Present Perfect

As clogging teachers, we collect tons of music and cuesheets.

I remember when I first started teaching clogging and we used 45 rpm records and you always had to go through your collection and pick a selection to bring to the workshops. Then came cassette tapes and we were thrilled that we didn't have to have a quarter on hand to weight down the phonograph arm for a skipping record.

When CDs came along, we thought it couldn't get any better. We could make a CD with just the songs we were teaching to, or make special CDs of favorites.

Now, in the digital age, we can have all of our music on our cellular phone. How crazy is that?

The downside to having digital files is that -- without a backup or hard copies -- we can lose important files we have spent years compiling.

I learned this the hard way a couple of years ago when I had gotten a new computer for the Double Toe Times and put all of the files from the old one onto the portable hard drive I backed up to and then I reformatted the old computer. I didn't want to fill the new computer with years of workshop and old files, so I took the hard drive and my laptop to a convention to go through the files and delete all of the old and unneeded ones. During the weekend, my backpack with laptop, back-up files, camera and other items was stolen by a non-clogger. I was devastated.

The perfect storm had happened and all of my data was lost... music, cuesheets, Double Toe Times layouts and subscriber data. It took months to go through the subscriber forms I had kept for tax purposes and rebuild the office files, but my clogging files were all gone.

Luckily, cloggers who I had sent cues to recently sent them back and I slowly started getting my most recent choreography back.

I was at a workshop last month after the event and socializing with friends when I was asked to come to the center of the room. Colleen Zurbrigg of Ontario, Canada presented me with a hand-made book of nearly 200 of my cuesheets from throughout the years. Her dear friend Wayne said she had spent countless hours gathering them, cleaning them up for printing and binding of the book, as well as digitizing each to a PDF file that was included on a thumbdrive.

I cannot express how touched I am by this amazing act of kindness and generosity. I love this family of clogging more than you can know.

Siblings In Synch

Clermont, Georgia Clogging Clan Stays in Step with a Winning Dance Team

The Cantrell siblings are a high-kicking, toestanding, clog dancing conundrum. It's not every day that you meet brothers and sisters ranging in age from 11 to 17 who are willing spend the bulk of their waking hours together.

It's also not every day you meet a group of young performers so focused on keeping an oldschool style of folk dance alive.

"We started clogging eight years ago," said 17-year-old Callie Cantrell, whose family lives in Clermont.

"Mama didn't want us to be all scattered around with sports and stuff, so she started looking for something we could all do together."

"I chose clogging because it's something that's

not gender-oriented and it crosses all economic and age groups and it's very family-friendly," said Sandra Cantrell, the mother of the family.

"They didn't know what clogging was at first. They thought it was like tap dancing." Although they seem similar, clogging is a bit different than tap dance. Whereas tap dancers perform to a song's melody, cloggers are focused more on a song's downbeat.

Also, tap dancers use the stationary taps on their shoes to make sounds; cloggers' shoes have jingle taps and get most of their sounds from the heels of their feet.

Their team, Synergy, under the direction of by Sarah Darby and based out of Sole Impulse Dance Studio in Cumming, has racked up numerous awards, including back-to-back national titles.

"Sarah has been such a motivator to them as

she relates well to them and doesn't put up with anything and siblings need a lot of that," Mrs. Cantrell said. "She loves them, and they know it, and after all is said and done. That's what it takes. They don't want to disappoint her, and she is always meeting them where they are and pushing them to do their best."


Cantrell credits teammates, particularly Ashley, Cammi & Merm, for making the family feel so special. "They have

been awesome," she said. "They each bring something unique to the team and their friendships have been invaluable. Each team member is like family."

The siblings have also won individual awards such as Parker Cantrell's Grand Champion Amateur Male title. He secured that honor at the Clogging Champions of America's Showdown of Champions in Tennessee a few weeks ago.

"Before I went to the dance-off, my teacher pulled me aside and said I had a really good chance of winning if I poured myself into it, so that's what I did," said Parker, 15.

Keeping a growing teenager in clogging shoes has been a challenge. The family handed down clogging shoes for years until Parker's feet began to outgrow everyone's. "Parker usually blows the toes out of his shoes first and is very proud of that fact," Mrs. Cantrell said.

