

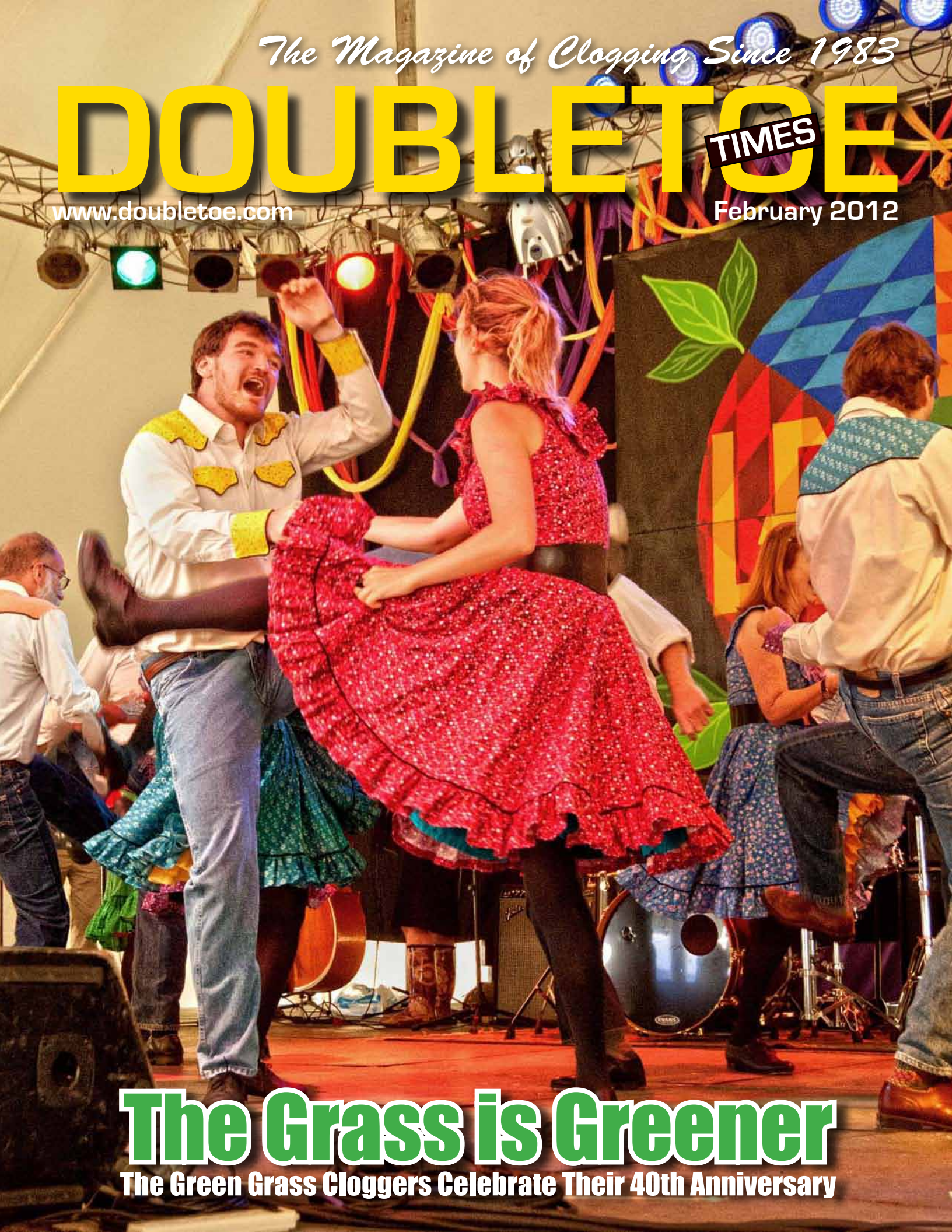

When the Green Grass Cloggers won the world championship of clogging in the early 1970's, they were upstarts. Their fresh and innovative take on this traditional form of Appalachian dance was exciting to those already familiar with flat-footing, buck dancing and clogging, and the high-kicking team went on to enjoy unprecedented success touring around the country and the world.

