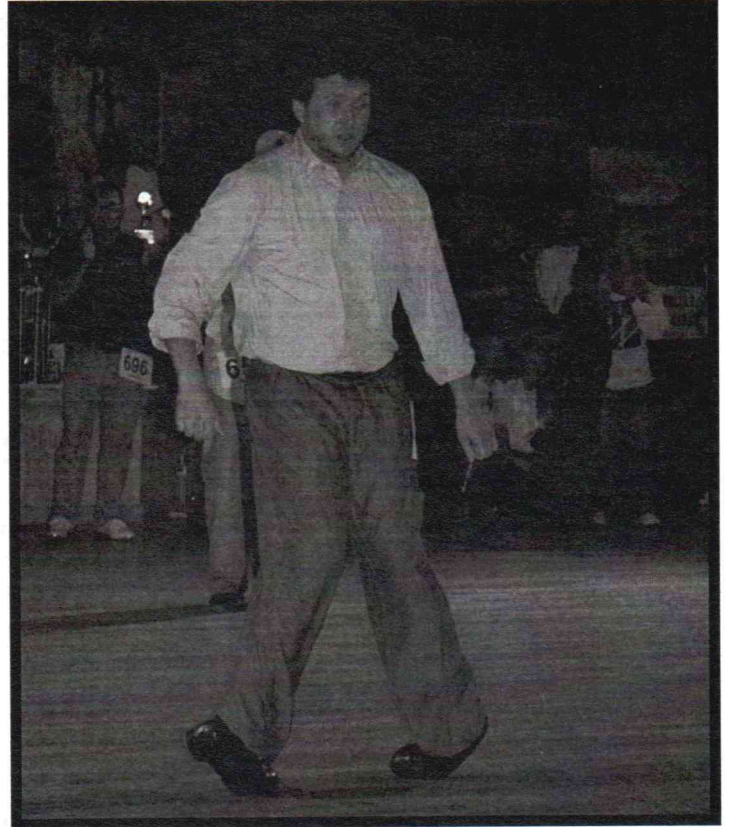
Riley works vigorously with the Peanut City Cloggers to make sure that they continue the tradition of traditional clogging. She makes sure that every member of the team first learns hoedowns before they begin any precision dances. While still exposing the team to other forms of clogging she sees to it that they compete in all categories of competitions. She makes sure that the team is ready for competition or shows and stays up late at night to ensure that their competition paperwork is turned in correctly and on time. Throughout her time as managing director there have been 12 members selected to the All-American Team, 2 to the Jr. All-American Team, 2 to the Millennium Team and 2 to the International team. She has also had 4 team members continue their love of clogging into college to dance on the Bailey Mountain Cloggers.

She has spent many hours and a lot of hard work with the team, being a mentor, counselor, friend, and teacher and has done it all as a volunteer, never receiving any money for her commitment to the art. All of her time has been given because she truly loves the art of clogging.

Eddie Caruthers, Chesapeake, Virginia

Eddie Caruthers began his clogging career in 1971. Before his clogging career began, he was very active in the Western Square Dance Association. He was featured as a caller at their National Conventions from 1972 through 1977. He wrote an original square dance routine which was published in the American Square Dance Magazine. He joined the Flatland

