

Tribulation and Tribute

June has been quote a month for me and my family.

At the beginning of the month, we lost our dear mother, Nancy, in the final stages of Alzheimer's. It still does not seem real to us.

My mother loved clogging and the family of cloggers. From the sweatshirts she made for so many, to they trips she and my Dad made with cloggers, I thank you for being so kind. I also must thank my late Grandmother who was my clogging inspiration and my parents who got us into square dancing at a young age. It truly changed all of our lives.

A week after Mom's service, one of my brothers had a boating accident resulting in a skull fracture and traumatic brain injury that put him into a coma for 16 days. Going to tell my father about the accident and that drive to the trauma hospital was one of the hardest things I have ever done.

A major financial investment to family members to help them buy a business turned into a nightmare when it was found that there was a myriad of issues of mismanagement, misinformation and misdeeds and I have had to legally take over to save the business and the jobs it supports and my financial investment. The betrayal has caused a wedge in the family during a very trying time and the added responsibilities and the many stresses it has created have put me in a place emotionally that I have never experienced before.

Needless to say, clogging has seemed pretty unimportant lately. Like I usually do, I have tried to lay low. I am very private usually and I tend to shut down when I get too much going on. My close friends and family know that and have been an amazing support system.

In May, right as my Mother's condition became critical, my partner in the World of Clogging Workshop put together a surprise tribute for me at our Memorial Day event. The touching words from so many people that I care about were a medicine that was much needed. Thank you, Hanna and everyone who was a part of the tribute. Barb Elko has written a wonderful article about it for this issue.

The outpouring of love and support from the clogging family this month has been a source of comfort for me that has helped me and the family tremendously. A longtime clogging friend was with us at hospice daily and those who travelled long distances to attend Mom's memorial or send flowers meant so much.

My brother is doing amazing considering the extent of his injury. His progress has defied the odds and is out of ICU. He will face a long recovery but he is out of the woods and responding well. Every day we see improvements.

Little messages, thank you's for mentoring and advice, tokens of love and a mountain of prayers sent have made a great difference in days that seemed very dark and have made me realize what a wonderful life I have. Even with the losses, and the pain and the uncertainty of the future, I have been blessed with a gift that few people gain in this life. All over the world and throughout my life I have left pieces of my heart and gathered marks on my own and many of those traces and their impact make their way home at the most incredible times and in the most amazing ways.



The World of Clogging Workshop and Championships

A quarter of a century old this year, the World of Clogging workshop/competition continues to entice cloggers to spend their USA Memorial Holiday Weekend dancing. This long running workshop has had several locations over the years

since its start in Columbus, Ohio. Currently the Cincinnati Airport Marriott is home, a very accommodating location. The longevity of this workshop is evidence that this one is special. A successful workshop constantly evolves taking on its own personality. These distinctions often determine the degree of fun for the attendees, thus building an allegiance to that particular workshop. Like myself, many dancers return to the World of Clogging year after year, cause this one is more fun than a barrel of monkeys!

Beginning at the Ramada Inn in Columbus, Ohio in the early 1990's, the event (then called the Memorial Day Clogging Spectacular) was a partnership of instructors Tandy Barrett, Charlie Burns, Jeff Driggs,

Sallie James and Steve Smith.

Last year Hanna Healy and Jeff Driggs, the hosts of the current event (now known as the World of Clogging), tried a unique idea. They held an instructors lottery. Twelve lucky instructors were selected and given a fifty minute teaching slot. The lottery was an ingenious idea! The results were favorable so Hanna and Jeff decided to have a lottery again this year. Six of the lottery winners from last year were invited back to teach. Those lucky teachers who were given the chance to return were Donna Aberman of Florida, Billie Jo Burnette of Tennessee, Barb Elko of Pennsylvania, Chris Phelps from Michigan, Naomi Zweben King from Ohio, and Bekka Gunner from New York. The six remaining teaching slots were offered in a lottery again and included Christy Corwin Howard from Indiana, Jason Pflugh from Ohio, Tina Curtis from Canada, Jared Pullum from Kentucky, Brian Dion from Ohio, and Colleen Zurbrigg from Canada.