Founded in 1971 by students at East Carolina University, this past year marked the team's 40th anniversary.

The Green Grass Cloggers were inspired by traditional mountain-style clogging teams and influenced by older flatfoot and buck dancers they met at a fiddling convention. The team developed its own original eclectic style that was a stylistic departure from other Carolina clogging teams.

They also dressed in old time calico dresses,

blue jeans and black shoes, a uniform they still wear today, when other teams dress in clean cut polyester outfits and white tap shoes. As a result of their original style both in dress and dance, the team won two World Champion Clogger titles.

By 1974, with an established reputation as top-notched performers, the Green Grass Cloggers began to be invited to perform at major folk festivals throughout the United States and Canada. From 1977 until 1987, the "Road Team," which relocated to Asheville, toured full-time

nationally and internationally as a professional dance company, while the "Home Team" remained active in Greenville and throughout North Carolina. By the end of the 1970s, clogging groups inspired by the Green Grass Cloggers had formed in many places across the country. Overseas, the Green Grass Clogger style

was adopted by groups in Japan and in England, where currently it is the predominant style of 'Appalachian' clogging.

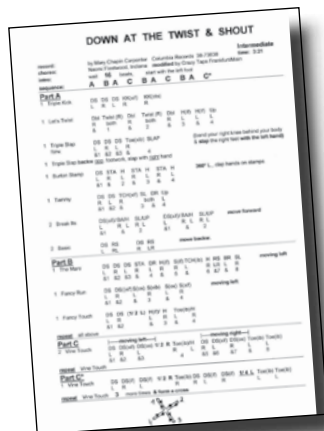

Forty years since it began, a handful of the original members are still dancing, and the team is seeing a revival of interest from young dancers as well as being the focus of a new independently produced documentary. *Year of the Possum: The Green Grass Cloggers' 40th* will be a lighthearted yet thoughtful documentary made by and amongst the Green Grass Cloggers themselves. It will bring you into the celebrations of the 40th anniversary milestone as the team looks backward and forward, and comments on their peculiar role as both the preservers and innovators of this distinctly American tradition. Aiming to be 25-30 minutes in length, the film will combine interviews and performances from the summer of 2011 with footage culled from four decades of clogging on the road and at home in Asheville, North Carolina.

Like the team itself, *Year of the Possum* will not be geared toward making a profit. Rather, it will be a new step forward in continuing the Green Grass legacy, spreading the joy of community oriented dance and keeping alive a vibrant mountain tradition.

The group is fund raising to help ensure that the project will be captured and presented in the highest possible quality. Filmmaker, Bruno Seraphin, who himself is a member of the clogging group, led the project, which just finished editing and will be available soon. Today there are two teams, one based in Asheville, North Carolina and the other in Greenville.

The current Asheville Team includes veteran Green Grass Cloggers dancers Dudley Culp, Rodney Sutton, Doug Baker, Carol Rifkin, Hunt Mallett, Pete Kirchner, and Trina Royar. In January of 2009, Linda Block, Annie Fain Liden, and Holly Baumgartner joined the team. In an exciting move celebrating their 40th year together, the Asheville Team recently expanded the membership to include another generation of young, exceptional dancers, mixing the best of several generations in order to continue the Green Grass style. In 2010 and 2011, Emolyn Liden, Suzannah Park, Sarah Jane Baker, Elizabeth Swann, Dan Baker, Bruno Seraphin, Topher Stevens, Scott Phelps, Ariel Dixon and

Jamie Sparks joined the fold.

