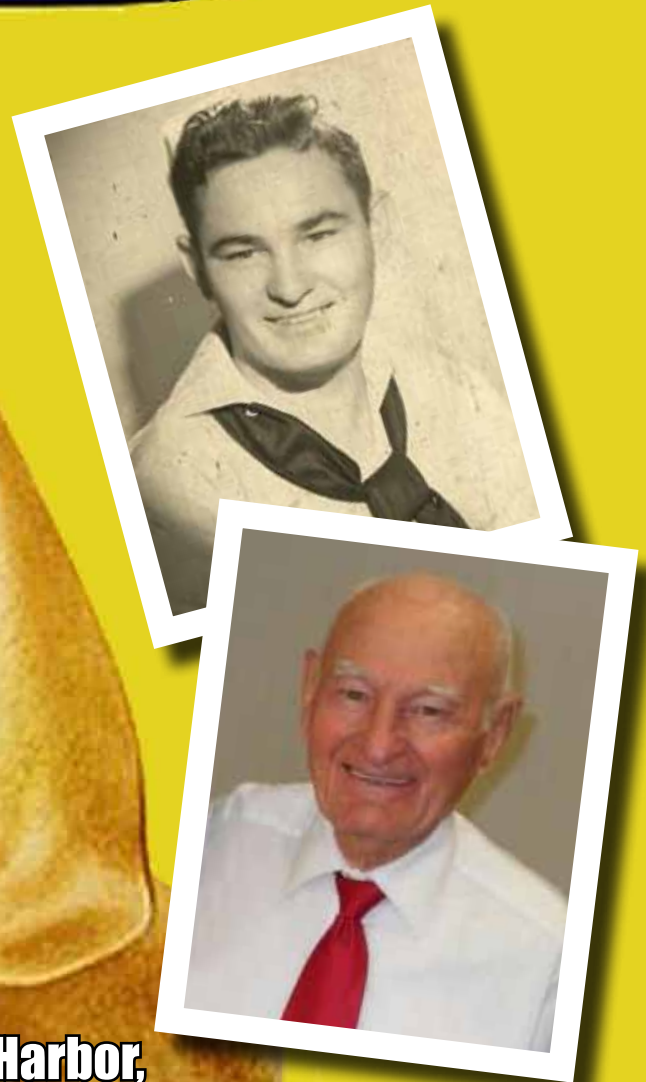
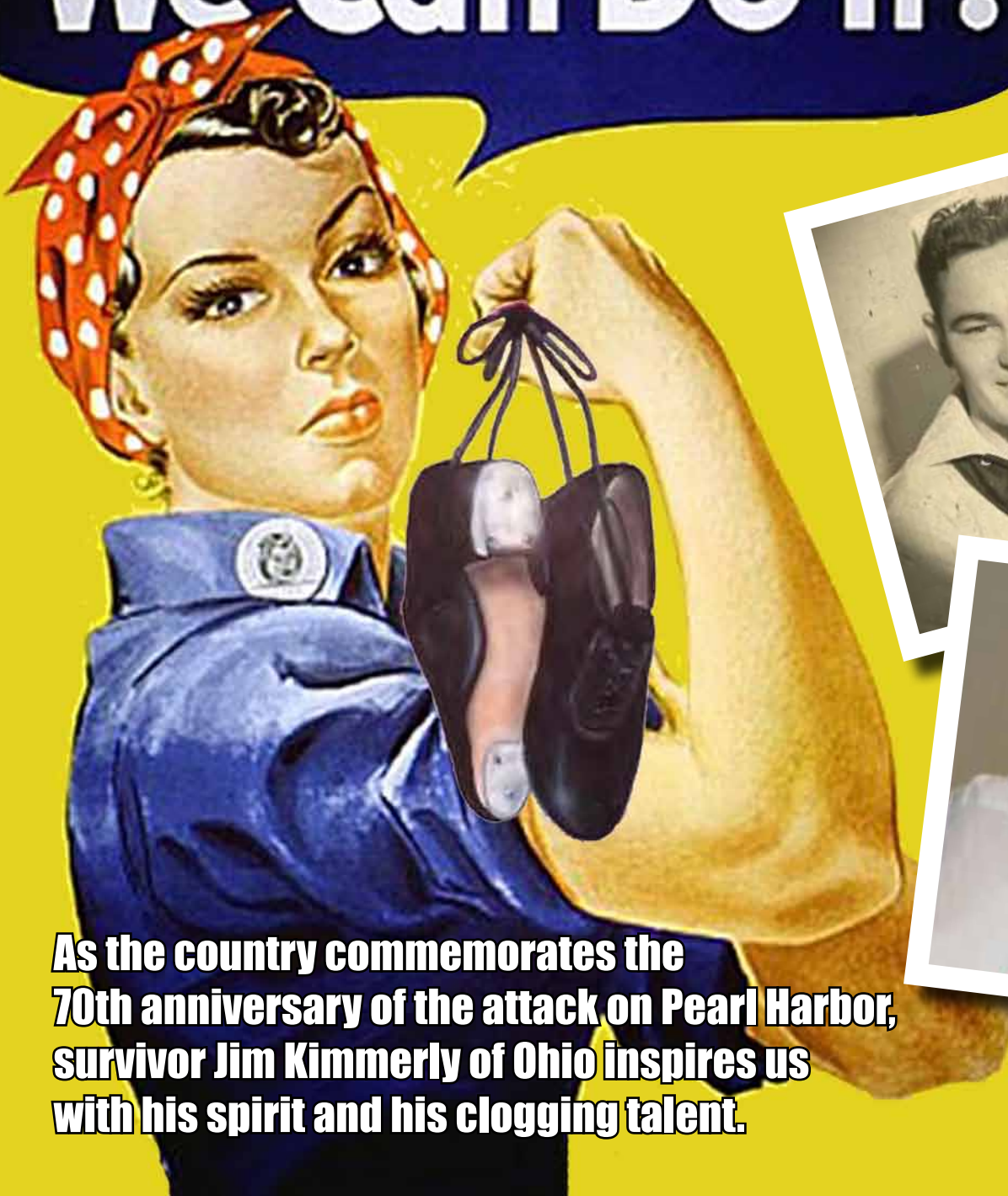