I was one of the six instructors invited back to teach, and trust me it was an invitation that did not take long to RSVP. I think for the returning six instructors this year was even more

Bekka's routine was so fast that everyone, including herself, rested on the floor afterwards... good stuff! Christy Corwin Howard challenged her group with a choreography to "Dessert", as did Chris Phelps with "Haven't

Had Enough", both great routines. Jared Pullman taught "Five More Hours". Talent runs through this young man's veins! Colleen Zurbrigg -- a seasoned instructor from Canada -- brought her smile, cue sheet and a routine to "Irish Stew". Her routines always contain some creative steps. Tina Curtis also from Canada had a well-received intermediate pop routine to "The Fighter". Jason Pflugh showed an intermediate routine to "Love This Life". 

Mission Impossible accomplished! Jeff had no clue so many were gathering to thank








He made his way to the sound table to speed up the transition when Hanna stepped in and told him she would take it from there. A thoroughly confused Jeff was led to a comfortable high-backed chair that had been brought to the front of the ballroom as Naomi Pyle and Scott Dobson with microphones in hand started the tribute to a man who stands alone. Naomi described Jeff as a kind, generous, wonderful friend, who remains so even when she wakes him at three in the morning with her latest clogging ideas.

Scott talked fondly of their shared travels and Jeff's story telling. Scott asked Naomi what she most admired about Jeff. She responded "How much time have you got?"

It is impossible to sum up Jeff Driggs, but I wanted to share a bit of the tribute to an amazing man!

To condense his thoughts, Florida instructor Matt Koziuk used the noun "inspiration." Jeff is a person

was invaluable. Nathan asked all those attending the tribute to do him a favor. Giving a nod to the descriptive expression "everything" among Nathan's clogging friends, Nathan that the entire crowd repeat these words "Jeff Driggs is everything, 1 2 ready go" "Jeff Driggs is everything" was repeated so loudly that it was probably heard outside the building. Delohn Collins, a member of All That, has known Jeff for nearly thirty years. He was seven years old when they first met. He said as a child his hero was He-Man. As an adult his heroes were his grandparents and parents. He believes a hero is somebody you aspire to be. "In the world of clogging, Jeff Driggs is my hero. I love him with all my heart," Delohn said. Several groups demonstrated during the tribute. Every demo was a routine that Jeff had choreographed through the years. The Fancy Free Cloggers performed the first demo of the evening to a bluegrass song "Drivin' Nails". Earlier in the evening, Jeff was a bit puzzled as to why this group had come to the fun dance dressed alike. Fooling this man was not easy. Jim Kimmerly, a member of the Fancy Free Cloggers, was introduced. He is 93 years old, and a survivor of Pearl Harbor. Jim wanted to give Jeff a special tribute, so he announced that he would do twenty pushups. The audience cheered and counted each push up. When he got 20 and continued doing pushups everyone was a bit worried. He actually gave Jeff 30. This incredible man earned a long standing ovation. What a wonderful way to pay tribute to Jeff! Next, the Buckeye Country Cloggers of Bellville, Ohio danced to "Casey Jones." It was apparent this one took Jeff back in time. His friendship with director Brian Dion and his Grandfather Paul Williams (who passed away early this year) goes back more than twenty years.

The Hills of Kentucky Cloggers filled the dance floor for a demo of "Real Time." Fonda Hill and her team have been friends of Jeff's for many years and Jeff was very touched by the group's tributes. Judy's School of Dance picked Jeff's fun routine to "Bang On The Drum All Day, for a lively demo that included an international mix of dancers from Canada and Nathan Ballard from Australia.

Studio One from Winchester, Kentucky, chose the choreography to Backstreet Boys song "Everybody" as their routine. It was an impressive demo and seeing the adults on the team joining with teen and college age members of the national champion clogging team doing a workshop dance to honor Jeff was awesome.

Joel Harrison's Capital City Dance Shack, Tenacious, Sole Patrol and Tap This! teams hit the dance floor for a mashup of Jeff's routines to "Party Rock Anthem" and "Born This Way."

If you were not present you missed two very memorable things. One: The huge smile on Jeff's face as the dancers did the running man step in "Party Rock Anthem." Two: The return of the fat suits that Naomi borrowed for the group's dancing to "Born This Way!"


The instructors from the World of Clogging gather on the dance floor to perform Jeff's well known routine to "Mamma Mia."


