Sam: I Am a Winner! National Champion Team Dancer Sam Enck Turns Her Dance Passion into Competition Gold

Samantha Enck no longer clogs down the aisles of the local Kmart and Walmart stores.

But the Grand Island, Nebraska Senior High freshman clogs nearly everywhere else she goes, including at home, her twice-monthly rehearsals in Lincoln, in Branson, Mo., and in Knoxville, Tenn.

The last venue was where Enck, performing as part of a team named Tap That, won a second

straight national championship at the Clogging Championship of America Showdown held in Knoxville, Tennessee.

Tap That won its first national championship in January 2011 in Knoxville, then returned for a successful defense of its title last month.

Like many accomplished and enthusiastic dancers, Enck's interest began

when she was just 3 years old, as she began taking tap, ballet and jazz lessons at Heartland School of Dance in Grand Island.

But when Enck reached age 9, she experienced what sometimes happens to dancers: a sense of burnout after spending many hours and years at the same activity. Some dancers press through that stage and get a second wind.

But Enck's second wind came courtesy of her grandmother, Lynne Manning of Grand Island, who read an article the local "The Independent" newspaper about a new clogging dance studio in nearby Aurora. Manning thought her granddaughter might continue to enjoy dance if she could learn a new style.

And that's exactly what happened. Enck's enthusiasm for clogging was so great



she would spontaneously break out in clogging moves when moving down the Kmart and Walmart aisles while shopping with her mother, Michelle.

Enck said she no longer clogs in stores. She realizes that what looked cute when she was 9 would not look so cute when done by a high school freshman. Yet her enthusiasm for clogging remains high.

It has to, considering the miles she and her mother pile up traveling to and from dance rehearsals and performances.

> Initially, they began making the short trip to Aurora for lessons. Unfortunately, the original owner and operator of the Aurora dance studio quit her business after only three months. However, instructor Joel Harrison of Lincoln took over the clogging lessons, but moved them farther east, to York.

The weekly lessons


in York lasted about four years. Then, Harrison eventually decided to close down his York lessons because it was getting too difficult to teach clogging in both Lincoln and York. However, he invited all his York dancers to come to Lincoln.

So Enck and her mother began driving even farther for rehearsals.

Enck's clogging has always had a competitive aspect to it, even in Aurora. "She made the team within 30 days," Michelle said.

When the lessons moved to York, Enck said, the name of her new team was Intensity. After starting her lessons in Lincoln, Enck became part of Tap That. During most of the year, Enck and her mother travel to Lincoln two *(Continued on page 10)*

Sundays per month so she can rehearse.

Enck said many Sunday rehearsals last about three hours. But when competition draws near, rehearsals may stretch out to eight hours. That's a lot of energy expended and calories burned. "Thirty minutes of clogging equals running seven miles," Enck said.

Those eight-hour Sunday rehearsals for competitions are supplemented by Tuesday night and Wednesday night rehearsals, which usually run from 6 to 9 p.m.

That can create scheduling problems for Enck, who also is a member of the varsity cheerleading squad and Ultimate Image show choir at Senior High.


Fortunately, school extracurricular activities are not held on Sundays or Wednesdays. Enck said she has a personal priority system for the conflicts that do arise. Tap That rehearsals close to a competition take precedence over cheerleading practice. But cheerleading for a game would take priority over a Tap That rehearsal.

An Ultimate Image rehearsal, if a show choir competition is nearer than a clogging competition, would take precedence over a clogging rehearsal.

Enck said it helps that the adult leaders for cheerleading, show choir and clogging are aware of her interests in all three areas. They try to make reasonable accommodations for an occasional absence so she can pursue all three interests.

While Enck no longer dances in store aisles, she does practice clogging in some unusual places and at unusual times.

Her mother said when they are riding home from clogging rehearsal - especially as Tap That nears a competition - Samantha will practice her arm moves as she sits in the passenger seat during *(Continued on page 10)*

the ride back to Grand Island.

