"Save" the last dance...

It seems like a popular topic of conversation at clogging events these days is how to promote clogging and get people into classes in a day and time when people have more on their plate than ever and there are so many other recreational choices. Some people even think clogging today needs "saving."

The western square dance community has been a step ahead of many traditional dance forms in organization and pro-active thinking. The activity has experienced the same ebb and flow of popularity that country western dancing, contra, clogging and other activities have experienced.

A project was even enacted by a coalition of square dancers called "Saving Square Dance."

Their mission was stated as "Promoting square dancing to the general public in a positive light. Educating the general public regarding the benefits of square dancing. Educating the general public that this is not a hayseed activity, but for everyone socially, physically, and mentally."

Their goals: Contribute to square dancing's growth by developing and putting into place an advertising campaign to promote square dancing.

The groups major projects:

- Get square dancing recognized as an approved medical exercise program and approved medical rehabilitation program.
- Get modern square dancing recognized as an approved physical education program to be implemented in school physical education programs.
- Promote the difference between "modern" square dance, and "traditional" square dance that some were exposed to in school.

The Australian clogging community many years ago put thought into similar initiatives to provide promotional materials and strategies to help spread the word on the benefits of clogging as an activity.

Sometimes we feel very isolated as we work from week to week with our classes and teams and look for solutions to marketing issues and growing our programs. Remember that there is a whole dance world of teachers and directors out there who can provide a network to bounce ideas off of.

If clogging seems to need "saving" in your area, be the one who throws the life preserver!

The world-renowned Bailey Mountain Cloggers of Mars Hill College present "New York" One dancer's iourney from ordinary to extraordinary

While sitting in the front row of the Moore Auditorium on the campus of Mars Hill College

in the mountains of Western North Carolina, listening to the chatter of nervous parents, the flower bouquet wrappings, and the clicking of the clogging shoes backstage, I was truthfully thinking this production was going to be akin to an end-of-the-vear recital at a dance studio. The widely-known Bailey Mountain Cloggers of Mars Hill College proved my thoughts wrong within the first 5

minutes of the first act.

The story of Drew Connors attempting to climb up the risky ladder of show business on Broadway was told elaborately through many Broadway musical theater numbers, jazz, hip hop, and ballroom dance ... oh, and clogging! Some of the tastes of Broadway plays included songs from "RENT", "The Producers", and "West Side Story".

The production, New York, was held March 1st and 2nd and showcased the dancers branching out and performing different dance styles other than clogging along with some musical theater. They brought in guest performers from around

> Asheville and Mars Hill to partake in the more difficult non-clogging

dance roles, and it worked well. The show got a standing ovation every night, and the team would start beaming the second they started clogging for the first

number of the show.

The star of the production, Florida native Joe Barron, was a dynamic presence to watch on stage. His role of Drew Connors took the audience through the journey of a performer trying to make it big. This journey included

moving to New York, auditioning and being rejected, being broke and in the pits of despair, and ultimately finding two goofy producers who were willing to hire him. In the end, the producers and Drew both fulfill their lifelong dreams of making it big.



In many routines, after performing some of Bailey Mountain's signature advanced clogging steps, he broke out into his own advanced hip hop routines with fantastic responses from the audience including the ever-popular "I love you, Joe!" "I never had the feeling that I was the *lead* role [of the show]," he humbly stated. "It was more of me and my friends just doing what we love."

CJ Tate and Laken Pilgrim, the main supporting stars, were animated in their roles of tourists aspiring to become Broadway producers. In the fifth number of Act I, the two are just getting into New York City with wide eyes, big dreams, and plans to become star producers.

"I was very excited to be doing 'The Producers' because it is a great Broadway play," Tate said. "I'm also very thankful that Danielle picked me to be one of the producers. I felt that adding different characters kept the show interesting with all of the subplots."

The brother-like friendship of the actors was palpable through their performance. This performance was the last for the affectionately nick-named, Tweedle-dee and Tweedle-dum, along with the five other graduating seniors, Leanne Rector, Heather Boyd, Deanna Chatham, Mary Bolster, and Shana Bolton.

