Documenting your shows for posterity is a great job for a dancer or parent. With the great interest in videography and scrapbooking, the club could provide the materials needed to have a team scrapbook or slideshow that is sure to be a treasure for the group. Having this scrapbook or an ipad showing the slideshow by the stage at events can also show folks what you do throughout the year and help to get you more bookings.

Do you need an assistant? Someone whose job is to have the equipment loaded at the end of the event can give you the freedom to talk to the crowd about upcoming classes and shows.

Delegating is easy. It’s the giving up of control that is difficult for many leaders. Give it a try. Take a look at many successful groups and you’ll find a team of dancers, spouses and parents that each take some part in the success of the group.



Nickel City Clogging Festival

Cloggers go overboard with fun and fellowship at world's largest regional clogging event


Many crews had heard tales of the riches found at the Nickel City Clogging Festival. The myth tells of 27 years of bounties gathered there. With maps, compasses, (GPS just in case,) we set course towards the coastline of Lake Erie. It cost several gold coins to pass through the toll gates, a cheap price to pay for the adventure that awaited us. We dropped anchor at the Adam Marks Hotel, home of the legendary Nickel City Festival. A menagerie of boisterous pirates, disguised as cloggers, were setting up camp. Unloading ample supplies and their sturdy clog shoes, these pirates were prepared to start the weekend battle. Which room...which leader...held the treasures they were seeking?

An exploratory mission, known as a fun dance, began Thursday evening. The buccaneers gathered syllabuses from the volunteer quartermasters, and began investigating room locations and size. From their crow's nest, Captains Perry, Gruber, Hudson, Orthner, Pyle, Shinoski, and Bilz, led the sailors through a familiar

for the perfect item.

The strategically positioned galleys on site tried to satisfy the vicious hunger of the crowd. More rations could easily be found outside the hotel. A staple food for a seafaring pirate is fish, so for many buccaneers the hot Buffalo wings were a culinary delight.

Friday and Saturday morning, Zumba classes were skillfully navigated by Kerri Orthner and Darolyn Pchajek. Ignoring the fact that the sun just rose above the horizon, the hardest of mates dressed and attended these early offerings. 





Cloggers in the Spotlight

Family's Fast Feet Find Favor on 'America's Got Talent'

Dancing since before they could tie their clogs, the six siblings of Fort Collins' Meehleis family are proud that their decades of practice gave them the opportunity to share their talents on "America's Got Talent."

Performing as The FAMtastix, the four sisters and two brothers are still reeling from the standing ovation they received on the NBC talent competition.

"To have the whole audience stand up was amazing; it was amazing," said Meghan, the oldest of the siblings whose ages range from 19 to 33.

The program that aired during the Summer competition was filmed late last year, but the dancers said watching themselves on national television was nerve-wracking and exhilarating at the same time.

"The audience can be pretty brutal sometimes," added Caitlynn, 24. "They'll let you know if they hate you on that show — very, very loudly ... They either love you or they hate you, so I'm glad that we got the reception that we did."

Dancing to Sister Sledge's anthemic "We are Family," the troupe also wowed the judges, who voted the group on to another round in the competition, which is quite an honor.



“You make clogging look really hot,” AGT judge Mel B told the group. Even the sometimes surly judge Howard Stern was on his feet wanting to see more from the group.

“That just doesn’t happen very often from him,” said dad Rick Meehleis, who co-runs High Country Conservatory of Dance, where the troupe trains, with his wife, Michelle.

Trying out for the show was a spur-of-the-moment decision for the siblings, who up until then had never performed together as an act, only as part of larger performances.

“It’s a long, tiring day,” Justin, 31, said of the 16-hour day. “You’re in holding rooms with hundreds, if not more, of other acts waiting to get through. It’s nerve-wracking — each round you have to go through — but the excitement and the possibility is what keeps you going forward.”

For Justin, clogging initially was a way to get faster feet on the soccer field, but soon clogging overtook soccer. Parents Rick and Michelle Meehleis got their children into clogging early on for fun, but soon the family started their own school — High Country Conservatory of Dance.

“I love the rhythms; I love the syncopation, the cadences, that whole thing along with the high-power, high-energy (aspect),” Justin said. “The most rewarding thing is getting an audience to feel what you’re trying to portray.”

The family hopes that the exposure from the show helps to lead them to an opportunity to turn The FAMtastix into a career.

“We wanted to do something that we could do all together,” Caitlynn said.

“Now we’re really hoping that we’ll have lots more opportunities to do this so that we can stay together.”