Clogger and Pearl Harbor Survivor is an Inspiration

For Adams County, Ohio resident and U.S. Navy Fireman Third Class Jim Kimmerly, remembering Dec. 7, 1941 at Pearl Harbor is as easy as a double toe slide and shuffle.

This December marks the 70th anniversary of Japan's surprise attack on American military bases on the Pacific islands on Dec. 7, 1941, which launched the United States into World War II. During that "Day in Infamy" 2,008 U.S. Navy personnel lost their lives, and American casualties totaled 3,581. Kimmerly was fortunate to be on a ship that fought hard in the battle, but escaped serious damage.

"I do pretty good for my age," Kimmerly said on Tuesday.

At 88, Kimmerly is still spry and active in pursuing what the dance that he loves. He included his clogging family in his memories of the day his ship played a part in fighting the attack on Pearl Harbor.

"We went to the Pearl Survivors National Remembrance Day this time last year," said Evie Poe, a friend and part of Kimmerly's family of cloggers in West Union, Ohio. "It was a very

touching experience."

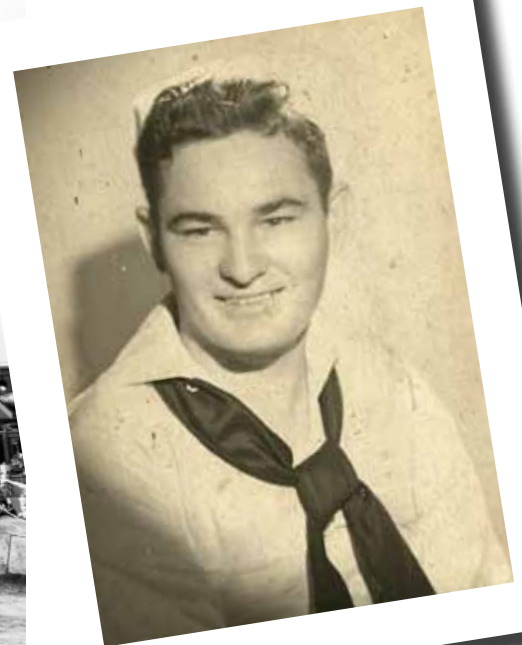
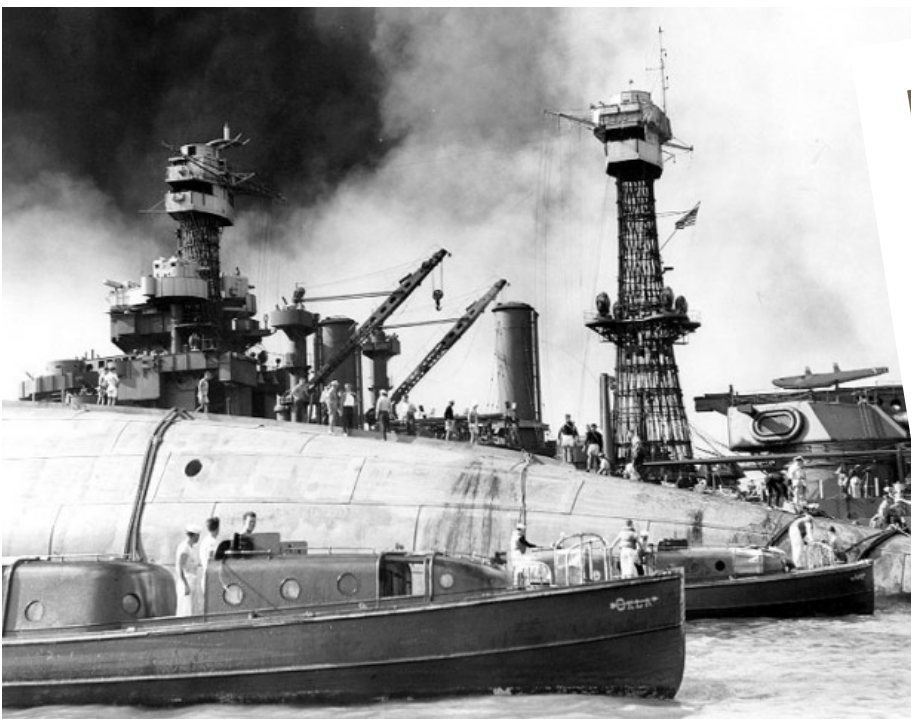
Kimmerly has clog danced for 16 years with the Fancy Free Cloggers. "I was line dancing and saw someone clogging and thought I liked it," Kimmerly said. "I was 73-years-old then."

"Jim is wonderful," Evie Poe, director of Fancy Free Cloggers, said Monday. "At 88, he's a very active member of Fancy Free. He's not just here biding time. He hates mistakes and works right along with us to perfect our performances. He's an inspiration to all of us."

Kimmerly's contagious attitude toward clogging, his fellow dancers and life in general has been recognized beyond his local dance group. He was presented the Lori Wilson Award in January at the Clogging Champions of America's Showdown of Champions in Knoxville, Tenn.

Wilson, a Georgia clogger, was killed on her way home from a clogging competition several years ago. Her mother presented one of two awards this year to Kimmerly for being a positive example to his peers and a dedicated clogger. He was given a standing ovation.