Enck said when she gets home she'll often go down to the basement for a quick review of all the dance moves she rehearsed earlier in Lincoln, even if she gets home late on a Tuesday or Wednesday night.

Despite an often hectic schedule, Enck is an honor roll student.

The Senior High freshman does more than rehearse and dance for competitions. She said one of the fun things she did as part of Tap That in 2011 was perform for the opening ceremony of the Special Olympics in Lincoln.

Enck said she and some of the other members of Tap That who

were willing to make the trip traveled to Branson, Mo., to perform at Silver Dollar City. "We did four, 30-minute shows for a week," she said.

In exchange for their performances, everyone got heavily discounted tickets for amusement rides and some shows.

Enck also has performed because of familial

pride. The pride came from her late great-grandmother, Fran Quisenberry, who loved to see Samantha perform clogging routines at her home of Bickford Cottage. Typically, other Bickford residents would gather so they could also enjoy the performances.

Getting to Knoxville to become champions two years in a row required Tap That to get through qualifying competitions in Ohio and South Carolina. At Knoxville, Tap That won first in standing line, a cappella and moving line.

It then got to perform standing line, a cappella and moving line for the overall championship, winning the crown with its top-scoring performance in moving line.

Enck said she definitely wants to continue being part of Tap That. She is not burning out. She noted Harrison is a motivational teacher.

Her mother said it also helps that members of Tap That are a tight group. At age 15, Enck is the youngest dancer, with the next youngest member

age 18. Most others are in their 20s.

Enck said that gives the group a family feel. Older, more experienced members act as "big sisters" to younger, less experienced dancers. All are dedicated.

While Enck juggles school and extracurriculars, others juggle work responsibilities. Enck does not even travel the farthest

for rehearsal. That distinction belongs to a dancer from Holbrook.

Still, Enck and her mother drive the second longest distance. Asked about a driver's license, Enck replied, "Not until next year."

Her mother then answered the next question before it was even asked. "I'm still driving," she said.

The Mulekicker Cloggers Missouri Team Has Been Kicking Up Their Heels for 25 Years!

Columbia, Missouri — Summer is just around the corner and that means performance season for clogging teams everywhere.

From plywood stages at county fairs to blacktop streets to parade floats, It is not unusual to find a group of dancers energetically stepping out to show off their clogging skills. But there is one thing in this group of Missouri clog dancers that stands out even more than their costumes and the tapping sound of their shoes: a smile on each face.

They are the Mulekicker Cloggers, a performance clogging group based in Fulton, Missouri.

Director and instructor Patricia Hopper said the group has been performina at fairs. festivals other events around the state for 25 years. The group, which consists of nine women and one man, also regularly performs for nursing homes. Most of the dancers have been associated with the group for more than two decades.

Clogging is not a common dance form anymore in the area, and there might only be one or two such groups within a 70-mile radius of Columbia, Hopper said.

"It's a combination of tap, Appalachian, square and buck dances with an element of folk dancing as well," member Rita Weber said.

Hopper said clogging was a common dance in the Appalachian Mountain region in the 19th century, and that's where it collected various elements from other dance forms.

The traditional form of the dance has eight basic steps, and together

they can form different dance formations.

"Usually, the rhythm is built with heel on one foot and the toe of the other," Weber said. Weber said she was in a square dancing club in Fulton, where she first met Hopper and became interested in clogging.

The shoes used for clogging are similar to ones used for tap dancing with one difference: The metal taps are free to swivel. Weber said this allows the double echoing sound effect when the shoes are tapped on the ground.

Hopper said they chose the word mule to be part of their group's name because Fulton, the group's hometown, is the mule capital of the world. Kicker, the other word in the group's name, is a basic dance movement in clogging, Hopper said.

The women wear a knee-length shirt-waist dress with the hem of the frock decorated with flounces and ruffles. The male costume, worn by Larry Martin, consists of white trousers and a blue shirt with a big gold star on the front and colorful stripes on the back and arms. All the dancers wear white shoes.

"We want the costumes to be showy," Hopper said. "We like to make them colorful."