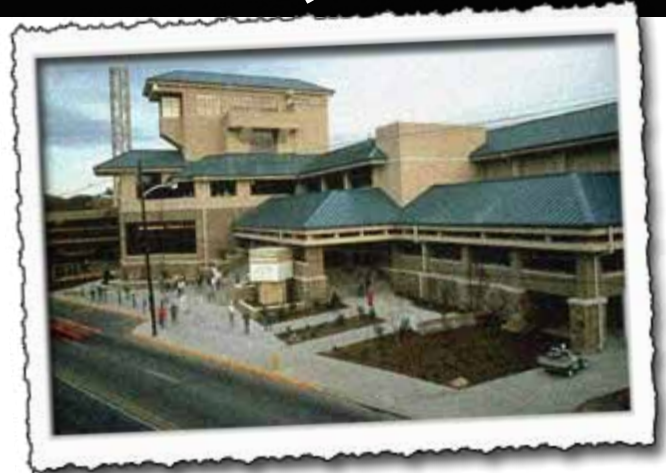

The Teacup Chain

TRY YOUR HAND AT A WESTERN STYLE SQUARE DANCE FIGURE USED BY THE GREEN GRASS CLOGGERS

One of many factors that distinguished the Green Grass Cloggers when the group first appeared in the early 1970's was the groups use of precision footwork to "Western Style" square dance figures.

At the time of the creation of the Green Grass Cloggers in 1971, most exhibition and competitive cloggers teams performed Appalachian style big circle and small circle figures that had been handed down as part of the culture. Often, figures would have different meanings from region to region and there were many varied ways of executing certain figures. What some dancers would call "wave the ocean, wave the sea," others dancers in their area would think of as a "double bow knot," and so on.--

Western style square dancing, much like the Green Grass Cloggers themselves, was an invention of the new era of dancers who took traditional forms and standardized or expounded on them.

Dr. Lloyd Shaw is given much credit for his work in establishing the groundwork of the modern Western style of square dance. He researched square dance figures and their history and introduced it to his high school students and others in his community in the 1930's. His first wide-spread recognition came in the mid '30's with the publication of his book *Cowboy Dances* and with the start of cross-country tours with his Cheyenne Mountain Dancers. All this, just a few years before America's entry into WW2, lit the fire that would eventually propel square dancing (as a household term) into neighborhoods across the country. Shaw's methods and philosophy would make square dancing accessible to all.

Prior to this, in rural communities across America, people enjoyed this form of dancing as a regionalized activity. While there were a few itinerant callers who could handle a whole

evening's program, much of the calling was done by individuals who might know only one or two calls. There were a limited number of books with calls available but fewer than a handful explained how the calling was to be done. The dances themselves were uncomplicated when compared to today's square dancing and, without sound amplification, the calls also were simple.

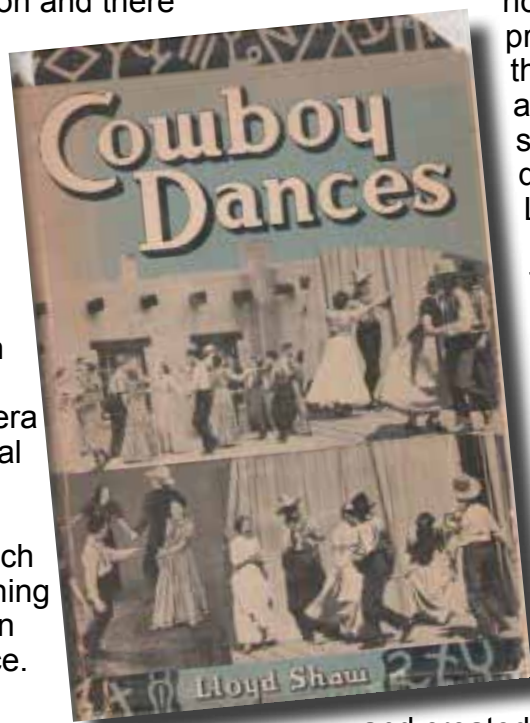
During the war, service personnel and defense workers moved from one area to another and, if a square dance was available, anyone who knew how to call, would likely share in the program. It was during this period that many of the post-war dancers and callers had their first taste of square dancing, but the role of developing leadership would fall to Lloyd Shaw.

Shaw's early cross-country tours and his book created great interest among school teachers and others. A big fan of his work was car maker Henry Ford, who invested his time and resources in promoting this newly emerging standardized set of calls and movements as a means of getting American families into their cars and meeting for square dance activities.