This production blew me away with a wide variety of dance styles and the complexity of routines from the get-go. My favorite part, and the audiences seemingly favorite part, was the STOMP-inspired a cappella routine where a fence, some pipes, clogging combinations, and bins, buckets, and brooms were utilized to make their own percussive beats.

As an audience member, you would have never guessed that the team had just shy of two months to prepare for the entire show when

Paul Melville, a Florida native who transferred to Mars Hill College in the beginning of the 2013 spring semester, says "Learning new dances in a short amount of time is always fun and just adds to my love of clogging. It was very different having to learn the signature steps of BMC so quickly, but in the end, not only did I learn new clogging steps, I got to know my new teammates and friends."

The good news and the biggest reason for the rushed production is because the loved and respected director of the team, Danielle Plimpton, who welcomed her first child at the end of March.

"This year was definitely rushed more so than the past but I believe it made the dancers focus more on the end result of a great production. This is my seventh year as the director for Bailey Mountain and I believe without a doubt this was the best concert yet. So many members of the community have expressed how impressed they were with the quality of dancing, costumes, music, and lighting. We are very blessed with this team and a supportive community that loves seeing us perform what we do best" Plimpton said.

After the last performance, while I was waiting for my friends who were in the show, I did what I could to help break down the stage set and pack props away. While I was cleaning up feather boas, bent pipes, and cardboard cellos, I watched the dynamic of the team from the sidelines. Some dancers were still in full costume with teased hair and ripped denim skirts, some were already in their comfortable sweats, and the men of the team were starting on the stage set breakdown. With Danielle about to pop, some of the dancers were obviously frustrated that she just wouldn't stay sitting down (she's the director

and directors don't sit. Ever.) After saying something along the lines of "What are you doing, Danielle? We don't need a baby born on this stage!" CJ Tate pulled up a chair in front of her, pointed to it, told her to sit, and wouldn't leave, or put his pointing arm down, until she did.

The love for each other that the team members emanate is enviable. Nearly

every dancer was reduced to tears (even some of the guys!) when the seniors were recognized during the finale of the last performance. This show marked the end of their crazy journey through college, and their last spring concert they will be in. It's not every day you find such a supportive and talented group of people; I can imagine how hard it will be to say their final goodbye at graduation.

Graduating senior, Laken Pilgrim summed it up. "Having done four concerts with BMC, they all have a special place in my heart, but this being my last one was a great one to go out on," he said. "Bailey Mountain is really hard to explain because it is something so great that words (Continued on page 14)

cannot define it. Being on stage with BMC is unlike any other."


These young dancers don't just put on shows for fun; they compete against other nationally recognized teams. They recently won their 20th National title with their Appalachian smooth square dance routine. The team qualifies for the American Clogging Hall of Fame (ACHF) national competitions every year in Maggie Valley, North Carolina. To be the national champion in ACHF, a team has to have the highest scoring value in a dance out of all of the different dance categories and age ranges at the competition. Since their founding in 1974, the team has won numerous awards in the ACHF competition circuit, along with many of their dancers being accepted into the American Clogging Hall of Fame. They are literally running out of space for trophies in their on-campus studio. These impressive accomplishments are no small feat.

You can truly tell this is a deep passion for these dancers, and we will definitely see some of them headlining large workshops soon enough. From one dancer to another, if you are ever thinking about coming out to Mars Hill for their spring concert, I highly recommend doing so, even if you don't personally know any dancers. The support from the small but tight-knit clogging

world means more to them than you will ever know, and the show is fantastic!



Find Out What It Means... To You and Your Dancers

RESPECT

Clogging is fun. No doubt about it; we all love it!

And, for the most part, we love the other cloggers who are enjoying it with us. Being a clogger gives you instant membership into an awesome 'club', with members worldwide.

However, while we are having the time of our lives, clogging away with big silly grins on our faces, we must remember to respect each other.

