In this issue of the Double Toe Times, we mourn the loss of a dear friend, Bobbi Boyce of Texas.

Bobbi, like so many others, discovered clogging when she was over the age of 40 and embraced it whole-heartedly, dancing and supporting local events and workshops as well as volunteering as an officer of the Texas Clogging Council and acting as a mentor to countless cloggers in her state.

Bobbi lost a bravely fought battle against cancer this past month. She had hoped to feel better and come to the Fontana Clogging Jamboree in the hills of North Carolina, an event that she loved dearly. Her spirit will be there with us as we celebrate ten years of jamborees in this beautiful mountain resort.

I recall a conversation I had many years ago with legendary clogging instructor Charlie Burns, who didn't begin clogging until he slowed down after a career and raising a family. In the early 1980's, when I first started attending workshops, Charlie Burns and Steve Smith were a formidable duo who taught hundreds of students in their native Kentucky and were favorites on the workshop circuit.

During a workshop in California that we had done for several years together, Charlie mentioned to me during dinner that he wished that he had discovered clogging earlier in his life and that I should be thankful to have started so young and I should appreciate the chance to do this for as long as I wish. Charlie has since retired from clogging, and Steve has limited his engagements drastically in recent years. So many of the people who were influential in the great growth of clogging in the 1980's are no longer able to dance or are no longer with us.

I guess I had thought that folks like Charlie had always been clogging. I grew up around square dancing and country music, but didn't begin clogging until college. I, myself, wished I had found clogging earlier in life. Now, 30 years into my clogging life, my knees ache and I get writers block, but I can't imagine walking away from the family I have made in this clogging world.

Bobbi fought against illness hoping for more time with her beloved family and her clogging family. Charlie retired from the dance he loved knowing he began a journey at an age when many are slowing down... and became a beloved clogging icon.

Whether you are a teen clogger, a young dancer juggling family responsibilities and your love of dance, or a senior who just discovered the clogging world, know that this activity will always welcome you to the floor and will always be here for you. Make the most of each day and be thankful that you are a clogger.



Rediscovering a Town's Roots, Feet First

CIRCLEVILLE, W.Va. — The Pendleton County Fair, held over four days in July in this tiny, no-stoplight town, had all the trappings of good, clean fun funnel cake, a ringtoss game, a magician clowning with children from the audience.

A bouncy castle and spinning swing were set up outside the former high school, the Allegheny Mountains rising nearby. Miss Pendleton County Queen and Miss Pendleton Teen were crowned on opening night; the next day, the girls, 19 and 13, loitered in their sashes and sparkling crowns.

There was also, after a two-year absence, a square dance in the un-air-conditioned school gym. A scoreboard announced that this had once been

Indians territory, but on this evening, the floor was filled with expert cloggers and eager twirlers, many in bare feet. A little girl in a yellow bonnet spun around with her mother. The band strummed its way through Appalachian songs as callers shouted to circle left, circle right, do-si-do. "Tip your hat and tie your shoe; now your partner's following you!"

The return of the Pendleton County dance was spurred by the Augusta Heritage Center, a resource for folk life studies out of Davis & Elkins College, about an hour away. The center's Mountain Dance Trail project has helped organize dances across the state, cultivating tradition county by county. With a nod to the Bourbon Trail in Kentucky and the Crooked Road music trail in Virginia, it is a homegrown effort to revive and brand a West Virginia legacy.

There is no better way to get to know the locals in "a little out-of-the-way town" than to dance with them, said Gerald Milnes, the folk arts coordinator at Augusta who came up with the idea for the trail. And if you're lucky, he said, "you get offered a drink out at the truck."

With promotion from the Mountain Dance Trail, this dance drew people from neighboring counties and states, as well as from just up the road.

started

square dancing in grade school in Circleville, where he still lives. "I think it just gets in your blood," he said. He offered a welcoming hand to newcomers at the gym.

Much of the talk among Mr. Arbaugh's friends was of other dances in other places — Maggie Valley, N.C., known as the clogging capital of the world, or the Canaan Valley nearby. They used to have a square dance there, said Don Nelson, 68, a retired telescope operator, "but you had to fight your way in."

Not so Circleville, an unincorporated area with fewer than 350 households about three and a half hours from Washington. "The nice thing about a county like this," Mr. Nelson said, talking about dancing but not only that, is that "if you screw up, they'll straighten you right out."

The Mountain Dance Trail began this year as an oral history project. Through the AmeriCorps program, Mr. Milnes hired Becky Hill, 23, an alumna of Davis & Elkins, and with money from a Kickstarter fund and some small state grants, the two traveled along Route 33, which runs east to west across the state, interviewing the

oldest square dance callers they could find, documenting their dance styles and histories.