With the other nonfamily members of their team, the Cantrells compete in about six competitions each year.

"We try to practice every day," said Savannah Cantrell, 13. Practice not only makes perfect, it also builds the stamina the dancers need to compete in the all-day competitions.

"At the last competition we were still dancing at 2 a.m.," said 11-year-old Jackson Cantrell.

When competitions are close, they each fall into their unique roles.

"Callie is constantly dancing with her fingers memorizing routines, "Mrs. Cantrell said. "Some folks think she is being rude by tapping her fingers, but she is dancing with them! It's just the way she learns,

so she tells us. She is the one who corrects the others and helps them perfect or clean up new steps while Parker is the motivator and pushes them to beef up their practice in preparation for a competition. Jackson is just a show off (and he knows it), and Savannah is a real workhorse and perfectionist. She helps her sister a great deal with their exhibition team that meets at our home basement studio each week."

During a rehearsal, if one of her siblings falls out of step, Callie only has to give a slight, negative shake of her head and everyone knows to start over. And they do, without a single complaint.

Although they all started clogging at the same time, Callie's leadership skills naturally shine through. When she was 14, she started offering lessons out of their basement studio.

"It's just a recreational group," Callie said. "It's mostly kids, but there are some adults that come, too."

Her students, the Spitfire Cloggers, meet every Thursday for lessons. They also perform at various community events.

Community performances give the Cantrells

another opportunity to practice their skills, and also help them educate the public about their art form. Clogging isn't all about petticoats and stiff upper bodies anymore.

"There's a lot of hiphop dance in it now. They also incorporate Irish Step, Canadian Step and toe stands in all their work," Sandra Cantrell said.

"It has evolved a lot over time. Some teams still wear the big petticoats and stuff, but (Continued on page 10)

a majority of the teams don't."

Between their home-schooling and dancing, the Cantrells are rarely apart, but no one seems to mind.

"We like it," Callie said. "Sometimes we fuss just like any other brothers and sisters, but we like being together."

There may be one thing they like better: clogging competitions.

"It's a lot of fun," Jackson said. "Especially when you get to bring home trophies that are the same size as you are."

In addition to excelling in clogging, the family are also musicians. Callie started playing upright bass two years ago, and Parker has played banjo for seven years, Jackson has played guitar for five years and Savannah the fiddle for six years. The family says that their biggest accomplishment has been being able to learn to play pretty music together. Each of them received scholarships to the Georgia Mountain Pick n' Bow Traditional School of Music and make up their own bluegrass band. Whenever possible, they perform music and clogging at area festivals, benefits, and for nursing homes, churches,


daycares and various interested groups. "Parker is just trying to put together his banjo playing with his clogging double doubles," Mrs. Cantrell said.

Sandra not only has a full time job in homeschooling the children and trying to keep up with their busy schedules, but she is a clogger as well, dancing with the Adult Synergy team, and have a ball with them every week during practice.

"My favorite thing is travel to the competitions as a family and enjoy the camaraderie of the other parents while watching each dancer on the team blossom," Cantrell said. "It seems like at every competition there is something new and fresh that someone has brought to the stage that is for the audience to enjoy."

She also loves designing and sewing clogging costumes to help save money and support the family's addiction - clogging. "It really is addicting," she said. "Once you learn a routine and perform it, you will love it from then on!"

The Cantrell children say that their goals are to win a national title and make the *All Pro Team*, the highest dancer honor at the Clogging Champions of America circuit that the family dances as part of. They also say they plan to continue dancing throughout college into adulthood and do their best each time they take the stage.

Writer experiences Appalachian dance style from folk school's award-winning group

Brasstown, North Carolina – It's a frightening notion to imagine being a mouse trying to maneuver across the stage once the Campbell Folk School Cloggers launch into a full routine. Once they start, they pound the wood floors and don't quit until the fiddle stops.

"The idea is what we do is make the beat. We make as much noise as we can," said Michelle Maloney, a 10-year clogger from Blairsville, Ga.

I watched them, completely fixated on their feet and the claps of the jingle taps on the wood. I hadn't known what the bottom of a clog looked like, much less how to do it, when I joined the beginners class at John C. Campbell Folk School.