Remember to respect the new dancers who are still 'feeling their way' through steps that you now find simple. Just remember back when you were learning those steps... nobody was born knowing how to clog, we ALL had to learn it at some point. So, all of you awesome cloggers, please be patient with others who are still learning...

remember, there's probably a lot about clogging that YOU don't know yet, either...(Lord knows I have a long way to go, myself!) It's a lot more fun when we help each other... so in class, allow those struggling dancers time to work out the steps without rolling your eyes, making impatient noises, or the like. What comes easily to some is a challenge to others, and they in turn may find a step to

be quite easy when it may be a challenge to you.

Respect your team: Regarding those on-againoff-again dancers who just like to pop in and out of classes when they feel like it...but still expect steps to be broken down for them, when the rest of the class learned them during their absence...if you miss a class, it is your responsibility to find a time outside of class-time to work with either your instructor or team-mate to 'catch up' before you come in and slow down the class progression...

Respect your team and don't hold them back. And even if you are at every class, remember to work on routines on your own time, too...don't hold the team back because you aren't taking time to practice on your own. If you need help with steps, there's always someone who will work with you...either your instructor or another teammate...maybe before or after class. During class time, be an active participant - don't have your own conversations on the side, (these are distracting to the instructor and other dancers) and let's leave our cellphones in our purses/bags/pockets during class...we are there to work on our clogging!

Respect your audience: People love to watch cloggers. Remember to respect and honor

your audience by putting on the best performance you can...learn your routines well, and perform them with a smile on your face and a song in your heart. People won't enjoy watching a stage full of faces that are frowning or looking bored...grins are contagious, try sharing one!

Respect yourself: Remember you are here to have fun...don't set limitations on yourself. Don't beat yourself up if you are having a hard time with some steps...relax and let it work itself out. Ask for help outside of class if you need to, but don't let it frustrate you to the point that you aren't having fun. Allow yourself to try new things, movements, music, and new friends!!

Iowa clogging club looks to teach, share dancing

WATERLOO, Iowa --- Connie Bartels has heard the assumptions.

Cloggers wear wooden shoes. Or, they only dance to country music.

And perhaps worst of all --- "Clogging... I can't do that."

"A lot of people want to try clogging but they say 'I can't do it," Bartels said.

After more than 30 years of teaching and dancing, Bartels, 61, of Waterloo, Iowa and founder of the Waterloo Country Cloggers, begs to differ.

"I tell them that I can teach anybody how to clog," Bartels said.

Bartels decided to give clogging a try when she was in her late 20s at the advice of her mother, who saw the Candy Mountain Cloggers perform at the National Cattle Congress. Bartels also signed up her young son and daughter in classes and they danced up until college.

The novelty became a lifelong hobby and passion for Bartels, who has traveled to Germany, Canada and throughout the United

States giving lessons, learning new skills and simply enjoying the dance.

"I guess it kinda just grew on me," Bartels said. "It was a great form of exercise. In fact, back in the 1980s I actually taught clogging at a fitness club. It was in the Black's Building in downtown Waterloo."

Bartels formed the Waterloo Country Cloggers in the 1980s, a decade she said enjoyed a resurgence of interest in clogging. She continues to teach teens alongside senior citizens at her home and opens up space to practice a couple of times a week.

"We are having a hard time getting kids into the group. I think they think all we do is country music," Bartels said.

Country and folk music are a part of clogging's heritage. Bartels likes to kick up her heels to everything from bluegrass to rap to '90s pop music. She's choreographed numbers to "Sold" by John Michael Montgomery but also the Backstreet Boys' "Larger than Life."

Brady McDowell, 14, of Evansdale, earned the right to take his self-choreographed number to the song "International Love" by Pitbull to the



Iowa State Fair. He joined the Waterloo Country Cloggers a year ago after a 4H friend introduced him to the pastime.

"It's really good exercise. It's fun and I can make up my own little moves for it," said McDowell, who dances in a pair of white FILA shoes with Steven Stompers taps affixed to the soles.