The movement sponsored master classes for callers and created programs of selected calls for consistency in terminology and teaching and calling methods.

With the steady growth of the square dance activity, individual areas came up with their own guidelines and some created their own codes of ethics. For a time, there was little coordination other than that collected and published by *Sets In Order*. This magazine, originally inspired by Lloyd Shaw, broadcast much of the Shaw philosophy, carried articles by the leaders of the day, took the lists of basics from square dance centers around the country, combined them, interpreted their styling to come up with a coordinated list and, in general, became a representative "voice of caller leadership".

By the time of the Green Grass Cloggers, a professional organization called Callerlab was created and galvanized the Western Style square dance activity.

The Green Grass Cloggers took advantage of this new and growing dance form to gather figures for their high-kicking and energetic dances.

One of the figures that the group performed that helped them to win their first World Clogging Championship in the 1970's was a figure called the "Teacup Chain."

Performed from a four couple static square, the figure is a highly orchestrated series of arm turns, passes and progressions around the set.

Gather eight of your most directionally gifted -- and patient -- dancers and try your hand at this classic Western style square dance figure that has served the Green Grass Cloggers so well.

The Teacup Chain

Starting formation - a four couple static square, or proceeding from everyone doing a Left Arm turn with partner. The caller will specify two ladies to move to the center at the start of the call, e.g., "Head ladies center for a Teacup Chain". For the rest of the definition, these two ladies will be called the "specified ladies". The specified ladies (both head ladies or both side ladies) move to the center and Star Right three-quarters to meet their corners for a Left Arm Turn. At the same time, the other two ladies move to the right around the perimeter of the square to their corners, and do a Right Arm Turn. Following the Arm Turns, the specified ladies move around the perimeter of the square to their new corners for a Right Arm Turn, while the other ladies go to the center and Star Left once and a quarter to meet their new corners for a Right Arm Turn. The specified ladies then move to the center and Star Left once and a quarter to their new corners for a Right Arm Turn, while the other ladies move to their new corners (around the perimeter of the square) for a Left Arm Turn. Finally, the specified ladies move to their new corners (their original

partners) for either a Courtesy Turn or a Left Arm Turn leading into the next command, while the other ladies move to the center and Star Right three-quarters to meet their new corners (their original partners) for either a Courtesy Turn or a Left Arm Turn leading into the next command. Everyone finishes with his/her original partner. If the caller desires the men to execute the ladies part and vice versa, as described above, the starting formation is a Static Square with all couples half-sashayed or proceeding from everyone doing a Left Arm Turn with their partner. The proper call is the "Head/Side Men Center for a Teacup Chain".

This call is usually done and taught from Static Squares. It should be noted that it can be called from facing Boy, Girl, Boy, Girl lines.

Teaching Method:

It is best to have the Side girls to back out, leave all the boys and Head girls in place. Have the head girls go to the center, turn 3/4 to the side man that was on her right.

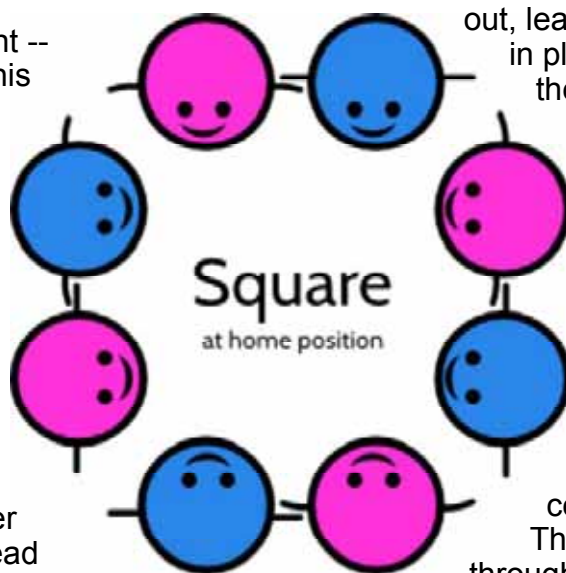
Turn the Side man by the Left and travel to the Head man to her right. Turn him by the right to return to the center of the square. Turn that star 1 1/4 to the other Side man. Turn him by the Right to return to her original Partner who will Courtesy Turn her to face the center of the set.