At a previous Showdown of Champions, Kimmerly was the recipient of the People's Choice Award. He traveled recently with Fancy Free to a competition in Gatlinburg, Tenn.,

and looks forward to clogging at the next Showdown of Champions to be held the last week of January in Knoxville, Tennessee.

While preparing for the competitions, he practices with the dance group twice a week. One of the routines he is working on is a duet with Poe to the Merle Haggard tune "Old Man from the Mountain."

Kimmerly also dances in many of the group's team routines. In an award-winning show routine performed by the group, Kimmerly portrays Grandpa in "Grandma Got Run Over By A Reindeer," as well as David Seville in a routine with the "Chipmunks."

"It's going great," Kimmerly said Tuesday about his clogging.

A rapidly decreasing number of Pearl Harbor survivors are still living across the nation, and Kimmerly is one of the most active. He belongs to the Pearl Harbor Survivors Association, Inc. and over the years visited Pearl Harbor five times during national reunions.

A member of his local chapter of the survivors association, Kimmerly said the chapter disbanded two to three years ago because of difficulty for

many of the members to go to the meetings.

"They're going to cancel the national association after Dec. 31 since there isn't anyone to take care of the paperwork," Kimmerly explained. "Last year was the last time I went to the national reunion. They're having something there this year, but it's not the national event."

According to a CNN news story by Phil Gast, dated Dec. 4, only an estimated 8,000

survivors are alive today out of the 84,000 uniformed Americans on Oahu the day of the attack.

Originally, Kimmerly and the crew of the Medusa were sent to Pearl Harbor for six months. He boarded the ship in August 1941 in San Pedro, Calif. Two weeks later they headed for the

Oahu Island harbor which surrounded

little Ford Island. After the attack on Pearl Harbor by the Japanese, the Medusa was needed to help repair damaged ships. It didn't leave Pearl Harbor until April 1943.