They really get after

it," Dix said.

Dee Schildroth, 55, remembers teaching her youngest how to ride a bike a decade ago and coming across a curious sight: people clogging away in Bartels' garage and driveway. She and her daughters, Annalise, now 19, and Lindsey, now 16, signed up for lessons and have been clogging ever since. Her daughters even accompanied Bartels to a clogging clinic in Canada.

Schildroth likes the

techniques and details that set clogging apart from dance forms. The extra metal tap plate that is riveted to the base plate of a clogging tap, or floating in the center of it gives an extra jingle sound that is unlike any other dance tap.

"For me, that's one of the fun parts. It's unique. You get the extra clicking," Schildroth said.

Bartels and crew perform at nursing homes, county fairs and even a family function here and there

Bartels offers newcomers a free month of lessons and practice time. After that, she charges \$10 a month.

"Just come in and try clogging out for a month and see if you like it." Bartels said.

added to the performance. The majority of our buses have senior citizens, and they are very fond of the girls. Everyone enjoys meeting the girls before and talking with them following the performances."


Hebb said her parents came to one of the first shows with the new Gandy Dancers and they were excited to tell her about their favorite part of the show.


And Hebb continues to brag on the girls and their professionalism.

The first year, the dancers performed four routines during each show. This year, there are nine dancers, and four girls perform a total of 10 times during each show.

"We have had such a positive response that we added additional dancers and increased their time on stage," Hebb said. "Dancers are used in other dinner theater shows in Gatlinburg, Tenn. and the Carolina Theatre. These girls give their all and add so much energy and enthusiasm to the show. This year during try-outs, we had three times more girls interview than the year before."

The 2013 Gandy Dancers include seniors Colleen Webley and April Kesling; juniors Brianna Swecker, Cayla Collett, Logan Ryan, Sonja Skinner and Katie Preusch; freshman Hannah Shiflett; and Jamie Queen.

"These girls were chosen based on three main items: dancing ability, their performance and their character," Hebb said. "They need to smile and be professional. We cannot have girls who are nasty nor catty, and these girls rise to the occasion. We are really close here and look at the dancers as our little sisters.

"I enjoy watching the girls grow up and change from good young girls to great professional adults," she said. "It is great to watch the transformation of the girls."

Some weeks the girls have two shows, while other weeks they have up to six. Besides clogging, the girls perform other styles of dance as well as flag routines, tap, jazz, jive and swing.

Kesling, of Beverly, says she enjoys being a Gandy Dancer.

"I have been in dance for 11 years," Kesling said. "Being a Gandy Dancer is a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity. I consider the Gandy Dancer performers another family, and they are great to be around."

Kesling said she plans to attend West Virginia University to study pre-pharmacy, and she hopes to continue to dance and be a cheerleader.

Elkins resident Webley said she has been dancing for 13 years, and is very excited to be a part of the Gandy Dancer Theatre.

"This is such a great opportunity and has caused me to mature, become more professional and more at ease with the audience," Webley said. "Working at the theater is different from school performances the difference is in the professional atmosphere. I plan to pursue a



medical degree in college, but plan to come home and dance in the theater as much as possible."

Skinner lives in Elkins and said she auditioned to be a Gandy Dancer after she saw a show.

"I was such a big fan, and I have been dancing for five years," Skinner said. "I love to perform and working as a Gandy Dancer is such a great time dance is truly my passion!"

Hebb said she is proud of the girls both in their lives and with their work at the Gandy Dancer.

"These girls give no less than 100 percent," she said. "They are given the routines and learn them quickly. If I were young

again, I would want to be their friends."

Sometimes the dancers do shows for elementary schools in the county. Hebb said the girls help the youngsters learn to do clog steps, line dancing, twist competitions. hula hoops and the locomotion.

The Gandy Dancers also volunteer in

the community, recently helping during the Live United Telethon for the United Way of Randolph County.





"The kids really like to see the girls come into the schools and on stage during the performances," Hebb said. "To the little ones, these girls are famous."