The head girls should be walked through this procedure 2 or more times. Now, the Head girls will back out and Side girls step in. Stress that all girls start with the Right Hand. The side girls will go to their Corner with a Right arm turn, then into the center for a Left hand Star 1 1/4 to the Side man for a Right hand turn to the other Head man for a Left hand turn back to the center for a 3/4 turn to her Original Partner where he will Courtesy Turn her to face the center of the set.

The side girls should be walked through this 2 or more time. If it seems all the girls understand their path, then put all girls into the square. Walk them through the routine at least once before putting on the music. If this walk through is successful let them dance it with the music with few clues being given.

The caller should give clues if some seem to be having some trouble. It is recommended that the

caller not try to teach the girls both the Head and Side path during the same tip. Reason, the men are doing a lot of turning and might rebel or at the least learn to hate this call. Yet, during the same evening the Head girls should become Side girls and the Side girls should become Head girls to repeat the above routine.

Hints: Stress that the boys have an important role. It is their job to guide the girls to the correct man or center of the square after the arm turn.

Girls will always start with the Right Hand either in the center for a Star or to their Corner.

Girls will visit every man in the square rotating counter clock wise or to their right.

When the girls are in the Star, if they use the right hand it will be a 3/4 turn. If they use the left hand it will be a 1 1/4 turn. This 1 1/4 turn seems to be hard for some ladies.

This is a forearm turn, not a hand turn.

Emphasize that the turns are arm turns and not courtesy turns until the girls return home.

Note that the boys use the same arm twice in a row (Head boys R, R, L, L; Side boys L, R, R, L) while the girls after leading with the right use the free hand/arm throughout. Tell the boys to let the girl determine which arm to use and just take the arm they are given. Let the girls know they are going to their corner and to each new corner. (this can be helpful if the girls are aware of the corner progression that they might see in a singing call.)

Other: The caller can use "Side Ladies Center for a Teacup Chain." It is recommended that this not be used for initial teaching. It is also recommended that Teacup Chain not be initially taught from facing lines.

Teacup Chain should take (32 beats) to perform comfortably. Girls should (may) use skirt work while in the center and if time permits while being arm turned. on the outside.

Some callers teach this call by having all four ladies do the Head Ladies part at the same time. Then having all four ladies do the Side Ladies part at the same time.

Lake Country Cloggers get your toes tapping

The Lake Country Cloggers of Penfield, New York are keeping the dancing traditions of early Europeans, African-Americans and Native Americans alive with rhythmic taps of heels and toes each Monday at Bay Trail Middle School.

You hear them before you see them and the sound is like metallic horseshoes set to the beats of bluegrass music.

"We have all come to clogging in different ways, says Mary Jo Spallina, director of the dance group. "When I was in Kentucky, I saw it, and when I came back here, I took lessons in the 1980s and a lot of us have continued to dance."

The Lake Country Cloggers are an amateur dance team that perform at venues, festivals and events across the area including the New York State Fair. The group has about a dozen members, but has had up to double that many in the past. They are looking for new cloggers, especially men, Spallina says. Clogging is a combination of tap, square, line, traditional and Irish dancing. Dancers wear shoes with taps on the toe and heel and use them to tap rhythm to the music, which can range from traditional folk to Lady Gaga.

"It's good exercise and it's a lot of fun," says Spallina.

Clogging is a big deal in the South, Midwest and other parts of the country. There are competitions, and teams even show up on television network talent shows.

Spallina says if you travel to different areas across the country, you will see different styles of clogging. And you can clog to anything that gets your toes tapping.

Mae Church has been clogging for 25 years.

"We are just girls and guys that got together and formed a team," she says. "We started the team, put some fliers out and people starting hiring us from nursing homes and other places."