The group's costumes are custom-designed and handmade by Hopper. She said she makes new costumes every two or three years. It takes Hopper eight hours to put together a

costume from scratch. A crowd looked on as the (Continued on page 16)

Mulekickers danced at the fairgrounds at a recent show. Some walked past with a hint of surprised joy on their faces while others stood and took photos. Others tapped their feet to the rhythm of the music.

Cathy Gerling watched closely as other spectators moved by. She said she attends every time the Mulekickers perform because her mother is part of the group.

"I smile every time I watch them. It makes me so happy," Gerling said. "It's like perma-grin."

Hopper choreographs the group's dances. They started by clogging to "Cotton-Eyed Joe" and followed it up with songs like "Locomotion" and some country music instrumentals. They also danced to a salsa tune. As the rest of the dancers danced in single file before the last song, Martin broke the line to do a cartwheel.

The heat and the cloudless sky prompted the cloggers to take several breaks during their dance routines.

"We're a little warm today," Hopper said on the microphone as the rest of the group stopped to catch their breath between the songs.

Jackie Cole has been with the group for 17 years. She said clog dancing is a form of catharsis for her. "You can stomp out a lot of your problems out," she said, playfully tapping her heels on the ground.

Hopper said the group's members have gone through a lot together over the years, and that has strengthened the bond of their friendships.

"We are friends first and then showmen," she said. Hopper recalled the difficult news of Cole's breast cancer diagnosis a few years ago. It was tough for the rest of the group, but Cole only missed two weeks of practice and was clogging again the night after her surgery.

Cole said she was introduced to the dance by her brother, Larry Martin. Martin, along with Hopper, Cole and Weber, is one of the original four members who have stayed with the group since it was formed.

Martin, 67, said that being the only man in the group brings out the best in him.

"That's why I have to do so good — because I have to keep up with all the ladies," he said.

Linda Kronk said she has been clogging for 24 years. She said she has loved it all along.

"I love to entertain, and it's good exercise," she said. The Mulekicker Cloggers perform at fairs and festivals and are featured yearly at the Missouri State Fair.

"Do another cartwheel, Larry!" the women cheered after the cloggers had taken a bow to finish the day's performance. And Martin did just that.

Couple brings Appalachian clogging to Fairbanks, Alaska

FAIRBANKS - When Bruno and Judith Grunau moved to Fairbanks, Alaska from the East Coast four years ago, they grabbed the opportunity to pass on a tradition from southwest Virginia: Appalachian-style clogging.

"It's a percussive dance with your feet," Bruno Grunau, a research and testing engineer at the Cold Climate Housing Research Center. The dance is Celtic in origin, mixed with Native American and early African-American dance styles. It incorporates clogging, flatfooting and buck dance and was popular in Appalachian communities as far back as the 18th century.

Dancers wear leather-bottom shoes with hard soles, sometimes with taps on the heel and toe. A wooden dance floor is preferred, to boost the sound of the heel and toe striking the floor with an emphasis on the downbeat.

Appalachian-style clogging is done to old-style

"We had a hard time finding a space that's free that had wooden floors," Grunau said. The Fairbanks Arts Association agreed to sponsor the group, which now has a weekly lesson and dance at Pioneer Park. Bowers' band, Lost Dog, accompanies the dancers, which has taken on the moniker of the Appalaskan Cloggers.

The weekly lessons and dance practice are free and open to the public.

"What we teach is Appalachian traditional," Grunau said. "It's not about precision, but more about unity and having fun."

The group gave its first public performance in February at the Winter Folk Fest. Grunau said the group is growing and he hopes it continues to strengthen.

"You teach it for free and you get people to come and the tradition carries on," Grunau said.

music with a fiddle, banjo or guitar, Grunau said. "It's not bluegrass; it kind of preceded bluegrass."

Grunau hadn't been in Fairbanks long when he connected with Pete Bowers, a prominent musician and scholar of the old-time music community in Ester. Bowers encouraged Grunau to start a local clogging group.
