For the Love of the Dance

Indiana Teen Doesn't Let Her Challenges Slow Her Down

GREENFIELD, INDIANA — When Erin Jeffries steps on stage, everything else fades from her mind.

The adrenaline takes over, and for the next few minutes, the 16-year-old can forget there is anything that sets her apart from the group of dancers, their feet striking the floor in well-rehearsed synchronicity.

She might feel fatigued afterward, and if there's much walking to be done, she'll probably have to use her wheelchair.

But nothing can take away those few precious minutes. And no amount of pain can make her regret them.

Erin was diagnosed at birth with Klippel-Trenaunay Syndrome, a rare disorder that causes vein malformations and abnormal overgrowth of the bone and soft tissue.

For Erin, the disease is most noticeable in her left leg, which is significantly larger than her right and the cause of constant pain.

The Greenfield teen has undergone multiple surgeries, but they have done little to keep her symptoms at bay. She walks with a limp and tires easily, depending on a wheelchair whenever long distances are involved.

At a recent trip to the Mayo Clinic in Minnesota, doctors confirmed something the teen has always feared – the only permanent solution for pain management might be to amputate.

But for the girl who has been clogging since she was 5 years old, that's no solution at all.

"I was like, 'No, not happening,'" she said. "Not happening yet."

A healthy start

When Erin was born, she seemed normal, save for a port-wine mark that stretched down her left leg. She was a colicky baby, but that didn't alarm her parents, Todd and Robin Jeffries. At that point, her legs also appeared to be the same size.

"She was very proportionate, very normal-looking," her mother said. "You wouldn't have known."

Call it a mother's intuition, but Robin Jeffries said eventually, she started wondering if there was more to that birthmark than her daughter's doctors said.

She took Erin, then 5 months old, to another doctor, who said she suspected the little girl suffered from KTS. Erin was transferred to Riley

Children's Hospital for a second opinion, and it was there she received her diagnosis.

Erin underwent her first surgery at age 1. At the time, her doctors thought a small growth she developed was a hernia, unrelated to her disorder.

They were wrong.

When doctors cut the area open, expecting to remove excess tissue, they found they had actually sliced through a mass of tangled blood vessels.

The toddler almost bled to death.

At age 2, Erin underwent laser treatments for the

port-wine stain on her leg. Not only would the treatment erase some of the unsightly purple color, doctors said, but by breaking up the surface blood vessels covering Erin's skin, it could relieve some of the pressure in her leg.

The process was so painful, she had to be put under general anesthesia.

Each treatment – and there were many – left behind what looked like second-degree burns. They took weeks to heal.

“She was a tough little kid,” her mother said. “Well, she’s a tough person.”

Determined to dance

The symptoms Erin experiences today didn't begin to emerge until she was in elementary school. In fact, they came about so gradually that no one in the family can pinpoint when the pain started.

But by age 11, it became clear Erin's KTS was affecting her. She had trouble walking long distances, and her left knee would swell to an uncomfortable size.

Clogging became harder, she remembers, and she lost the ability to run.

But she wasn't one to complain, and she certainly wasn't one to give up.

“There were many times when I thought Erin should quit, ... just because of pain,” her dad said. “I didn't want to see her in pain after she had danced or after she had practiced.”

But his daughter's resilience could not be ignored. Some days were harder than others, and there were tears when it hurt too much to dance.

But Erin was resolute. So, the family came to a decision.

“Erin has to decide what she can handle and what she can't,” her father said.

Today, Erin finds relief by taking frequent breaks and not being shy about sitting out if she's feeling overwhelmed. Hearts Ablaze, her clogging team, is a Christian-based group that has been unfailingly supportive, she said.

“All the people that I dance with have become my family, and they are all constantly in prayer for me,” she said. “It's like there's so much support that I feel like it doesn't really matter what happens.”

At a recent dance competition, the team received the Cup of Honor, an award recognizing the cloggers for their support of their teammate.

While there is no permanent treatment for KTS, there are other means patients can take to manage their symptoms.

A custom-fit compression sock Erin wears relieves some of her pain. It keeps the blood from pooling, painfully, in her leg and also masks the varicose veins that cross her skin like a purple web.

Erin has trouble explaining how she dances with her condition. After all, she's been doing it for years.

Just performing the steps properly comes with its own challenges, as her left leg is significantly heavier and weaker than her right.

But she can't explain how she does that, either.

Short of pointe ballet, Erin would be hard-pressed to

find a style of dance more difficult for someone with her condition.

Clogging is a high-impact style of dance, and its rapid-fire movements require precise timing. Any dancer lagging behind would be noticeable not just to the eye but the ear.

But Erin doesn't let her condition stop her from doing the things she loves. In fact, those who know her best say it's barely slowed her down.

An open mind

That recent trip to the Mayo clinic has given Erin and her family much to consider. While losing a leg might seem a terrifying prognosis, Erin discusses the possibility with a matter-of-factness only someone who has suffered can understand.

KTS is not degenerative, but it is the kind of condition that worsens with time and the effects of gravity on an aging body. And there is no cure.

Erin has lived with constant pain for so long that, when her clogging days are over, she will consider amputation.

She wonders if it might grant her some of the freedoms she hasn't been able to enjoy. Many people with prosthetics are able to run. And without that compression sock over her foot, she could finally wear flip flops.

"I'm gonna keep an open mind to it," she said. "Because it hurts so much. In my mind, it'd be a lot less painful."