"It's just fun meeting new people and learning the dances and stuff," says Jen Beachner of Greece. "We have a lot of fun."

FOOT STOMPIN' IN THE BIG APPLE

A two-hour clog-dancing class with City Stompers, a group that meets at a studio in Chelsea most Friday nights, is far from a wimpy exercise routine

After Jennifer Shaoul's tae kwon do instructor died five years ago, she struggled to find a replacement for the exercise she so dearly loved. Ms. Shaoul found an unlikely substitute: clog dancing.

"It has the same benefit in that you're working out hard, but you're focusing so hard," she said. "You're not focusing on the exercise, but you're focusing on the art."

Ms. Shaoul, a 49-year-old manager at a nonprofit organization that helps people with disabilities, had no previous dance training when she decided to try a two-hour clogging class with City Stompers, a group that meets at a studio space on West 26th Street in Chelsea most Friday nights.

Clogging differs from tap dancing because dancers keep their knees loose, emphasize the downbeat and usually perform to bluegrass. The foundation steps are simple: the basic (shuffle-ball-change), a single (shuffle-step) and a double (a single and a basic).

But this is not a wimpy exercise routine unfit for serious gym rats. The steps are strung together into more difficult combinations, and the combinations form five- to six-minute routines specifically choreographed to pieces of music that call for movement around the room and, in some cases, interaction with other dancers.

On the Friday evening I was there, dancers were experiencing an intense aerobic workout and having fun. At the end of the first routine, they weren't biting their lips in concentration, they were smiling.

Rebecca Faye Powers, 26, one of the instructors and a former ballet dancer, said clog dancing "gives you an awareness of your body similar to yoga; you have to be so attentive

and so precise with your movements." She said it was also useful for building abdominal and leg strength.

The class draws men and women of a range of ages, physical ability and experience. Many of them have injuries that prevent them from doing other forms of dance and exercise, and they find that clog dancing accommodates their limitations.

"For the most part you can dance at whatever level you are, and still feel like you're part of it," said D. L. Anderson, 54, a teacher and performance artist from Brooklyn.

Clog dancing also tests the mind. It requires excellent memory, coordination, rhythm and perhaps most important, a willingness to look and feel silly. Watching the class reminded me of a magnet on my refrigerator at home that reads, "Let go, or be dragged."

After one particularly challenging routine, Megan Downes, 41, an instructor who has been teaching dance for 20 years, admonished the class for over thinking the steps.

"Not everything is crystal clear," she said. "You just have to throw yourself into it." Now there's an adage that belongs on a magnet.

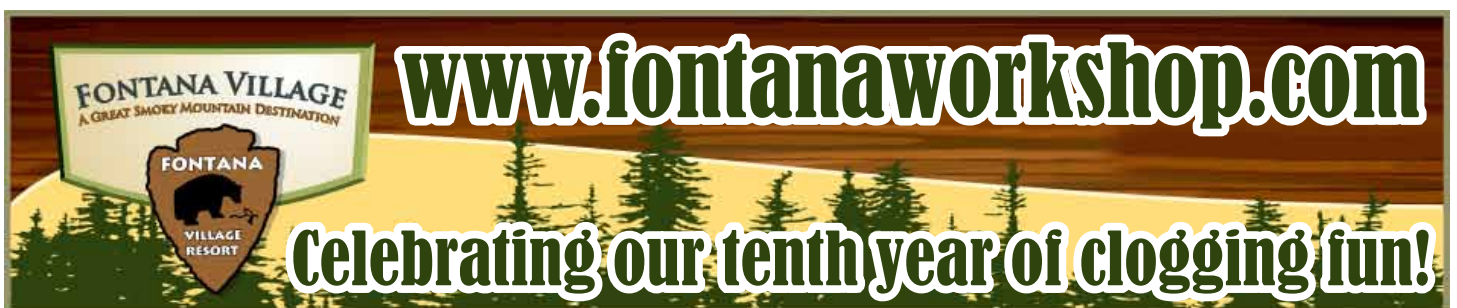