On the morning of Dec. 7, 1941, the Medusa was in Pearl Harbor just northeast of Ford Island Naval Air Station. Beside it, toward the island was the U.S.S. Curtiss. Lined up along the northwest shore of the island, bow to stern, were the ships U.S.S. Tangier, Utah, Raleigh and Detroit.

The first wave of 183 aircraft were ordered to take off by Japanese Admiral Nagumo at 6:10 a.m. They were launched from three aircraft carriers 220 miles north of Oahu Island. Two of the aircraft were lost during takeoff. At 7:55 a.m., the first wave of Japanese aircraft reached their destination in Hawaii and began their assault. The second wave of aircraft arrived about an hour later.

During a 2005 interview with his local newspaper about his Pearl Harbor experience, Kimmerly described his ship, the USS Medusa in the quiet before the

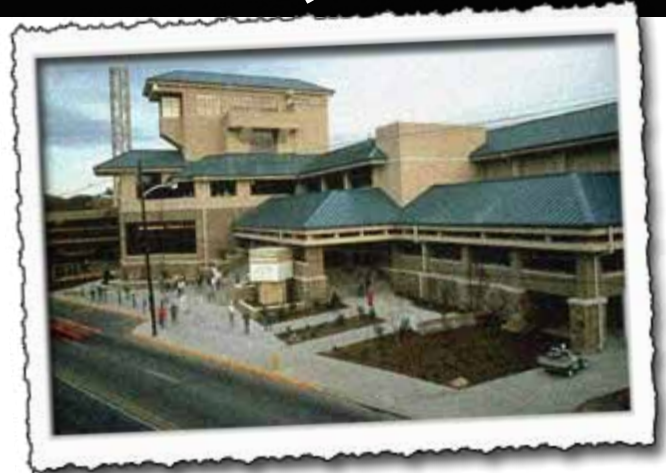

attack and the disbelief he felt about the bold attack by Japanese kamikaze fighter planes.

Normally sailors on the Medusa would put away their cots in the machine shop during the day. They worked where they slept; Sundays were different, Kimmerly said.

"On Sunday you got to leave your cot down and didn't have shop work to do. We just took it easy on Sundays," said Kimmerly.

Shortly before 7 a.m. that Sunday, Kimmerly remembered general quarters was sounded, sending all ship personnel to their battle stations.

Kimmerly was a machinist and slept at night in the machine shop of the ship as it floated in Pearl Harbor. When they called "general quarters," he climbed to his lookout station on the upper deck of the Medusa.

"I had just had my breakfast and was laying around; I never remembered them saying it was the real thing. I just remember being mad that they were running a drill on a Sunday," said Kimmerly.

Planes were already coming in, but Kimmerly thought they were American planes on a drill.

Kimmerly was not sure that the entire incident

was not an elaborate drill.

"I was in my battle station as lookout on the upper deck, and the guy next to me said it was real Japanese planes, but I still didn't believe him until he pointed to the Utah, a target ship we would tow out and shoot at. The Utah was turning over in the water from a hit from one of the Japanese torpedoes. Then I knew it was real," said Kimmerly. "They were coming in low, and I could see the flashes of the machine gun fire."

"The Medusa had two five-inch guns on it," said Kimmerly. "When the guns fired, it would shake the ship. I was passing up ammunition. When the ship shook, I thought it was a torpedo hitting us."

The ships Medusa, Utah, Curtis and Riley were all anchored on the opposite side of Ford Island from Battleship Row and hit by the first wave of Japanese fighters.

"Riley got hit and a plane crashed into the Curtis. A two-man (Japanese) submarine was trying to torpedo the Medusa, but missed. The destroyer Monahan got rid of that sub with a depth charge," recalled Kimmerly. "They spent a lot of time hammering Battleship Row. They hit the airfield before they went after the row."

Once the attack was over, Kimmerly was not sure of what to expect next.

"I thought they were coming back; that they were going to invade the place," said Kimmerly.

Following the attack, the emphasis in Pearl Harbor was getting the people out of the ships that had turned over, according to Kimmerly.

"Most of the ships that turned over had people trapped in them," he said. "There was fire on the water for at least three days from the oil and gasoline floating on it."

Once their work was done at the battle site, the crew of the Medusa was sent to New Hebrides

until December 1943. While there, Kimmerly got an executive call and was asked to go to optical school to learn to work on gun sights. He was shipped to Washington, D.C., in January 1944. After completing training, he was sent to advanced optical school at Portsmouth Navy Yard in Norfolk, Va., to learn to repair Mark 14 and Mark 15 gun sights.