I knew it was a style steeped in Appalachian history, the use of country and folk music making it unmistakably regional. It reminds me of a combination of line and tap dancing. The steps and accompanying sound hint at a Scottish-Irish influence. An uninformed outsider like myself could easily confuse it with Irish step dancing.

"It's like a cousin of tap dancing and river dancing. It started in England, transitioned from New England and filtered down south," describes Brian Gatti, a 16-year-old clogger and Nantahala High School student.

The dancers – elementary school students, teenagers, parents and grandparents – made it look easy. With a background in basic coordination and little else, I followed cues from instructor Dianne Jackson.

We were schooled in Appalachian precision clogging, meaning we all did the same routine. As it gets more intermediate, styles include breaking off into pairs, traveling and making formations. Our class was for the bunny slope crowd.

Jackson showed us how to do a "single basic," which means kicking the toe out to make a double sound then a step and a rock step. A rock step requires picking up the foot and rocking on the ball of it without leaning on the heels. It's the foundation step.


We took our time working up to doubles and triples of the same step. Think slow motion "Boot Scootin' Boogie." It wasn't too challenging, but

required constant awareness of cue definitions. It was a cerebral exercise to remember that a "fancy double" meant two rock steps and two kicks.

"What I like about it is it makes me think in order to remember the routines. It really keeps you going up here," Maloney said, tapping on her temple. "That's part of it – the intellectual stuff. I'm into the physical, too."

I really started sweating when Jackson introduced us to the "Fontana," a move Jackson said originated in Fontana Village in Graham County in the 1950s. It's essentially brushing your foot on the floor, bringing up the knee and clicking the opposite heel on the floor while the other is in mid-air. This one tripped me up a few times.

I was assured it takes time to make the move a fluid action. Hiwassee Dam resident Kevon Hardin found that she maintained her balance if she did the steps quicker, so I followed suit.

"It's very heart healthy," Hardin said.

Retired and "full-time funning," as she called it, Hardin felt

moved to pick up clogging. She said she took tap dance classes when she was a child.

"I read about the class in the local newspaper. It said beginners class, and I said 'That's for me,' " Hardin said.

She was right about going faster, but our instructor's suggestion was to take it slow to avoid kicking out too far or hitting the wrong part of the foot on the floor.

The beginners don't wear clogs. We were told to focus first on the basics before worrying about doing it correctly. In fact, the mess ups and constant teetering on one foot brought out a semblance of fellowship among the newbies.

"It's very individual. That's what's so nice about this group. It's not competitive. We do festivals, exhibitions, nursing homes. We're not aiming to be competitive," Maloney said.

The cloggers have a board of directors and vote on where they travel. The Campbell Folk

School Cloggers formed in the fall of 1989. Jackson said the early 1990s saw the team competing, but they stopped. They do most of their performances in spring and fall.

"In 1991, we traveled to Denmark for two weeks and danced throughout the country," Jackson said. "Some of the teammates went back in 1994 or 1995. In 2002, we traveled to Washington for the Fourth of July festivities in their parade.

Other than that we dance locally at different festivals and church functions. We really try to stay to non-profit organizations.

"We dance some in Hayesville, Andrews and Blairsville, Ga. The folk school frowns on competition. They like more of a camaraderie of students learning from other students."

Gatti said clogging is about being yourself and feeling open. Regardless of skill level, there will be a group to dance with. The teens are a tight unit and have some of the fastest feet I've ever seen.

"My sister brought me over here. I started with Brian. We've been friends ever since," said Rivkah Holder, a 16-year-old

home school student.

Twins Cori and Katie Pressley were dancers as little girls. They've been in the Brasstown clogging scene for more than five years. Cori performed tap, ballet and gymnastics before becoming a clogger. She was down to Earth about why the other types of dance weren't for her.

"The dancing was provocative and a bit expensive," Cori said.

For only one dollar, I was able to attend the beginner's class and discover I had more than a passing interest in clogging. I hear it's an addiction once you start. I'm not sure if that's what's happening to me, but lately I find myself sneaking in a "Fontana" when no one is looking.