"The reason we did interviews was to capture these stories, about the boozing and the drinking and the fighting," Ms. Hill said. "What makes this dance so important is not just a dance move, but everything that's around that, that makes it alive."

"It's like regional identity for a lot of the folks around here," she added. "They grow up with the fiddle music and the banjo music, and dancing in their homes. It's part of who they are."

Dance styles change by region, Ms. Hill said. In Circleville, big mountain circle dancing dominates. In Henderson, a few hours away, it is Appalachian four-couple sets.

At the dance, Ellen Ratcliffe, 65, a retired banker from Monterey, Va., showed off her skills as a flatfooter, which uses the heel instead of the toe, and involves stepping on every beat. "It's very personal. You just let your feet be the melody and go with that."

Not everyone was so accomplished. "Excuse me, are you interested in cakewalking?" a young man asked a young woman sitting on the side. "I'm not very good," he offered, by way of enticement. Up she went.

The young man, Dominick Pugliese, a camp counselor from Maryland had brought 13 teenage campers to Circleville







after one of them saw a flier for the Dance Trail. The highlight of the trip, he said, "It's hard to be really awful at square dancing."

For locals, the resurrection of the community square dance — and the presence of young people — were a welcome sight.

"I had a dance in Upper Tract back in June," said Dana M. Keplinger, 62, a resident of that unincorporated area, high up in the mountains. "There hadn't been a dance in that old schoolhouse since probably I was a kid. And it was packed."

The clogging world mourns the passing of Texas Clogger and instructor Bobbi Boyce, 67, who passed away at her home on Monday, July 23, 2012 -- one day shy of her 68th birthday -- in Campbellton, Texas after a valiant battle against cancer.

Bobbi will be remembered best for her generous nature, sharp wit and guick smile. She held advanced of the Cloggers Showcase of San Antonio. In 2003 she was chosen to be honored as the TCC's Clogger of the Year.

Texas clogging instructor Garland Bullock shared his remembrances of Bobbi. "When I first became interested in clogging in Austin, I constantly heard the name Bobbi Boyce," Bullock said. "It would be years before I actually met Bobbi at a workshop, and after that time I always tried to take her classes. For me, she was the face of clogging in Texas and a wonderful person always willing to share her knowledge and skills in a delightful way which she often did for me.

degrees in education and taught in Texas public schools for 30 years, spending the majority of her career as a reading specialist and seventhgrade reading teacher at Porter Junior High in Austin.

In the 1990's, Bobbi discovered clogging, a dance style rooted in Appalachian mountain dancing, and became an avid fan, dancing with, directing and co-directing several clogging teams in Texas, including Clickety Cloggers in Austin. She also served as the president of the Texas Clogging Council and chaired the Texas Clogging Rally, the council's largest statewide event. Bobbi made numerous friends across the

country through her involvement in clogging, which was a source of great joy for her during the past 20 years.

"What a great lady," said nationally recognized clogging instructor Chip Summey. "Bobbi always had a great big smile. Heaven is lucky to have gained such a spririted and talented lady. I am sure she is dancing on that big stage in Heaven now."

Bobbi Boyce began teaching clogging in 1995. She taught frequently at the Texas Cloggers' Rally, the Doubletoe Jam workshop, Camp Esperanza Benefit Workshop, and many other workshops in Texas and Oklahoma. She was elected to two terms as president of the Texas Clogging Council (TCC). While holding that office, she also served on the Board of Directors

In addition to her love of clogging, Bobbi loved spending time with her family and cherished her four grandchildren. National clogging instructor Naomi Pyle of Indiana shared a special bond with Boyce. The pair often compared photos and stories about thier beloved grandchildren.

In 2004, Bobbi and her husband, Jerry, moved from Buda, Texas to Campbellton, where they lived on 26 acres dubbed Riverbreeze Ranch. Bobbi thoroughly enjoyed country life, feeding their longhorn steer, spending hours by the fire (even in 80-degree

temperatures), and nurturing cactus gardens. One of her greatest joys was hosting family at the ranch, including several family reunions.

A memorial service to honor and celebrate Bobbi's life was held on August 7, 2012, at Alamo Heights United Methodist Church in San Antonio, attended by family and friends and her clogging family.

She is survived by husband Gerald (Jerry) A. Boyce of Campbellton; daughter Beverly Rudkin Ingle and her husband, Joe Ingle, and granddaughters Anna Mathias, Katheryne Ingle, Evelyn Ingle and Victoria Ingle, all of San Antonio; sisters Evelyn Hilley Reed of Granbury, and Marilyn Hilley Pettit of New York, New York; and numerous loving nieces, nephews, in-laws and friends.