His new skills took him back to the South Pacific to Ulithi on Sorlen Island. Kimmerly worked in the optical shop while living in a tent and spending the nights on a cot.

"It was down by the equator, so it was hot," he said. "When the war ended in 1945, I got to come back to the states."

In April of 1946, he was discharged from duty. He worked in Maysville and in Cincinnati, Ohio before going to work at Chrysler in Dayton. He worked there for 31 years, primarily in the sheet metal department.

Kimmerly and his late wife, Thelma Fletcher of Tennessee, raised two sons and a daughter. He lives on a parcel of land on State Route 247, a part of the farm where he and his six brothers and six sisters were raised. Two of his sisters, Bertha Webb and Minnie Rogers, and several nephews and nieces, also still live in Adams County.

His parents, Samuel and Perlina Kimmerly, had five sons serving in the armed forces during World War II. Four were in the Navy, and one was an infantryman in the Army National Guard. On several occasions during his tour of duty, Kimmerly saw his brothers.

"We all came back," he said.

Kimmerly has no intention of slowing down, but he is planning for retirement.

He has been building a deck at his latest project, Poe said.

"I am working on setting up a mobile home in Manchester (Ohio) for when I am no longer able to drive," Kimmerly said. "But that is many years from now."

10. Start creating your own happiness. – If you are waiting for someone else to make you happy, you're missing out. Smile because you can.

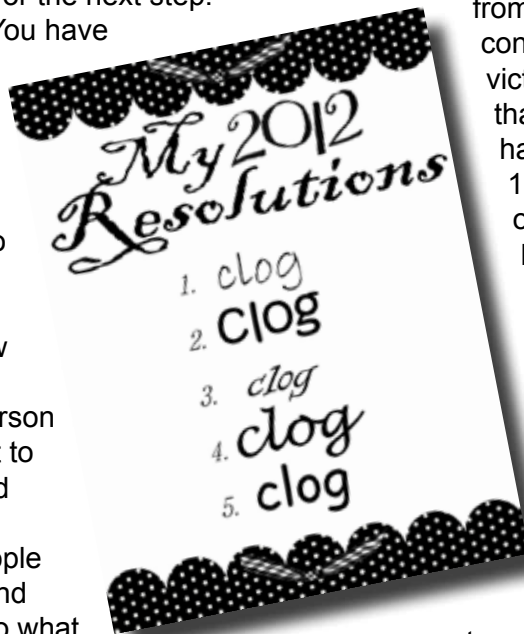
30 Things to Do For Yourself This New Year

Remind yourself that you can and will grow stronger from these hard times. And remain conscious of your blessings and victories – all the things in your life that are right. Focus on what you have, not on what you haven't.
18. Start forgiving yourself and others. – We've all been hurt by our own decisions and by others. And while the pain of these experiences is normal, sometimes it lingers for too long. We relive the pain over and over and have a hard time letting go. Forgiveness is the remedy. It doesn't mean you're erasing the past, or forgetting what happened. It means you're letting go of the resentment and pain, and instead choosing to learn from the incident and move on with your life.
19. Start helping those around you. – Care about people. Guide them if you know a better way. The more you help others, the more they will want to help you. Love and kindness begets love and kindness. And so on and so forth.
20. Start listening to your own inner voice. – If it helps, discuss your ideas with those closest to you, but give yourself enough room to follow your own intuition. Be true to yourself. Say what you need to say. Do what you know in your heart is right.
21. Start being attentive to your stress level and take short breaks. – Slow down. Breathe. Give yourself permission to pause, regroup and move forward with clarity and purpose. When you're at your

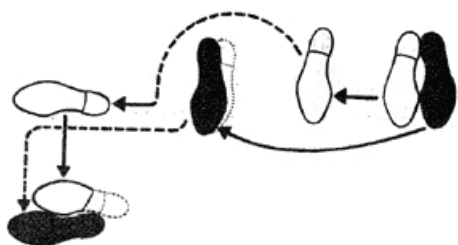


busiest, a brief recess can rejuvenate your mind and increase your productivity. These short breaks will help you regain your sanity and reflect on your recent actions so you can be sure they're in line with your goals.