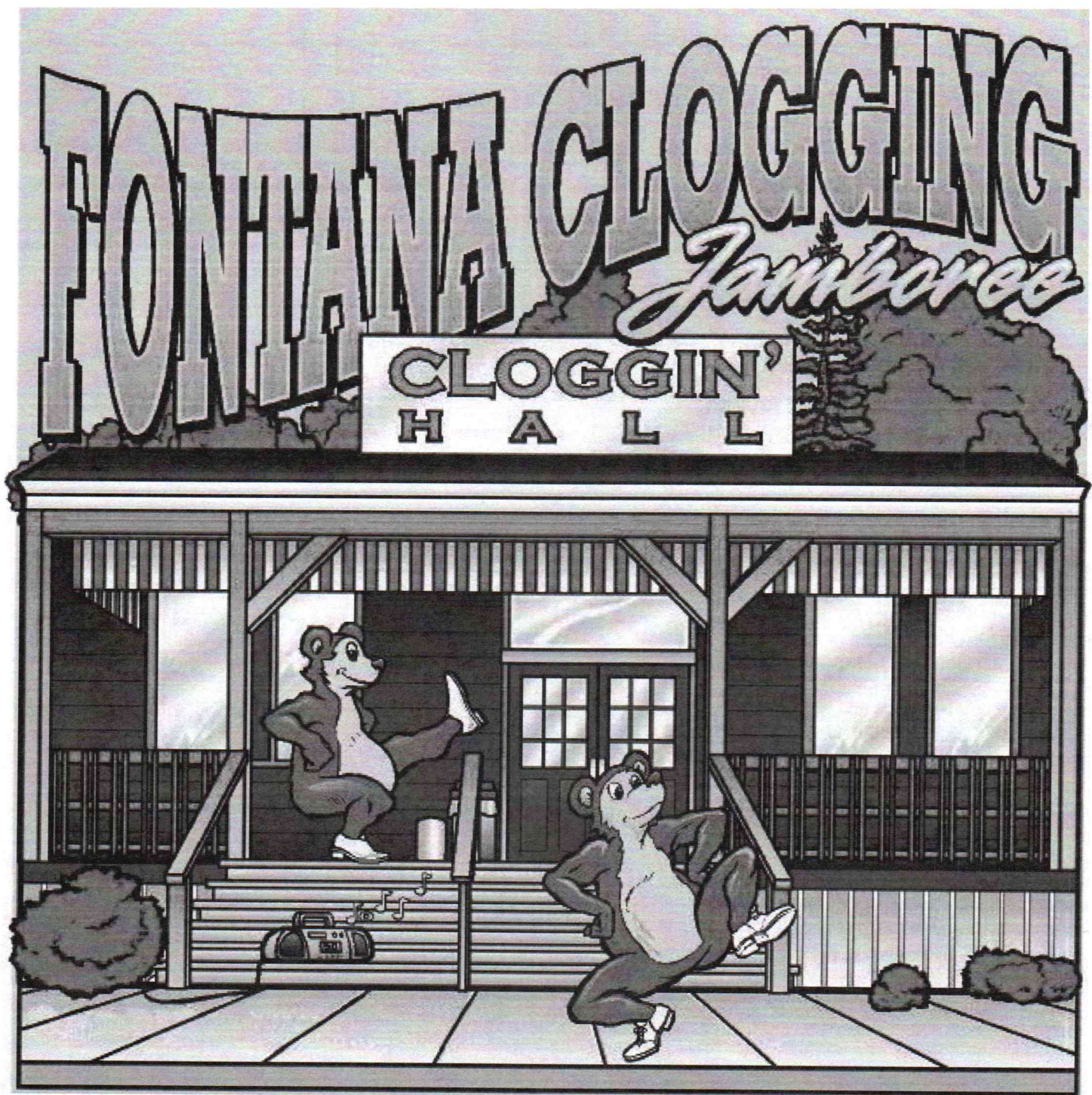
Cloggers and was active in their shows, travels and competitions through 1994. He has shared his knowledge with many teams throughout his years as a clogger.

He has assisted at many competitions by being a time keeper, a score runner, an emcee, a judge, a rep, and a music man. He participated in the first judges training ever offered and has been a certified judge all these years. His knowledge of square dancing and all our rules has qualified him to be an official rules representative for the ACHF organization. He is seen at many competitions in the position of judge or judge/rep. He wrote a scoring program and has done the scoring for many competitions and has been instrumental in the reviewing and revamping the rules and scoresheets used by the ACHF.

Caruthers was honored as a member of our All American Team in 1995 and as a member of the NCHC All Stars in 1996.

Caruthers is given the credit for accomplishing the unheard of task of coordinating the partnering of the four major clogging competition sanctioning organizations to include clogging as a featured event in the Junior Olympics.

When not clogging, he is employed by the Federal Government and works on the antenna systems for many of our United States War Ships.

Shindig on the Green

Shindig on the Green is one of Asheville's finest traditions, celebrating the musical and dance heritage and mountain culture of Western North Carolina throughout the summer for more than 40 years. The annual mountain tradition features an exhilarating mix of Big Circle Mountain Dancers, Clog Dancers, Bluegrass and Old Time String Bands, Ballad Singers, Storytellers and of course the strong sense of community and family that has kept mountain culture strong for so many years. With a main stage show as well as informal jam sessions, there's something for everyone at the festival, including lots and lots of great clogging and old time Appalachian style square dancing. Shindig on the Green gets underway "along about sundown," or for those using a watch- 7:00 p.m., and usually runs until 10:00 p.m. throughout the months of July and August and runs through the Labor Day Weekend.

The Shindig on the Green began entertaining the Asheville community in 1966, but it can trace its origins back further to the advent of its parent festival, The Mountain Folk and Dance Festival, in 1928. The Mountain Folk and Dance Festival was founded by Bascom Lamar Lunsford in an attempt to spread the beauty and dignity of Southern Appalachian music and dance traditions. Since its inception, The Mountain Folk and Dance Festival has played a fundamental role in preserving and sharing those traditions with the world. It was out of this fine tradition that Shindig on the Green was formed to not only create another venue, but



also to encourage public participation in folk music and dance. Since then, the Shindig has been a resounding success and The Mountain Folk and Dance Festival has gone on to be the oldest festival of its kind in the nation.

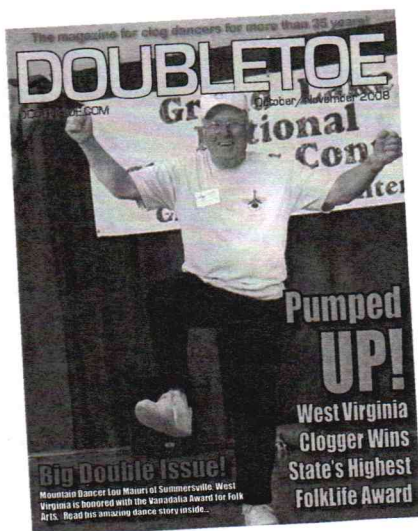