Of course, there would be other pain.

"I know I wouldn't be able to dance anymore," she said.

Erin, a junior at Greenfield-Central High School, said she expects to give up clogging when she



goes to college. Until then, she's planning to tough it out.

But for the upbeat teen, that's nothing new.

"This has always been managed symptom by symptom," her mother said. "Everything we do with Erin is one day at a time."

There have been unexpected benefits to having KTS, the family has found.

Having experienced her own challenges, Erin has developed special compassion for others who are hurting.

"I'd be able to relate to them in different ways," she said.

Erin's parents will support her no matter what the future holds.

And they are proud their daughter always looks to the positive, despite the limitations KTS has imposed on her life.

"I've always told her it's just part of who she is," her mother said. "I think it's made her just an amazing person."

Clogging in the Heartland

BRISTOL, INDIANA — Some are drawn to clogging because it looks like it could be fun. Others think it might be good exercise and some just want the challenge.

“Whatever the reason,” said clogger Sharon Stuckman, “You get hooked.”

Members of the Heartland Country Cloggers performed 13 different dances to both traditional and contemporary music Saturday evening at the Bristol Homecoming Festival. Shoes fitted with specially hinged taps make for the unique sound of clogging.

There are as many ages represented in the group as there are reasons to join.

Cassidy Woodall, 13, of Constantine, Mich., learned how to clog when she was 7 years old.

“I had seen clogging on television before,”

Cassidy said. “And then my mom and I saw cloggers perform at the Shipshewana Mayfest. After the show we asked them if they gave lessons.”

They did.

Both Cassidy and her mother Ellen took the eight-week course with the Heartland Country Cloggers.

Since then the two have performed in dozens of shows each summer.

“I’ve also learned Buck dancing, which is kind of

one step up from clogging,” Cassidy said. “It’s more foot movement per beat. You’re on the balls of your feet more and do a lot more hopping and jumping around.”

Cassidy said she likes to learn the dances, but mostly enjoys performing on stage.

“She even talked her grandparents into taking clogging lessons!” Ellen said.

Becky Hochstetler got involved in clogging when her daughter Dori was 14 years old. That was in 1992.

Two years later she formed the Heartland Country Cloggers with a friend. Today, she’s still the director along with assistant directors Sharon Stuckman and Maribeth Rhodes.

Hochstetler is now clogging along side her granddaughter, Brittney Martin, of Nappanee.

Martin, who recently graduated from NorthWood High School, has been clogging since she was 6 years old.

“Nobody pressured me into learning just because both my mom and grandmother knew how and I’d grown up around it,” Martin said. “I wanted to figure out to get involved.”

That was certainly a challenge for Brittany who has spina bifida and is wheelchair bound.

“My grandmother taught me the different steps

using her hands,” Martin said. “So we got some kid’s sandals and put taps on them.”

With a board resting on the arms of her wheelchair, Martin puts the shoes on her hands clogs to a variety of dance numbers.

“It’s a way for her to express herself with her hands instead of her feet,” Hochstetler said.

Martin uses one set of shoes for traditional clogging dances and a lighter weight version for the faster, more intricate numbers.

“In October we go to a workshop in southern Indiana,” Martin said. “That’s my favorite time because we get to meet cloggers from around the state and sometimes from farther away.”

Two times, in 2010 and 2012, Martin has had the chance to perform in a national clogging showcase in Nashville, Tenn.

“I felt a little out of my league,” Martin said. “I mean there were national champions there!”

But it didn’t stop Martin from performing and drawing a lot of attention.

“I am different and I think people are fascinated to see clogging with hands,” Martin said. “It’s an experience I will never forget.”

Martin is planning on studying journalism in the fall at Grace College on Winona Lake near Warsaw.

“I’m going to try to find time to keep clogging,” she said. “Practice is on Thursdays and I don’t have classes on Thursdays for the first eight weeks of school.”

Besides performing in six of the 13 dances,

Martin also demonstrated and explained a variety of steps to the crowd watching the Bristol Homecoming clogging show.

Beginner classes, at Prairieview Missionary Church, 2612 Dierdorff Road, Goshen, start the first Thursday of October at 6:30 p.m. and run for eight weeks.

About the Heartland Country Cloggers

Started in 1994, with just 8 members, they have grown to more than 2 dozen performers clogging to traditional and contemporary music.

They perform both traditional and contemporary shows, public events and private bookings throughout the central Michiana region (northcentral Indiana and lower central Michigan).

"It felt great, just wonderful, just like 30 years ago," she said, "Just like back then when I was young, and when I could really get it on."

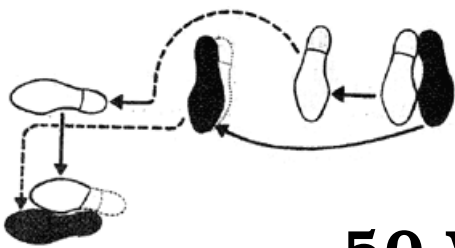
She's in the end stage of COPD (Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease).

"I just wanted to be up there, because I love to

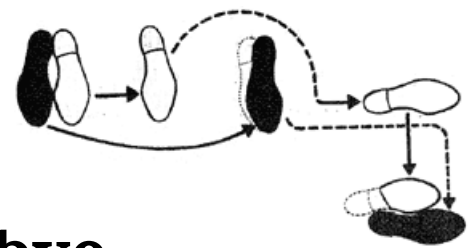