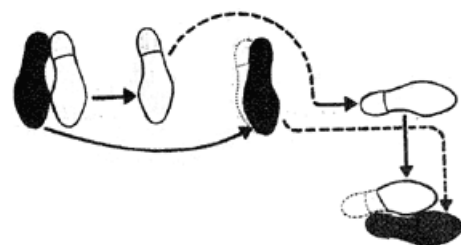
22. Start noticing the beauty of small moments. – Instead of waiting for the big things to happen – marriage, kids, big promotion, winning the lottery – find happiness in the small things that happen every day. Little things like having a quiet cup of coffee in the early morning, or the delicious taste and smell of a homemade meal, or the pleasure of sharing something you enjoy with someone else, or holding hands with your partner. Noticing these small pleasures on a daily basis makes a big difference in the quality of your life.
23. Start accepting things when they are less than perfect. – Remember, 'perfect' is the enemy of 'good.' One of the biggest challenges for people who want to improve themselves and improve the world is learning to accept things as they are. Sometimes it's better to accept and appreciate the world as it is, and people as they are, rather than to trying to make everything and everyone conform to an impossible ideal. No, you shouldn't accept a life of mediocrity, but learn to love and value things when they are less than perfect.
24. Start working toward your goals every single day. – Remember, the journey of a thousand miles begins with one step. Whatever it is you dream about, start taking small, logical steps every day to make it happen. Get out there and DO something! The harder you work the luckier you will become. While many of us decide at some point during the course of our lives that we want to answer our calling, only an astute few of us actually work on it. By 'working on it,' I mean consistently devoting oneself to the end result. Read *The 7 Habits of Highly Effective People*.
25. Start being more open about how you feel. – If you're hurting, give yourself the necessary space and time to hurt, but be open about it. Talk to those closest to you. Tell them the truth about how you feel. Let them listen. The simple act of getting things off your chest and into the open is your first step toward feeling good again.
26. Start taking full accountability for your own life. – Own your choices and mistakes, and be willing to take the necessary steps to improve upon them. Either you take accountability for your life or someone else will. And when they do, you'll become a slave to their ideas and dreams instead of a pioneer of your own. You are the only one who can directly control the outcome of your life.
27. Start actively nurturing your most important relationships. – Bring real, honest joy into your life and the lives of those you love by simply telling them how much they mean to you on a regular basis. You can't be everything to everyone, but you can be everything to a few people. Decide who these people are in your life and treat them like royalty. Remember, you don't need a certain number of friends, just a number of friends you can be certain of.
28. Start concentrating on the things you can control. – You can't change everything, but you can always change something. Wasting your time, talent and emotional energy on things that are beyond your control is a recipe for frustration, misery and stagnation. Invest your energy in the things you can control, and act on them now.
29. Start focusing on the possibility of positive outcomes. – The mind must believe it CAN do something before it is capable of actually doing it. The way to overcome negative thoughts and destructive emotions is to develop opposing, positive emotions that are stronger and more powerful. Listen to your self-talk and replace negative thoughts with positive ones. Regardless of how a situation seems, focus on what you DO WANT to happen, and then take the next positive step forward. No, you can't control everything that happens to you, but you can control how you react to things. Everyone's life has positive and negative aspects – whether or not you're happy and successful in the long run depends greatly on which aspects you focus on. Read *The How of Happiness*.
30. Start noticing how wealthy you are right now. – Henry David Thoreau once said, "Wealth is the ability to fully experience life." Even when times are tough, it's always important to keep things in perspective. You didn't go to sleep hungry last night. You didn't go to sleep outside. You had a choice of what clothes to wear this morning. You hardly broke a sweat today. You didn't spend a minute in fear. You have access to clean drinking water. You have access to medical care. You have access to the Internet. You can read. Some might say you are incredibly wealthy, so remember to be grateful for all the things you do have.

And no, it won't always be easy. Every person has a stack of obstacles in front of them. But you must take accountability for your situation and overcome these obstacles. Choosing not to is choosing a lifetime of mere existence.

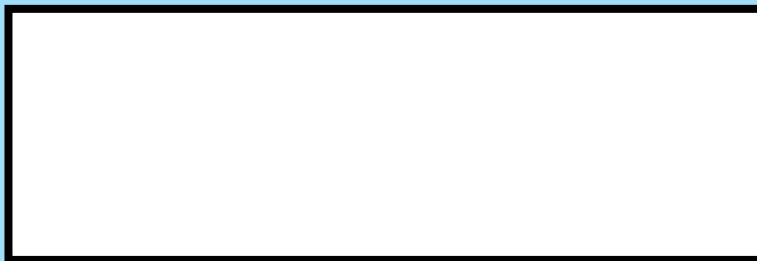
